State of New Hampshire TOWN OF CENTER HARBOR TOWN WARRANT

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Center Harbor in the County of Belknap in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Center Harbor Town House in said Center Harbor on Tuesday, the thirteenth day of March, next at two of the clock in the afternoon, to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
- 2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
- 3. To see how much money the Town will vote to raise for the Highway Department.
- 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise money for aid to the Laconia Hospital and if so how much.
- 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise money in the amount of \$2,500.00 for Welfare and Town Poor.
- 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise the sum of \$3,000.00 for maintenance of the Center Harbor Volunteer Fire Company.
- 7. To see if the Town will vote to accept State Aid Assistance for Class V Roads, the Town to raise \$253.63, the State to contribute \$1,690.85.
- 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise money for Parks & Playgrounds, including Band Concerts, and if so how much.

- 9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$128.38, which is 1/300 of 1% of the assessed valuation of the Town, to the Lakes Region Association.
- 10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,750.00 for street lighting throughout the town.
- 11. To see if the Town will vote to install two street lights on Maurice C. Chase Circle.
- 12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$2,000.00 for continuing the Piper Hill Road project.
- 13. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$2,000.00 for improvements of Canney Road.
- 14. To see if Town will vote to raise the sum of \$250.00 for care of shade trees and Blister Rust Control.
- 15. To see if Town will vote to accept approximately six feet of Gephart's Road and maintain same.
- 16. To see if Town will vote to authorize the selectmen to look into the possibilities of a public sewer system and if so, appropriate a sum of money therefor.
- 17. To see if the Town will vote to elect rather than appoint the road agent in the future. (By Request)
- 18. To see if the Town will vote to have a full time police, and if so appropriate money therefor.
- 19. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the selectmen to sell property acquired by Tax Collector's Deed.
- 20. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to hire money for Town purposes in anticipation of taxes.

- 21. To choose agents or committees in relation to any article in the Warrant and to hear reports of any here-to-fore chosen.
- 22. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

Forest Fire Warden's Report

AN APPEAL FROM YOUR FOREST FIRE WARDEN

In these days of constantly rising taxes and wages, any unnecessary expense is an added burden on everyone's pocket-book—yours and mine. Forest fires cost money and damage our valuable woodlands. Lightning sets some forest fires, but we have no control of lightning. Children may cause fires. Ninty-eight percent of our forest fires result from human carelessness—our carelessness. This, we—you and I can do somthing about.

When we require you to obtain a permit for out-of-doors burning or forbid you to burn on days of high fire danger or set up regulations—hours, etc., governing the use of the town dump we are simply protecting yours and the town's interests.

The ever present threat of forest fires is the concern of all of us; the responsibility for preventing them is ours and the costs of extinquishing are ours. We can do something about this problem, by being aware and alert to the danger and by cooperating with your warden.

Do the things that are required of you:

- 1. Follow the warden's directions.
- 2. Secure the required burning permit.
- 3. Keep your fires under control.
- 4. Completely extinquish your fires before leaving them.
- 5. See that your children are properly cautioned.

Everyone will benefit by it.
