

1. **Motion Presenter:** Joseph Dwyer, on behalf of the Academic Affairs Committee
2. **Dates of Faculty Senate Discussion:** 11/30/20; 12/7/20
3. **Rationale:** UNH will likely continue to be in a “yellow mode” of operation in the Spring 2021. The Faculty Senate passed a motion in the Summer 2020 to allow for a fully online ADD/DROP process for the Fall 2020. The change to procedures was made in order to reduce the amount of contact between students, instructors, and staff and to help maintain the COVID-19 classroom density recommendations.
4. **Motion:** The Faculty Senate approves moving the Spring 2021 ADD/DROP process fully online in light of the COVID-19 pandemic.
5. **Senate Action:** The motion passed with 51 in favor, none opposed, and one abstention.
