To the Inhabitants of the Town of Grafton, in the County of Grafton and said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Town Hall in said Grafton on Tuesday, the twelfth day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
- 2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.

POLLS CLOSE AT 6 P.M.

Business Meetings on all other articles to begin at 2 p.m.

- 3. To hear the report of the budget committee and act thereon.
- 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the following sums for their respective purposes as listed below:

(1.)	For the control of White Pine Blister Rust	\$ 98.80
(2.)	For Old Home Day	50.00
	For Improvements to Huff Beach	50.00
(4.)	For Tree Removal and Railing	1,000.00
(5.)	For Patching & Oiling Roads	400.00
(6.)	For an Emergency Highway Appropriation	
	under Control of the Selectmen	500.00
(7.)	For Salt on Winter Roads	100.00

5. (A) To see if the Town will vote to adopt a plan for extending to employees of the Town the benefits of Title II of the Federal Social Security Act (Old Age, Survivors and Disability Insurance) as authorized by Chapter 101 of the Revised Statutes Annotated by Chapter 302 and 332 of the Laws of 1955 and to Raise and appropriate the sum of \$450.00 to defray town's share of the cost thereof.

(B) To see if the Town wishes to exclude from the plan services in any class or classes of position

filled by popular election.

- (C) To see if the Town will authorize the Selectmen to execute on behalf of the Town the necessary agreement with the State of New Hampshire to carry into effect the plan and to see if the town will designate the Chairman, Board of Selectmen, as the officers to be responsible for the administration of the plan.
- 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$8,000.00 for the purpose of maintaining highways and bridges.
- 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,176.43 and thereby receive \$7,842.84 from the State for Town Road Aid.
- 8. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in Anticipation of Taxes.
- 9. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to convey any real estate acquired by Tax Collectors deed.
- 10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000.00 for the purchase of Culverts.
- 11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000.00 for completing the Tractor Shed Addition.

- empower the Planning Board to approve or disapprove in it's discretion new subdivisions and plans thereof showing streets, or widening thereof, or parks, and upon the adoption of this article, it shall be the duty of the Town Clerk to file with the Registry of Deeds of the County of Grafton a Certificate or note giving the date of authorization, as Chapter 36 of the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, 1955. If this article is adopted, it shall further be the duty of the Town Clerk to issue all certificates of failure when the planning board shall fail to take action as provided in Chapter 36, Sections 19, 20-29 inclusive.
- 13. To take any vote or transact any further business that may legally come before said meeting.
