STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

The Polls will be Open from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

To the inhabitants of the Town of Colebrook, in the County of Coos, in the State of New Hampshire, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Colebrook School Gymnasium in said Town of Colebrook at Tuesday, the 13th day of March next at seven o'clock in the evening, to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To bring in your ballots for the election of Town Officers to be elected by ballot for the Town of Colebrook for the ensuing year.
- 2. To act upon all of the following articles contained in this warrant.
- 3. To see if the Town will instruct its Selectmen to appoint all other Town Officers as required by law.
- 4. To see if the Town will elect to approve of the inclusion of its Officers and Employees in the New Hampshire Retirement System of the State of New Hampshire, which system is provided for by RSA 100-A (Supp), for the Employees of the Town of Colebrook to be effective January 1st, 1984.
- 5. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for General Government for the ensuing year including outside fires and interest for short term obligations.
- 6. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for Emergency Radio Communications for the ensuing year.
- 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (3,500.00) for the purchase of a new Base Station Radio for the Town of Colebrook Radio Communications Center and to withdraw this amount from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972.
- 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Seven Thousand (\$7,000.00) for the purchase of a new Police Cruiser and to withdraw this amount from the Revenue Sharing Fund Established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972.
- 9. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the Police for the ensuing year.
- 10. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the maintenance and expenses of Highways for the ensuing year and to authorize the Selectmen to apply Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) revenue from the State Highway Block Grant allotted under RSA 235: 23 as amended.

- 11. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of Seventeen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$17,500.00) for Street and Road Paving and to authorize the Selectmen to withdraw the amount of Seven Thousand Thousand Five Hundred (\$7,500.00) from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under provisions of the State Local Assistance Act of 1972 and to use Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) from the State Highway Block Grant allotted under RSA 235: 23 as amended.
- 12. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the maintenance of the Sanitary Landfill for the ensuing year, including annual payment on indebtedness for purchase of Crawler-Loader.
- 13. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 for new Heating System for Police Room and to authorize the Selectmen to withdraw this amount from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972.
- 14. To raise and appropriate such sums as may be necessary for the support of the Town Poor for the ensuing year.
- 15. To raise and appropriate such sums as may be necessary for Old Age Assistance for the ensuing year.
- 16. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$17,000.00) of Highway Block Grant Funds allotted under RSA 235: 23 as amended for the Excavation of Colby Street and the remaining funds to be used where necessary for Road and Street Repairs.
- 17. To see if the Town will vote to remove the snow from the Business area of the village, defining the areas to be cleared, and to raise and appropriate money for the same.
- 18. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the Plowing and Sanding of sidewalks for the ensuing year.
- 19. To see what sum of money the Town will raise and appropriate for cleaning streets in the Business area this summer and to authorize the Selectmen to withdraw this amount from the Parking Meter Fund.
- 20. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,000.00 (Four Thousand Dollars) for the Construction and Repairs of Sidewalks and to authorize the Selectmen to withdraw this amount from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of State and Local Assistance Act of 1972.
- 21. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) to be withdrawn by the Selectmen from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972, and to be placed in the Special Truck Purchasing Fund.

- 22. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the observance of Memorial Day.
- 23. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) for Monuments or other appropriate Memorials to the Veterans of the Korean and Viet Nam conflicts and to authorize the Selectmen to withdraw this amount from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972.
- 24. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Four Dollars (\$1,774.00) as the Town's share for the operating expenses of the North Country Council for one year, beginning July 1st, 1984. These funds will be used for Financing Staff, Office and General Operating Expenses, Regional Planning Studies, Technical Assistance to Member Communities, Coordination with Local, State and Federal Agencies and other Programs of the Council. These fund may be used in conjunction with State and Federal Funds available for planning purposes.
- 25. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate as a contribution for the services of the Northern Coos Community Health.
- 26. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for support of the Community Action Outreach Program. (By Petition)
- 27. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate towards the support of the Upper Connecticut Valley EmergencyServices.
- 28. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise as a contribution for the support and services of Ver-Shire Center UCVMHS. (By Petition)
- 29. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise as a contribution for the support and services of Upper Connecticut Valley Mental Health Service. (By Petition)
- 30. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the operating expenses of Ambulance District A-1.
- 31. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the support of the Town Library for the ensuing year.
- 32. To see what sum the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for Street Lighting for the ensuing year.
- 33. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the use of the Town Planning Board for the ensuing year.

- 34. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the care of Cemeteries for the ensuing year.
- 35. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the amount of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for the control of stray dogs in the community for the ensuing year, pursuant to the provisions of RSA 466: 30a as heretofore adopted by said Town.
- 36. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Five Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$5,300.00) for the Purchase and Repairs of Parking Meters, for the Summer Cadet, Crosswalk Police and to authorize the Selectmen to withdraw this amount from the Parking Meter Fund.
- 37. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for Maintenance and Construction of Storm Drains for the ensuing year.
- 38. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000.00) for Colby Street Storm Drain Construction and authorize the Selectmen to withdraw these funds from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972.
- 39. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for Hydrant Services for the ensuing year.
- 40. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate to pay on the principal of the Bond Issue for Sewerage Facilities.
- 41. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to establish a Program for Forest Management based on the recommendations of the County Forester for property of the Colebrook Department on South Hill Road: said program to involve the sale of standing timber.
- 42. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for a Summer Recreation Program and to authorize the Selectmen to appoint Recreation Committee Members in accordance with RSA 31:47.
- 43. To see what sum of money the Town will raise and appropriate for the maintenance of the Colebrook Skating Rink.
- 44. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectment to apply for, to receive and use all funds of grants as may now or hereafter be forthcoming from Federal, State, Local or Private agencies in accordance with RSA 31:95-b.
- 45. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow the money to defray the expenses of the Town in anticipation of Taxes for the ensuing year.

- 46. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to sell at public auction any real estate acquired by the Town through Tax Collector's Deeds, or owned by the Town or any agency thereof, an until such sale is made, to administer the property in the best interest of the Town.
- 47. To see if the Town will vote to give free use of the Town Hall to non-profit organizations, including heat, lights, and janitor services, whenever same does not conflict with the best interest of the Town and at the discretion of the Selectmen for the ensuing year.
- 48. To see if the Town will vote to accept, ratify and confirm the reports of Agents, Selectmen, Auditors and all other Town Officers, as contained in the Annual Report of Said Town of Colebrook for the year ending December 31, 1983.
- 49. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.

POLICE REPORT

February 6, 1984

To The Honorable Selectmen: Richard Hicks, Jr., Chairman Frank Owen William Weir

Gentlemen:

Again with pride, I present my annual budget and activity for the year 1983.

The Police Department was pleased that there were less thefts, as well as other serious crimes this year than last. We did cover more Motor Vehicle accidents this year than last, due to people being a little more careless, along with bad weather and road conditions. We were disturbed that we investigated one fatal Motor Vehicle accident.

During this past year, again I am pleased to have saved the Taxpayers of the Town of Colebrook money, due to savings throughout the Police Budget, and also, the effort and coordination between the Police Department and Selectmen.

This year, there was a large turnover in Police Officers. Sergeant Roland Streeter resigned in February, and was replaced by Officer Roger Pond, Sr., who will be resigning shortly to go into a full-time recruiting job with the National Guard. Jeffrey Cauller has been hired to replace Roger, as the third full-time patrolman. Jeff will be attending the Police Academy in Concord, New Hampshire, during this year.

Howard C. Weber and Randall Dobson have been hired this year as Special Police Officers. Both have completed the Part-time Police Officers School, held in Gorham, New Hampshire, during this year.

The new Jaws of Life tool, manned by the Colebrook Fire Department, was used once during the year, to free a young woman from a Motor Vehicle accident just across the town line in Columbia.

A group of concerned citizens are starting work on organizing a Humane Society. The Police are supportive and cooperating with this effort. Hopefully, in the near future, there will be a shelter provided for unwanted animals, and clinics set-up to have pets spayed or neutered.

Again, I would like to thank the Selectmen, the Citizens of the Town of Colebrook, for their continued support, guidance, and cooperation, in helping make our job easier. A thanks also, to Troopers Howard Weber, Robert Bruno, and John Barthelmes, of the New Hampshire State Police, Deputy Sheriff Thomas Pryor, the North Country REACT Team; whom during the year are a big help to the Police Department, the Colebrook Communications, for excellent dispatching and clerical work, and a special thanks to the members of my department.

With us all pulling together, let us make 1984 another safe and secure year.

COLEBROOK PUBLIC LIBRARY

Just under 24,000 books, magazines, records, tapes, patterns, puppets, and puzzles circulated during the year. This is a substantial increase over last year with a good percentage being from circulation of children's books and materials. Over 800 new books were purchased, donated or given as gifts in memory of a loved one. A book sale at Summerfest relieved us of discarded books and donated second-hand books that could not be used.

Frances Haynes, Children's Librarian, completed another two courses in the Public Library Techniques Program during the spring and fall.

Films were shown during the summer for young children, with a good turnout each week.

In early summer, the Kiwanis donated a sum of money to be used for early childhood development. Over 100 puppets and puzzles were purchased for children to take home, play with and return. These are circulated real well.

At the November meeting of the Statewide Library Program, I was elected chairperson for Forum I, the northern most region. At present the state library system is making several changes and adding new concepts including computer data retrieval and media-mobile vans to go to shut-ins and nursing and group homes.

We ended the year with Christmas story telling for preschoolers done several Saturday mornings by Rita Turner.
