# 10th Birthday!

The Grafton Volunteer Fire Department was organized in 1949.

To get the Department started, the town voted an appropriation of \$400. There were voluntary contributions of \$572.25. The ladies put on a supper and obtained \$54.40. A Minstrel Show featuring local talent brought in \$63.54 and a turkey raffle \$54.00.

A second-hand truck, a 500-gallon water tank, a booster pump, hose and other necessary equipment were purchased and with this material the firemen made up their own fire truck, all labor being on a volunteer basis. A new fire house was built, also by voluntary labor.

To say the least, it was far from being a model fire truck. However, to this homemade equipment, manned by volunteer firemen who have been faithful in their duties, is due the credit for many buildings standing and serving a useful purpose that otherwise might now be in ashes.

The fire company has been thrifty financially, having accumulated a small amount of money, and it is the hope of the department that in the near future, when a little more capital has been acquired, some better equipment may be purchased in order to serve the town even better.

# TOWN WARRANT

### THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Grafton in the County of Grafton, in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Grafton on Tuesday, the 10th day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

Polls to close at 5 p.m.

- 1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
- 2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
- 3. To hear the report of the Budget Committee and act thereon.
- 4. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to make short term loans in anticipation of taxes.
- 5. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the purpose of maintaining Highways and Bridges.
- 6. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the purpose of cutting bushes and railing embankments.

- 7. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to administer or dispose of any real estate acquired by Tax Collector's deed.
- 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$677.00 to continue street lighting.
- 9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$25.00 for care of the Common at Grafton Center.
- 10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$925.22 and thereby receive \$6,-168.15 from the State for Town Road Aid.
- 11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$300.00 for the control of Write Pine Blister Rust in cooperation with the Forestry and Recreation Department for the current year.
- 12. To see of the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$50.00 for the observance of Old Home Day.
- 13. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$300.00 for the purchase of culverts.
- 14. To see of the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$700.00 for the purpose of oiling roads.
- 15. To see of the Town will vote to purchase the snow plow and wing which is now installed on the Town Truck and raise and appropriate \$2450.00 for the same, one thousand dollars to be raised by taxation this year and the balance of fourteen hundred and fifty dollars by two serial notes of \$725.00 each plus interest, one note due in 1960 and one in 1961. The Town's old V plow being turned in on the deal for \$200.00

- 16. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 as an emergency highway appropriation, said appropriation to be controlled by the Selectmen.
- 17. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1000.00 to be used in conjunction with the Grange or other organizations for the purpose of putting a basement dining room and kitchen under the Town Hall.
- 18. To see of the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$850.00 to go with the unexpended balance of \$850.00 now in the Treasury for painting and repair of Town Hall.
- 19. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$140.00 to be used in conjunction with money from the Ladies' Benevolent Society and Men's Club for installing water pump and fixtures in Town Hall.
- 20. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$300.00 to be used for Workmen's Compensation for highway laborers and liability insurance to cover roadwork and Town buildings, namely Town Hall, Library, Fire House and School Building.

- 21. To see if the Town will vote to raise anh appropriate the sum of \$50.00 for publicizing and promoting the natural advantages and resources of the town, together with other towns in the Dartmouth-Lake Sunapee Region.
- 22. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$250.00 to be used in conjunction with the unexpended balance of \$413.80 now in the Treasury to erect a fence and gate along the front of the new Cemetery.
- 23. Shall the provisions of Chapter 171-A of the Revised Laws relative to playing games of Beano be adopted in this town.
- 24. To take any vote or transact any further business that may legally come before said meeting.
