SELECTMEN'S REPORT

As has been the custom during the last few years we herewith submit our Annual Report which we have tried to make as brief as possible.

During the year the following projects, approved by the 1960 Town Meeting, have been carried out to completion:

The water hole at Stoddard Center, damaged by the mud and silt which washed into it during the heavy rain in October 1959, has been cleaned out and restored to its original capacity, and a better arrangement made to receive the suction hose to the fire truck.

Alterations to the Fire Station, providing a Meeting Room for the members of the Department, have been completed.

A new road grader, replacing the old one, has been added to the equipment of the Highway Department. With it our roads are being easier and better maintained.

The heavy snow storms of December kept both the State and our own Highway crews busy for long hours cleaning the roads. As a result there were no public roads in the Town that were closed to traffic for any length of time.

Your Selectmen are considering the purchase, with the cooperation of the State Forestry Department, of a new fire truck to replace the old Dodge truck that has given such good service but is now beyond economical repair. The new truck would be used, primarily, for fighting forest fires.

The Stoddard-Marlow and Stoddard-Sullivan town lines were perambulated during the year and the bounds marked with aluminum stakes as has been the practice in marking our other town lines. These stakes can be easily located, do not rot as the old wooden stakes did and are not expensive.

We are again including in the Budget an item covering a moderate appropriation for Civil Defense. In the past we have found that the opportunity to purchase useful surplus government equipment through Civil Defense has resulted in great saving in cost.

The Developments in Stoddard continue to provide new camps and cottages as well as additional tax revenue and business for the Town. In the not too far-off future we will be faced with requests for the laying-out and maintenance of new Town roads providing access to these areas. These requests will have to be given serious consideration. At the present time we have one such request for a new road and one request for a change in location of a portion of an existing Town road. Public Hearings of these petitions are planned for early Spring.

We again strongly recommend that the printing of the Inventory of Polls and Ratable Property - the Tax List - in each year's Town Report be dispensed with, by vote of the Town, and that such Inventory be printed every five years.

Word has just been received that our 1959 Town Report won second place in Class 1 in the State Municipal Reports contest for 1960.

Management of the Town's business is made much easier by the cooperation received by our citizens and Summer residents. We appreciate and extend our thanks for the cooperation that has been given us.

TOWN WARRANT

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Stoddard in the County of Cheshire in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Town Hall in said Stoddard on Tuesday, the Fourteenth day of March next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
- 2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
- 3. To see what sums of money the Town will vote to raise for Highways and Bridges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
- 4. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Snow Removal for the ensuing year and make appropriation of the same.
- 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Two Hundred and Eighty-one Dollars and Twenty-two Cents (\$281.22) for T. R. A.

- 6. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the general expenses of the Highway Department.
- 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for the maintenance of Public Landings.
- 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$1,400.00) for the general maintenance of the Fire Department.
- 9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Thirty-seven Dollars (\$37.00) as its fair share of the operating cost of the Elliot Community Hospital.
- 10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Seventy-eight Dollars to advertise the Town, said money to be paid to the Monadnock Region Association, for the purpose.
- 11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for Civil Defense, to be spent by the Civil Defense Director with the approval of the Selectmen.
- 12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) for street lights.
- 13. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the maintenance of the Library.

- 14. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to sell the old Dodge Fire Truck, less equipment, when it is replaced by another truck.
- 15. To see if the Town will vote to accept the legacy of the late Minnie M. Albee in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for use in maintaining perpetual care of the burial lots of Alson Upton and Nathan Morse in the Cemetery.
- 16. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue that section of public road leading from the Juniper Hill Road, past what was formerly known as the Mary Sweeney Place, the intent being to discontinue all sections of this road at present considered as a public highway.
- 17. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.
- 18. To see if the Town will vote to accept the provisions of the Municipal Budget Act.
- 19. To see if the Town will vote to petition the State Tax Commission to make a complete reappraisal of land and buildings within the Town to equalize valuation in accordance with the law and raise money for this purpose.

- 20. To hear reports of Committees and take any action thereon.
- 21. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

To the Inhabitants of the School District of Stoddard qualified to vote in district affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town in said district on the 14th day of March 1961 at two o'clock in the afternoon, to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose a Moderator for the ensuing year.
- 2. To choose a Clerk for the ensuing year.
- 3. To choose a Member of the School Board for the ensuing three years.
- 4. To choose a Treasurer for the ensuing year.
- 5. To determine and appoint the salaries of the School Board and the Truant Officer, and fix the compensation for any other officers or agents of the district.
- 6. To hear the reports of Agents, Auditors, Committees, or Officers chosen and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 7. To choose Agents, Auditors and Committees, in relation to any subject embraced in this warrant.

- 8. To see what sum of money the district will raise and appropriate for the support of schools for the salaries of school district officials and agents, and for the payment of statutory obligations of the district, and to authorize the application against said appropriations of such sums as are estimated to be received from the State Foundation Aid Fund together with other income; the School Board to certify to the selectmen the balance between the estimated revenue and appropriations, which balance is to be raised by taxes by the town.
- 9. To see if the district will vote to enter into a contract with another school district to pay tuition in excess of the State average.
- 10. To see if the district will vote to authorize the School Board to make application for and to accept, on behalf of the district, any or all grants or other funds for educational purposes which may now or hereafter be forthcoming from the United States Government or from the State of New Hampshire for the school year 1961 62.

A recent communication from the Keene School District indicated that they would be unable to "guarantee future tuition arrangements, due to the demands of future resident enrollments."

However, in the light of the Cooperative movement in the communities surrounding the Keene School District and the small number of pupils requesting admission to the Keene Schools from Stoddard, I do not believe that any pupil from Stoddard seeking admission to the Keene school will be denied.

You have probably read with some concern a proposal made by the Chairman of the State Board of Education, relative to the reduction of school districts in New Hampshire. Consistent with my thinking, relative to Cooperative School Districts, the proposl has merit. However, there are a great many problems to be worked out prior to the implementation of such a program, and New Hampshire will "make haste slowly" in its adoption.

That the seed has been planted is evident, and that there will be progress towards its adoption in one form or another, is entirely conceivable. Therefore, it behooves those small communities, such as Stoddard, to give some serious thought to some form of reorganization in order that they will be in a position to guide their own destiny when the time comes.

It was extremely gratifying to the Board and me to receive a gift of fifty dollars from Florence L. Ward to be used for the benefit of the school. The Board decided to use this fund to purchase books for the school library, and it certainly was a pleasure for Mrs. McMahon to prepare the list.

Again, I want to express my appreciation to the School Board, teacher, pupils and citizens for making my work in Stoddard

extremely pleasant.
