1977 WARRANT

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Sullivan in the County of Cheshire in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Community Hall in said E. Sullivan on Tuesday the 8th day of March, next at 1:00 of the clock in the afternoon. Polls not to close before 7:00 of the clock in the evening, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

You are hereby notified to meet at Community Hall in said E. Sullivan on Saturday, the 12th day of March, next at 1:00 of the clock in the afternoon, to act upon the following subjects:

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.

3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$30,000.00 for the Maintenance of Highways and Bridges and for construction of the same for the ensuing year.

4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$470.67 for Town Road Aid in order to receive the full State's share of \$6,186.39.

5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,700.00 to provide and maintain adequate Public Library service, and authorize the Library Trustees to receive and use supplemental funds otherwise provided.

6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,200.00 for the operation of the Fire Department and the purchase and maintenance of equipment.

7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,000.00 for the Police Department and the purchase and maintenance of equipment.

8. To see if the Town will appropriate the sum of \$750.00 for a recreation program to be administered by the Commission.

9. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectpersons to use up to \$3,500.00 Revenue Sharing money, for improvements to Town Buildings, or take any action relating thereto.

10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 for the maintenance of the Town Cemeteries.

11. To authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.

12. To see if the Town will vote to require a permit before the construction of any building with an area of 100 square feet or more.

13. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectpersons to enter into agreement with the City of Keene for emergency ambulance service.

14. To see if the Town will adopt the following ordinance: No person shall build, construct, or place any building, mobile home, trailer of any type, camp site, septic tank, leach field, or any part of a sewer system, fence, road, or any other structure of any type, in the following locations, without a written permit to do so by the Selectpersons and then only after a public hearing.

A. Within 15 feet (elevation above the low water level) adjacent to or near the Ashuelot River.

B. Within 10 feet of Otter Brook from the Roxbury-Sullivan town line to Centre Street.

C. Within 7 feet of Otter Brook from Centre Street to the Nelson-Sullivan Town line.

D. Within 5 feet of all other streams that normally flow all year.

E. Within 5 feet of Bolster or Chapman Ponds.

15. To see if the Town will vote to create a Budget Committee by adopting the provisions of the "Municipal Budget Law" in accordance with Chapter 32 of the New Hampshire Statutes, and, if these provisions are adopted, to determine the number of committee members and the members and the method of their selection of appointment.

16. To vote to accept the reports of Agents, Auditor and Committees, as printed in the Town Report.

17. To see if the Town will vote to raise, appropriate or borrow \$19,500.00 to renovate the stage area and install two bathrooms and complete plumbing in East Sullivan Community Hall or take any action relating thereto.

18. To transact any other business which may legally come before said meeting and to listen to opinions of a purely advisory nature in regard to the conduct of Town Affairs for the ensuing year.

ARTICLE 3

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$25000.00 for the Maintenance of Highways and Bridges and for any other construction of the same for the ensuing year.

ARTICLE 4

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$473.07 for Town Road Aid in order to receive the full State's share of \$3153.79.

ARTICLE 5

Motion to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2175.00 for the Library was amended to reduce to \$1700.00. The amendment carried by a voice vote.

Voted to raise and appropriate \$1700.00 to provide and maintain adequate Public Library service, and authorize the Library Trustees to receive and use supplemental funds otherwise provided.

ARTICLE 6

The amount of \$5000.00 was defeated by a negative voice vote. Motion to raise and appropriate \$2500.00 was voted for the operation of the Fire Department and the purchase and maintenance of equipment.

ARTICLE 7

The amount of \$4500.00 was defeated by written ballot. Yes 49

No 50

Motion - to raise and appropriate \$4000.00 was declared passed in the affirmative by voice vote, for the Police Department and the purchase and maintenance of equipment.

ARTICLE 8

Voted, by a clear cut affirmative voice vote, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$250.00 for the Planning Board.

ARTICLE 9

Voted, to authorize the Selectmen to appoint a Recreation Commission of (5) five members including one ex-officio member from the Planning Boards and one (1) from the Conservation Commission.

ARTICLE 10

Voted, by voice vote, to appropriate the sum of \$750.00 for a recreation program to be administered by the Commission.

ARTICLE 11

Voted, by voice vote to use \$2500.00 of Revenue Sharing money for the use of the Fire Department, the other \$1000.00 (if available) is unearmarked.

ARTICLE 12

Voted, by voice vote, to raise and appropriate \$500.00 for the maintenance of the Town Cemeteries.

ARTICLE 13

Voted, by voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.

ARTICLE 14

Voted, by a clear cut major to "pass over" this article, which was to require a permit before the construction of any building with an area of 100 square feet or more.

ARTICLE 15

Voted, by a unanimous voice vote to "pass over" this article -- To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to enter into an agreement with the Foley-DiLuzio Ambulance Service of Keene.

ARTICLE 16

Voted in the affirmative by a large majority voice vote, to authorize the Selectmen to accept a deed from the First Congregational Church Society of Sullivan, Incorporated March 6, 1955 as United Congregational Church of Sullivan, of certain buildings consisting of carriage sheds together with the right to use the land under said buildings and a right to pass and repass over a driveway giving access thereto, and further to accept gifts and grants in connection therewith whether in kind or specie, and further to authorize the said committee to expend funds and use said gifts for the restoration and repair of said buildings.

ARTICLE 17

Voted, in the affirmative, to require a fifty (50) foot set back for any part of a sewage system from any property line unless variance is received from the Board of Selectmen after proper hearing.

ARTICLE 18

Voted, in the affirmative, to require a fifty (50) foot set back for any part of a water system from any property line unless variance is received from the Board of Selectmen after proper hearing.

ARTICLE 19

Voted, by voice vote, to table this article and the Selectmen appoint a committee of three to study renovation, of the E. Sullivan Community Hall and report their suggestions at the next annual Town meeting.

ARTICLE 20

Voted, unanimous voice vote to table indefinitely the reconstructing Bridge No. 089/099 on the Cross Road.

ARTICLE 21

Voted, by a clear cut majority voice vote to accept this Article, which read: To see if the Town will accept a deed of Bessie C. Jewett dated November 8, 1974, and affirm an agreement of the Selectmen dated November 11, 1974 for the purchase of land on the westerly side of Town Farm Road, so-called, and southerly of the Meeting House being seven (7) acres, more or less, the conditions of which shall be that the Town shall pay on behalf of Bessie C. Jewett, her heirs and administrators, annually an amount of money equal to the amount of taxes levied against all of her real estate in the Town for that year, excluding any premises purchased or acquired by her or her heirs after April 1, 1974, and the Town shall make payment of this obligation by application of said payment to taxes due to the Town from Bessie C. Jewett in each such year. Said agreement provides that it shall commence April 1, 1974 for a period of ten (10) years from April 1, 1974, and it further provides that the total of payments made by said Town shall not exceed Thirteen Thousand (\$13,000.) Dollars. The agreement further provides that in the event that the remaining premises or any portion thereof of Bessie C. Jewett shall be conveyed to any other person not a child of Bessie C. Jewett, a spouse of such child, or child of such child, during the ten (10) year period, the obligation of the Town to make such payment shall cease as to premises conveyed to such other person, and further to appropriate such funds as may be necessary to fulfill the said agreement.

ARTICLE 22

Voted to accept the reports of Agents, Auditor and Committees, as printed in the Town Report.

ARTICLE 23

Voted to "pass over" this article. It was suggested that the Petitioners bring to the next annual meeting more information pertaining to the creating of a Budget Committee.

ARTICLE 24

Suggested that notice of meetings be published in the Keene Shopper News.

Voted to adjourn the meeting at 7:45 p.m.

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

TOWN OF SULLIVAN

May 5, 1976, at the Fire Station
7:00 P.M.

Decree of the Court granting the Town of Sullivan permission to hold a special town meeting, dated April 14, 1976, by presiding Justice John W. King.

Warrant:

"To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of Nine Thousand Five Hundred (\$9,500.00) Dollars as its share of the cost of re-construction of bridge No. 089/099 on the Cross Road. The bridge to be constructed by the State under the Town Bridge Aid Program together with Federal Assistance with the share of the Town of Sullivan being one quarter of the share of the State of New Hampshire, the total cost of the said project being One Hundred Eight Thousand (\$108,000) Dollars, the Federal share being Seventy Thousand (\$70,000.00) Dollars, the share of the State of New Hampshire being Twenty Eight Thousand Five Hundred (\$28,500.00) Dollars and the share of the Town of Sullivan being Nine Thousand Five Hundred (\$9,500.00) Dollars. To raise by taxes or bonds of the Town the said Nine Thousand Five Hundred (\$9,500.00) Dollars that the Selectmen by authorization to borrow the share necessary to fulfill the Town's share or to take any action relating to the above and further to authorize the Selectmen to apply and accept any Federal funds for the purposes of reducing the State and local shares."

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m., May 5, at the Fire Station to act upon the Warrant Article. The written ballots were accepted by the Moderator, Mr. Stanley Walters. The vote was a clear major 42 - 23 to raise and appropriate the Nine Thousand Five Hundred (\$9,500.00) Dollars from this year's taxes and accept state and federal funds, along with bridge standards set by the state.

PUBLIC LIBRARY TRUSTEES REPORT

The library loaned 1,627 books to townspeople in the year 1976: town library books, 1,211 - State Bookmobile books, 416. The bookmobile came three times. We are particularly pleased with this year's increase in readers because the library has been opened only one day a week for four hours. Due to the cutback in operation costs of the Community Hall where the library is located, it was necessary to shorten the library hours to Wednesdays from 3-7 p.m.

Several town histories were sold and the money was used to pay for materials for new adult and juvenile card catalog files, now under construction.

Monies from our annual Flea Market -- Book Sale last June were spent to buy paint and give the new library building (the old Town Hall at the Center) two coats of paint. The exterior of the building was in dire need of paint and a final coat will be necessary in 1977 as well as exterior green trim.

Twenty-six children participated in a Summer Vacation Reading program. Certificates, ribbons and gift books were presented at the end of the summer. Top readers in the different age levels were Joseph, Jeff and John Fitzpatrick and Cherri Flanders.

Over 250 new books were either purchased or given to the library in 1976. Mrs. Richard Sweet continues to supply us with new mystery and detective novels. We subscribe to the National Geographic, and a copy of Organic Gardening magazine is donated monthly by Gwen Johnson.

Thirty new books were purchased from the Bessie Jewett Memorial Book Fund and seventeen new books were purchased from the Elsie Smith Memorial Book Fund. The library trustees made a special trip to H.R. Huntington Book Company in Chicopee, Mass. to purchase children's books at special library rates.

Marjorie W. Smith has been the substitute librarian since May 1976.
