Town Warrant

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Exeter, in the County of Rockingham, in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs: [L. s.]

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Exeter on Tuesday, the eleventh day of March next, at ten of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

- 1st. To choose by ballot and plurality vote a town clerk.
- 2d. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one selectman for three years.
- 3d. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one trustee of the Robinson Female Seminary for the term of seven years.
- 4th. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one trustee of the trust funds held by the town of Exeter, to hold office for three years.
- 5th. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one trustee of the Swasey Parkway for three years.
- 6th. To choose all other necessary town officers, auditors, or committees for the ensuing year.
- 7th. To see what sums of money the town will raise and appropriate for the maintenance of the poor, for repairing highways, for repairing and building bridges, for repairing and building sidewalks, for building drains and sewers, for oiling streets, for payment of the town debt, for lighting streets, for defraying expenses of decorating the graves of soldiers, for pre-

venting the spread of insect pests within the town, for the control of the white pine blister disease, for the payment of firemen for the ensuing year, and for other charges arising within the town.

- 8th. To hear the reports of agents, auditors, and other officers and committees heretofore chosen and pass any vote arising therefrom.
- 9th. To see if the town will vote to authorize the town treasurer, with the approval of the selectmen, to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.
- 10th. To see if the town will vote to authorize the water commissioners, with the approval of the selectmen, to borrow money in anticipation of revenue.
- 11th. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the issuance and distribution of printed matter to call attention to the resources and natural advantages of the town and to assist on planning and development for the benefit of the town in co-operation with other towns co-ordinated in the Seacoast Regional Development Association the sum of five hundred dollars. (\$500.00)
- 12th. To see what action the town will take by ballot on the following question: "Shall the provisions of Chapter 171-A of the Revised Laws relative to playing games of beano be declared no longer in effect in this town."
- 13th. On petition of Henry W. Shute and sixteen others, to see if the town will vote to establish a Planning Board of five members to make a study of the town's present and potential development, with particular reference to the problems which are to arise out of the proposed Newington-Portsmouth Jet Air Base, and to report to the town, not later than the next Town Meeting, appropriate recommendations for the promotion and maintenance of the town's best interests. The board members shall consist of one selectman and four other citizens to be appointed by the selectmen.
- 14th. To determine the sentiment of the town in relation to the establishment of a military air base in the Portsmouth-

Newington area and to notify the Secretary of Defense for Air in Washington, D. C., of the same.

- 15th. On petition of Edward C. Becker and sixteen others, to see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to extend the sewer from the Pulver development to the Country Club Estates, including Douglas Way and Ridgecrest Drive and appropriate fifteen thousand six hundred dollars ((\$15,600) for same.
- 16th. On petition of James A. Tufts and twenty others, to see if the town will vote to extend the present sewer on High Street from front of the residence of Dr. George M. Johnson to the residence of James A. Tufts and appropriate the sum of three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500.00) for this purpose.
- 17th. On petition of Gerard Fournier and twelve others, to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of two thousand two hundred dollars (\$2,200.00) to install a sewer system on Morrow Street, from the sewer of Front Street, a distance of about 525 feet.
- 18th. On petition of Henry Shepard and ten others, to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200.00) to extend the sewer on Jady Hill Avenue from the existing manhole on the hill, to include Henry Shepard's residence, a distance of about 300 feet.
- 19th. On petition of Leslie H. Dining and ten others, to see if the town will vote to install a sewer on Gill Street connecting manhole on Linden Street with manhole in front of Morrison property on Gill Street and appropriate twelve hundred dollars (\$1200.00) for same.
- 20th. On petition of Oscar J. Pearson and twenty-five others, to see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to construct a sewer on Colonial Heights beginning at the intersection of Wheelwright Avenue and Thornton Street, running along Thornton Street to include Towle Avenue to Ann's Lane, then crossing property of Wendall and Dorothy Battles and of Elizabeth A. Smith to the existing manhole near the residence

- of Herman Smith on High Street, and to appropriate twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000.00) for same.
- 21st. On petition of Daniel Herlihy and ten others, to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) for the purpose of eight concerts to be played in the Swasey Pavillion by the Exeter Brass Band during the summer of 1952.
- 22d. On petition of Robert M. Swasey and eleven others, to see if the town of Exeter will vote to appropriate the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) for the purpose of spraying poison ivy along the streets and highways.
- 23d. To see if the town will authorize the selectmen to purchase a Resuscitator for the use of the town and appropriate the sum of five hundred and seventy dollars (\$570.00) for same.
- 24th. On petition of Elizabeth E. Kendall and nine others, to see if the town will vote to discontinue as a Public Highway a certain way running between Front and Maple Streets easterly of and adjacent to the premises of the United States Post Office, which highway was laid out on May 5, 1931, by the selectmen.
- 25th. On petition of Eugene E. Biele and eighteen others, to see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to reconstruct Crawford Avenue and appropriate twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2500.00) for same.
- 26th. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Water Commission, with the approval of the selectmen, to borrow a sum or sums not exceeding ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the purpose of providing for water main extensions to be made under contract with water takers, and to issue a note or notes therefor with principal payable in equal annual installments over a period not exceeding ten (10) years, and all other matters in connection with said notes to be left to the discretion of the water commissioners and selectmen.
- 27th. On petition of Lewis E. Fifield and eleven others, to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of six thousand dollars (\$6,000.00) for the purpose of extending the watermains on Portsmouth Avenue to the residence of

Elmer D. Frost and place a hydrant on same between the residence of Daniel Higgins and Lewis E. Fifield.

28th. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

Report of State Tax Commission DIVISION OF MUNICIPAL ACCOUNTING

Concord, New Hampshire, January 22, 1952.

Board of Selectmen, Exeter, New Hampshire

Gentlemen: Submitted herewith is the report of the annual audit and examination of the accounts of the Town of Exeter for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1951, which was made by this Division in accordance with the vote of the Town. Exhibits as hereafter listed are included as part of the report.

Scope of Audit

Included in the audit and examination were the accounts and records of the Board of Selectmen, Treasurer, Tax Collector, Town Clerk, Road Agent, Library Treasurer, Clerk of Municipal Court, Trustees of Swasey Parkway, Trustees of Trust Funds and Water Department.

Financial Statements

Comparative Balance Sheets — Dec. 31, 1950 - Dec. 31,

1951: (Exhibit A-1)

Comparative Balance Sheets as of December 31, 1950, and December 31, 1951, are presented in Exhibit A-1. As indicated therein the Net Debt decreased by \$29,028.64 during the year, 1951.

Comparative Statements of Appropriations and Expenditures — Estimated and Actual Revenues:

Comparative statements of appropriations and expenditures, estimated and actual revenues for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1951, are presented in Exhibits A-3 and A-4. As indicated by the budget summary (Exhibit A-4), a net revenue surplus of \$7,864.31, less a net overdraft of appropriations of \$7,496.17, resulted in a net budget surplus of \$368.14.

Summary of Receipts and Expenditures: (Exhibit B-1)

A summary of receipts and expenditures for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1951, made up in accordance with the uniform classification of accounts, is included in Exhibit B-1. Proof of the Treasurer's balance, as of December 31, 1951, is indicated in Exhibit B-2.

Statement of Bonded Debt: (Exhibit K-1)

A statement of bonded debt, as of December 31, 1951, showing annual debt service requirements, is contained in Exhibit K-1.

Water Department: (Exhibits L-1, L-2 and L-3)

The Water Department section of the report is included in Exhibits L-1, L-2 and L-3.

Audit Procedure

The accounts and records of all town officials charged with the custody, receipt and disbursement of public funds were examined and audited. Vouchers and cancelled checks were compared with supporting invoices and payrolls as well as entries in the books of record. Receipts were checked by source insofar as possi-

ble and totals of receipts and expenditures verified. Book balances were verified by comparison with reconciled bank balances made from statements obtained from depository banks. Verification of uncollected taxes was made by mailing notices to delinquent taxpayers as indicated by the Collector's records.

General Comments

Current Deficit - Surplus:

It is noted that the current financial condition of the Town was improved during the year, 1951, which started with a current deficit of \$9,331.32 and closed with a current surplus of \$540.64, as shown herewith:

It is with considerable pride and pleasure that I report the circulation of books continued to rise higher than the previous year. The increase of three thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight, (3,828) in the juvenile department seemed phenominal when one realizes that television does effect our children's reading. The adult department showed an increase of two thousand four hundred and ninety four, (2,494) which is most gratifying.

We received two substantial amounts of books from the Alice Davis Estate and Mrs. Burt Folsom's Estate. From the former were mysteries and several excellent non-fiction works, and from the latter valuable books for the genealogical room. There have been other gifts from numerous people which were much appreciated.

The display case in the reference room which is taken care of by the Exeter Historical Society has had four exhibits this year. Under the able planning of Mr. William Dudley the following were shown: collection of old views and maps of Exeter; old fire apparatus, supplied by the Exeter Fire Department; early lighting gadgets, lights and old matches, antiques, needle cases, pin cases. cushions and old boxes.

We have reserved a small space in the rotunda for books about Great Britain and by British authors. This has been done at the request of the English Speaking Union. So far it has been well received by the patrons of the library.

The principal of the Academy, Mr. William Saltonstall and the Exeter Library Committee will be hosts for the New Hampshire Library Association Annual Meeting to be held on May 8th and 9th of 1952. Your librarian retired from the office of secretary of the association in May and the Davis librarian, Mr. Rodney Armstrong, was appointed auditor for two years.

The juvenile department has been very active during 1951. Pupils from the Exeter Day School and Court Street School have paid us a visit. The Seminary and High Schools have received their instructions on how to use the facilities of the library. The Court Street

School invited Mrs. Summerfield to two of their special programs. The Girl Scouts were taught how to mend books and the proper way to open a new book. As a result several came in to assist with our mending.

There have been the usual story hours on Saturday afternoon. Two Girl Scouts told stories at one meeting and six children reviewed books at another. We wish to thank the people who gave of their time to read to the children.

I wish to thank the library committee and staff for their continued support and fine cooperation.

Report of Water Commissioners

The Board of Water Commissioners is pleased to present herewith a report of the activities of the Water Department during the year, 1951. Since last year's report practically all of the proposed major improvements to the system have been completed and put into operation. In addition to those mentioned in the Superintendent's Report, an unplanned but very worthwhile project was the thorough cleaning and painting of the old standpipe on Prospect Hill.

The Commissioners feel that the Underwriters' report of flow tests made on November 15th reflect better than anything else the improved service available to the citizens of Exeter. A comparison of these figures with tests from the same hydrants in 1949 is given below.

This chart clearly shows that, with the exception of the last two hydrants named, there is adequate flow for excellent fire protection. The Commissioners plan to enlarge the High Street and Jady Hill mains as soon as funds are available.

The financial structure of the Department has been weakened by the unprecedented demand for new extensions and service renewals. The lack of time necessary to build up a depreciation reserve has worked a hardship whenever old equipment has had to be re-

placed. The greatly increased cost of material has made the use of a fixed budget practically unworkable.

In closing, the Commissioners wish to remind the citizens of Exeter that they should take pride in the foresight which prompted them to purchase the Exeter Water Works when they did. Under present shortages and prices a complete renovation of the system would be impossible today.

To the Board of Water Commissioners:

I herewith submit my report as Superintendent for

the year ending Dec. 31, 1951.

The year 1951 was one of much activity in the Water Department. It saw the completion of the new 1,000,000 gallon standpipe on Epping Road, the completion and putting into operation of the new Layne gravel packed well in Gilman Park, the installation of a new 750-gallon per minute gasoline driven standby pump at the Portsmouth Avenue station and the installation of several main extensions. These installations have made a great improvement in the water system in which the people of Exeter should feel proud.

The water from the new well is of excellent quality as shown by the several analysis made by the state board of health. We have had several complaints of color and taste especially from customers living on or near the ends of the system. The cause is the rust that has come off from the walls of the old pipes. This has been driven into those sections by the new water which is somewhat different than the old and by the change in direction of flow. We believe that this con-

dition will soon be corrected.

Every one is pleased with the increase in pressure and rates of flow which will be reflected in lower insurance rates.
