#### TOWN WARRANT

#### THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Grafton, in the County of Grafton in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Grafton on Tuesday, the fourteenth day of March, next at ten of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

POLLS CLOSE AT 6 P.M.

Business Meeting on all other articles to begin at 2 P.M.

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.

3. To hear the report of the budget committee and act thereon.

4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the following sums for their respective purposes as listed below:

5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$600.00 for the Town Library; \$275.00 of said sum for regular maintenance and \$325.00 for paint, floor finishing and labor.

6. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$50.00 for the purpose of publicizing and promoting the natural advantages and resources of the town together with other towns in the Dartmouth-Lake Sunapee Region Association.

7.(A) To see if the town will vote to adopt a plan for extending to employees of the town the benefits of Title II of the Federal Social Security Act (Old Age, Survivors and Disability Insurance) as authorized by Chapter 101 of the Revised Statutes Annotated by Chapter 302 and 332 of the Laws of 1955 and to raise and appropriate the sum of \$450.00 to defray town's share of the cost thereof.

(B) To see if the town wishes to exclude from the plan services in any class or classes of positions filled by popular election.

(C) To see if the town will authorize the Selectmen to execute on behalf of the town the necessary agree ment with the State of New Hampshire to carry into effect the plan and to see if the town will designate the Chairman, Board of Selectmen, as the officers to be responsible for the administration of the plan.

8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$7,500.00 for the purpose of maintaining highways and bridges.

9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,056.21 and thereby receive \$7,041.43 from the State for Town Road Aid.

10. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in Anticipation of taxes.

11. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the

Selectmen to convey by deed any real estate acquired by Tax Collectors deed.

12. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow a sum not to exceed \$5,500.00 to be used for the purchase of a four wheel drive loader. The entire sum to be paid in three equal payments, plus interest, on April 1, 1968, April 1, 1969, and April 1, 1970.

(A) If above article is approved, to see if the town will vote to transfer \$2,000.00 from Cash Surplus to make up the balance of \$7,500.00 purchase price of said loader.

(B) If article 12 is defeated, to see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to establish a capital reserve fund for the future acquisition of a loader by transferring \$2,000.00 from cash surplus to such fund.

13. Pursuant to a petition of ten or more legal voters: To see if the Town will create by ordinance a Town Planning Board of five (5) members under the Community Planning Enabling Act, Chapter 36:1-15, RSA 1955.

### VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT

As far as monthly meetings are concerned we have worsened our record!

In 1965 we had eight members present at one meeting; last year our highest attendance was four - not counting the June meeting which was ably assisted by three members of the Junior Ladies Auxiliary, together with your correspondents!

Fires were fortunately better attended, and all members as well as those of the Canaan and Danbury Departments, are due for special citation on August 11, when a major conflagration destroyed the barn on the estate of the late L.M. Hazen.

Caused by lightning striking a transformer about 6 p.m., the flames quickly raged out of control and despite the efforts of the three Departments, the structure was a total loss by the following morning. Hundreds of smouldering bales of hay which had recently been stored in the barn required several "return engagements" for over a week until the fire could definitely be called all out.

Several other fires during the year were of a comparatively minor nature, although three chimney fires which were potentially dangerous were extinguished before too much damage could be caused.

### GRAFTON FIRE RECORD

Fire records are made by people--- those who cause fires and those who control them. Your forest fire warden, deputy wardens, fire chief and firemen have, in spite of a prolonged drought, made one of the best fire control records in recent years. Despite a very dry spring, we in New Hampshire working together, have substantially reduced our fire incidence (885 in 1965 to 595 in 1966.)

This enviable record is largely due to two factors:

- 1. A closely coordinated and integrated state-town organization jointly carrying out programs of forest fire prevention, training and suppression with dedicated personnel.
- 2. Your appreciation of our forest fire control program and your individual effort in practicing fire prevention.

Statistics show, however, there is room for improvement. Major problems are still with us; (1) the careless disposal of cigarettes; (2) the householder's carelessness in burning rubbish; (3) the failure of woodlot owners and contractors to completely extinguish their brush burning fires; (4) failure to extinguish camp fires; (5) unsupervised children playing with matches.

New Hampshire has 4,339,000 acres of woodland to be protected. In 1966 we experienced 595 forest fires on this area and restricted acreage burned to 395 acres --- a fine testimonial to the efficiency and dedication of the men who make up our forest fire control organization.

If you must burn you will need a permit. Permits are not issued between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. except on rainy days. Permits are not needed when the ground is covered with snow. To minimize risk the best way to dispose of rubbish is at your authorized town or munici-

pal dumping area.

- 2. Be sure all discarded smoking material is out
- 3. Don't leave a live camp or cooking fire.
- 4. Most important Instruct your children that matches are not play things.
- 5. There was one fire caused by lightening on Smith Mt.
