

to Approve Change in ADD DROP procedures for Fall 2020

1. Motion presenter: Kevin Healey, on behalf of the Agenda Committee
2. Dates of Faculty Senate Discussion: 06/29/20
3. **Rationale:** UNH is planning for on-campus instruction for the Fall 2020; however, we are still facing the COVID-19 pandemic. The Academic Reopening Committee has recommended adjusting the ADD/DROP process for Fall 2020 in order to reduce the amount of contact between students, instructors, and the Registrar's office staff and to help maintain the COVID-19 classroom density recommendations. The Registrar's office has proposed a fully online process where students could use their Registration Access Code (RAC) for the Fall 2020 ADD/DROP process.
4. **Motion:** The Faculty Senate approves moving the Fall 2020 ADD/DROP process fully online for the Fall 2020 only as recommended by the Academic Reopening Committee in light of the COVID-19 pandemic.
5. **Senate Action:** The motion passed unanimously with 55 in favor, none opposed, and no abstentions.
