THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Jackson in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Town House in said Jackson on Tuesday, the 14th day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
- 2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.

To determine what sums of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the following purposes:

- 3. Maintenance of summer highways and bridges.
- 4. Snow removal from highways and dooryards, and sanding highways.
 - 5. Street Lights.
 - 6. Old Age Assistance and Poor Relief.
 - 7. Maintenance of Cemetery.
 - 8. Memorial Day Exercises.
 - 9. Town Library.
 - 10. Fire Protection.
 - 11. Police Protection.
 - 12. Memorial Hospital.
 - 13. Jackson Resort Association.
 - 14. Social Security.
 - 15. Civil Defense.
 - 16. Town Dump.
 - 17. Skating Rink.
 - 18. A sum of money for the improvement of sidewalk.
- 19. The sum of \$275.18 for T.R.A. State will contribute \$1,834.52 as its share.
 - 20. The sum of \$145.00 for White Mt. Regional Assn.

- 21. Petition by Lawrence Flint and others to raise and appropriate a sum of money necessary to repair and make safe for modern automobiles, a section of Thorn Mt. Road from the driveway of Clifton Smith's residence to the driveway of Mrs. Robert D. French, as early in 1961 as conditions will permit.
- 22. The sum of \$950.00 to be used on Class V roads, resurfacing with tar, Proctor Hill inclusive.
- 23. The sum of \$300.00 for interest on borrowing in anticipation of taxes.
- 24. The sum of \$2,500.00 for Airport in Fryeburg this money was authorized to be spent in 1960 and the amount spent to be raised to reimburse Treas. by said amount in 1961.
- 25. To see if the voters of Jackson will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of forty-five dollars (\$45.00) to aid in carrying on the Water Safety and Swimming Program for the children of the district.
- 26. The sum of \$125.00 for reassessing new property in 1961 by the State assessors.
- 27. The sum of \$1,000.00 to be raised and appropriated for the purchase of Highway equipment, mainly road grader, the amount to be added to unexpended balance of 1960 of \$350.00 for new equipment, the balance, if any, to be paid out of earnings of Highway Dept.
- 28. To see what action the Town will take relative to Town tractor.
- 29. To raise and appropriate the amount of \$775.61 to reimburse the Town Treasurer for over-expenditures, Highway account.
- 30. To impose summons of .20 on poll taxes uncollected after October 15th, 1961.
- 31. To authorize the Selectmen to distribute inventory blanks at the time of taking inventory.
- 32. Petition by J. Arthur Doucette and others to see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$200.00 to be donated to the White Mountain Airport project to assist in the construction of a hard surfaced runway at the White Mountain Airport.

To act on any other business that may legally come before this meeting.

We, the undersigned auditors of the Town of Jackson, hereby certify that we have examined the books, vouchers, bank statements and other financial records of the various oficers of the town for the year ending December 31, 1960, and find them to be correct in all respects.

Librarian's Report

The Jackson Public Library was open on Saturdays from 2 to 4 P.M. for most of the year. From June 20 to September 5, 1960, it was open Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 2 to 4 P.M. In that time we circulated 1407 volumes to customers of all ages. Our special bin enables even 4-year-olds to select their own books, and we impose no age limit on borrowers, down or up. Limited funds too limited - prevent our purchase of new books that even our small library needs.

But, such books as we do acquire are selected first for readability, for their interest to our patrons, whatever group they may be in. Fiction, non-fiction, teen-age and children's (school age and pre-school) are all included.

We offer you a challenge. Come in and surprise your-self. Our library has charm. We have books of all kinds, amusing as well as instructive.

Professional librarians, college faculty members, readers from other states and towns familiar with libraries, tell us that we have a good library. Other towns, 10 or even 20 times as large as ours, do not have one as good - or even have one at all.

So, come in and take a book. Reading is a privilege. We have books. Enjoy the privilege right in your own home town, and boost a real local asset - the library.

The Bookmobile came about every other month during the year, with fiction, non-fiction and children's books. The Bookmobile people are most helpful and cooperative within their ability to help us, but they in no sense even pretend to furnish us with the new books that we require.

Our circulating magazines are: American Home, Atlantic, Coronet, Field & Stream, Good Housekeeping, Holiday, Jack & Jill, Ladies Home Journal, Life, Mc-Call's, Redbook, Readers' Digest and Saturday Evening Post. Bertha M. Rogers gives us Holiday and Readers' Digest Condensed Books. We thank her.

Mrs. Doucette, trustee, gives us "The New Yorker", "National Geographic," books and some of her spare time. Another trustee, Mrs. Frost and she have helped in

several unglamorous tasks involving books in bulk. Mrs. Haskell, our third trustee, lights our wonderful radiant heat gas stove early on cold library days. This faithful work is a boon to the whole community. More than one of our local small fry has turned from blue to pink in front of it.

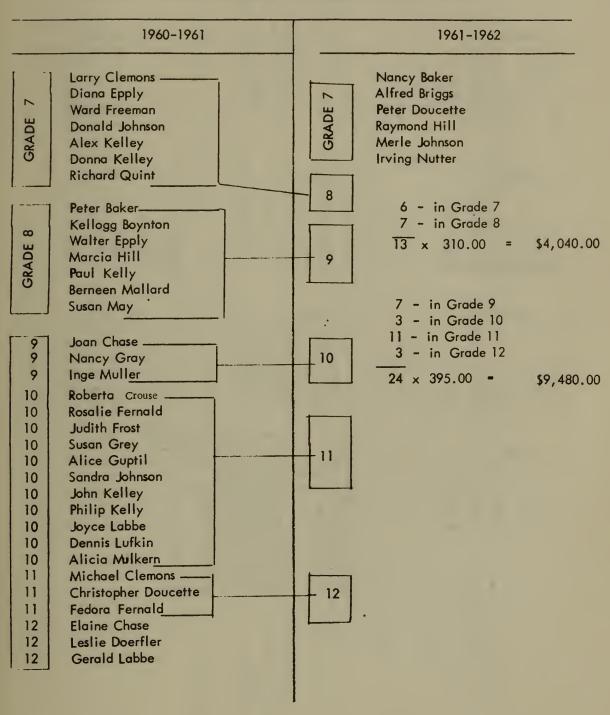

Report of Forest Fire Wardens

PREVENTION IS YOUR BUSINESS

Carelessness, HUMAN CARELESSNESS, causes 9 out of 10 forest fires. Each year 200,000 fires burn over 30 million acres in the United States. This represents 5 percent of our nation's woodlands being wasted each year. Every fire takes its toll. Floods follow; stream flow is affected; timber, buildings, grazing and wildlife are destroyed - all because MANY are CARELESS with fire in and near woodland. This can be remedied. You can put an end to this shameful waste! PREVENTION is YOUR business!

YOU, whether YOU be farmer, homemaker, business or professional man or woman, municipal, state or federal official, clerk or woodsman can play an important part in the continuing and vital prevention program.

First - by setting a good example YOURSELF - being sensible and complying with the necessary laws and regulations governing the use of fire in and near woodlands.

Second - by using YOUR individual influence in your community and valued council with others in insisting and encouraging them to do likewise.

The following simple rules may be used as a guide both for YOU and for them.

- 1. Before burning, secure a permit from your local forest fire warden the law requires it.
- 2. Be sure to properly supervise your burning don't leave it.
- 3. Make certain your fire, camp or debris, is DEAD OUT before leaving it.
- 4. Don't throw down lighted matches, cigars and cigarettes or from moving vehicles make sure they are out use your ash tray.
- 5. Don't burn at home use your town dump and save yourself much possible difficulty, both personal and financial.
