

SELECTMEN'S REPORT

The chief concern of the Selectmen has been the consistent increase in our tax rate. Between 1964, the year of reappraisal, through 1967, the taxes have risen from \$28.00 to \$41.80 and can see no immediate relief.

Last fall, in an attempt to alleviate this situation, we took a positive approach to the introduction of industry in Atkinson. We appointed an Industrial Director, who also acts as Chairman of the Economic Industrial Commission. Following a meeting with members of the Industrial Commission and the Planning Board, the Selectmen directed them to prepare a map showing areas zoned specifically for industry and to recommend amendments to the zoning ordinances as required for presentation to this Town Meeting. The results of their efforts will be presented to residents by ballot on March 12.

We urge all townspeople, after carefully considering our financial status, to give their approval to these amendments.

For the first time in three years, the Selectmen found it impossible to stay within the appropriated budget voted at the last Town Meeting. The heavy snowfall of last Spring and this past Fall was the main reason, and a contributing factor was the deterioration of the resurfacing project of Sawyer Avenue. Emergency measures had to be taken to make the road usable and this, of course, was not allowed for in our budget.

On the pleasanter side, we wish to congratulate Bi-Centennial Chairman, Robert H. Moore and members of the bi-centennial committee for an unforgettable week of activities in commemoration of our 200th anniversary.

REPORT OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

Again, it is my pleasure to submit my annual report as Chief of the Atkinson Fire Department.

New equipment purchased this past year included two new fire ladders for Tankers 1 and 2, a smoke ejector and two new fog nozzles. New hose was also purchased for replacement, and 600' of one inch hose for the forestry truck.

Thru the efforts of the Women's Auxiliary of the fire department, we are purchasing an additional resuscitator head for dual resuscitation, also a 6' projection screen for training aid films.

In addition to our own training program, a training course was given our department by Mr. A. W. Dick, Instructor from the State Fire Training Service. This course included ladder instruction, rescue work, smoke mask and resuscitator practice and use.

Work has started on our new training area at the rear of the fire house. The land has been bulldozed and leveled in preparation for a training tower and pit fire tank to be built this year. All payment for this project will be from proceeds from the Annual Firemen's Ball, Annual Turkey Raffle and activities of this sort.

During Bicentennial Week the firemen ran a four-day carnival at Sagris Field. The Junior Fire Department - under the leadership of their advisor, Charles Kinney - sponsored the Firemen's Muster.

Fire Prevention Week, fire department members held tours of the fire house for the kindergartens of Atkinson and Plaistow, and the first grade from Rockwell School. Trucks and various fire fighting equipment were shown and demonstrated to the children. A surprise fire drill was held at both our town schools. Thru the cooperation of Mr. Yeaton and the department, the alarm was sounded at school and a call was made to the red network for men and trucks to respond to a mock fire in the basement of the school. Thru the efforts of good fire drills at school, the building was orderly emptied of all children in 1-1/2 minutes. Trucks and firemen arrived and proceeded to fight a mock fire in the basement of the school. A demonstration was also made using the fire extinguishers at the school.

I must emphasize again that there can be no outside burning between 9 A.M. and 5 P.M. A permit must be obtained for all outdoor fires. These permits may now be obtained from Forest Fire Warden, Daniel Stewart or any one of the following Deputy Forest Fire Wardens - Wilbur Moody, Meredith Reynolds, William Kinney or Warren Kolb.

No power oil burner shall be installed or replaced without first obtaining a permit from the Atkinson Fire Department. To the inhabitants of the Town of Atkinson, in the County of Rockingham, in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Grange Hall in said Atkinson on Tuesday, the 12th day of March next at ten o'clock in the forenoon, and close not earlier than seven p.m. to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the coming year.

2. To see if the Town will vote to adopt the amendments to the zoning ordinances as proposed by the Planning Board. (By Ballot)

3. To see if the Town will vote to establish an annual salary of \$400 for the Town Treasurer.

4. To see if the Town will vote to establish an annual salary of 200 for the Town Clerk.

5. To see if the Town will vote to establish a salary for the Tax Collector for taxes collected, using the formula of one per cent for the first \$100,000.00 and one half of one per cent for each additional dollar.

6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,200 for the replacement of the heating unit at the Kimball Library.

7. To see if the Town will vote to increase the salaries of the Auditors from \$50 to \$100 each, per year.

8. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,800 for additional work on Sawyer Avenue by adding shoulders where necessary, to correct the dip by adding fill for approximately 300 feet and for resurfacing the street.

9. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$250 for the purchase of street signs.

10. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,500 to remove what remains of the old bridge located on Westside Drive and to install an additional length of culvert to improve the area. (Without Recommendation)

11. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$750 to supplement \$600 raised at the 1967 Town Meeting to install a wet hydrant on land located on Sawyer Avenue, between Meadow Lane and Highland Road, and a dry hydrant at another location.

12. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$400 as matching funds to an equal amount raised by the Atkinson Police Association for the purpose of replacing the base radio station and remote control unit.

13. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$3,000 from the unencumbered surplus funds remaining at the end of the fiscal year, 1967, to the Capital Reserve Fund established in 1966 for the purpose of acquiring a fire pumper.

14. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$452.00 as our share of the annual budget of the Seacoast Regional Development Association. Without Recommendation.

15. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$50.85 for our share of the Rockingham County Community Action Program. Without Recommendation.

16. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray Town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations for the same.

17. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Town Treasurer, with the approval of the Selectmen, to hire such sums of money as the Town will need in anticipation of taxes.

18. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to administer, sell or otherwise dispose of any real estate acquired by tax title or otherwise, either by private sale or public auction, providing that if such property is to be sold at public auction, then the same shall be advertised 15 days in advance of sale with notice there-of posted in three public places.

19. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a parcel of land located at the corner of Woodlawn Avenue and Academy Avenue to the Recreation Commission to be used for recreation purposes.

20. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen and Planning Board to take the necessary steps to join a regional planning group.





REPORT OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

The year of 1967 was a relatively busy one for the Police Department, and increasingly busier than the past years. In addition to the increased road patrols throughout the town and pond area, an additional number of man hours were added to the departmental problem, with the Bi-Centennial Celebration in September.

We are still plagued with an ever increasing number of house breaks, necessitating more and more road patrolling by the men of the department.

Sixty-one cases were processed in the Plaistow Municipal Court during the year, the major portion of these cases were motor vehicle, resulting from the intensified road patrolling.

The Blue Network telephone system was kept busy with numerous calls ranging from requests for hours at the Library, Town Clerk's Office, telephone numbers of local doctors, will there be school, who issues hunting and fishing licenses, etc. A total of two hundred and forty-seven telephone calls were received and the Department personnel responded to over sixty-five complaints of varied natures and covered some twenty-two motor vehicle accidents and investigations.

A total of forty-seven telephone calls were received from persons informing us that they were leaving on vacation or would be away from their homes for a specified period of time.

During the year, the Department purchased a mobile radio from the Sheriff's Department, this purchase was made possible through utilizing funds from the Police Association. This mobile radio was installed in the Chief's vehicle and the State Police radio was removed from the Chief's vehicle and re-installed in the Deputy Chief's vehicle, thereby affording our Department direct radio communication with the State Police and Rockingham County Sheriff's Department.

I wish to take this opportunity to thank the people of Atkinson for their cooperation, throughout the year, especially during the Halloween period, for providing entertainment for the younger generation, as a result of this, the malicious mischief and vandalism was greatly reduced in town.

To the members of the Department, I extend my thanks and commendations for a job well done.

REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES OF THE KIMBALL PUBLIC LIBRARY

The Trustees of the Kimball Public Library met in February, April and October with Mrs. Elgin Reynolds, Librarian.

In February, Mrs. Reynolds distributed typewritten copies of a set of policies for Library Practice formulated by the Trustees in 1966, in accordance with recommendations made by the State Library Commission for affiliated libraries.

These policies stated the general objectives of the library, the basic rules governing personnel and other internal rules of the library and the selection of books. A copy of these policies will be sent to the State Library Commission in 1968.

Mrs. Dyke has served again as Chairman of the Board of Trustees, and has represented the Board at the Southeast District Advisory Council meetings held in Derry every other month during the year. One or more members of the Board have attended the district book meetings and have reported on the topics presented such as the use of Paper Back Books, the Pamphlet File and how to encourage the return of over-due books.

Two members of the Board were able to attend the First Annual Meeting of the New Hampshire Library Council, an all day meeting held in October at the Wayfarer Motel in Bedford, N. H. Mr. Samuel Molod, Associate State Librarian from Connecticut was the principal speaker on the topic "Total Library Service." The meeting was open to Librarians, Library Trustees and Friends of the Library, and was well attended.

During the year, the Trustees discussed and authorized various repairs on the library building, notably the repair of the porch railing. The Trustees also discussed the Library Budget to be presented at the Town Budget hearing in February, 1968 and approved the recommendation made by the Librarian for a study of the heating needs of the library building. They recommended that a request for an appropriate sum to provide for adequate heating of the library building be put into the Town Budget.

REPORT OF THE PLANNING BOARD

On top of the regular monthly meetings on the third Monday of each month to which any citizen is welcome, your Planning Board has had a very active year with a flurry of Public Hearings with the idea of making the Zoning Ordinance more realistic and in keeping with more recent developments. You will find on your ballot many questions about amendments to the Zoning Ordinance to which the Board wishes you to give honest thoughtful attention with the idea of what is best for the town and if not at the present, what will be best for you as a part of the town.

The first of these amendments concerns the words "Cost and Value." Our regulations now say "cost." We believe that the word "value" would be more appropriate and cover the value of the owner's time.

The second of these amendments concerns the floor level square footage. Your Board feels that 600 square feet is too small an area for a family, and are asking you to raise this square footage to 800. This will have a tendency to upgrade the houses in the Town. We also believe that any new construction in the Seasonal area should have its footage increased from 400 to 600.

The third amendment is added in order to keep the Residential Area on an uncrowded basis. Here, with the cooperation of the Health Officer, to have better sanitary facilities, we are asking you to place a limit of only one house on an acre lot. As you will remember a couple years ago, we were working on Garden type and cluster zoning, and you objected strenuously. This will prevent, for the present, that type of development although we still believe that such a type of development, if done wisely, would be of definite tax benefit to the Town.

The last group of amendments have developed out of some very good research on the part of the Industrial Commission, Albert Habif, Chairman. This group has presented some rather dramatic changes in the structure of the Town with an eye on the future, and a thought of helping to keep the tax structure more under control. These ideas are primarily to allow some industry in the Town. At the present time it is prohibited except for home industry and certain activities present before the Zoning Ordinance was passed.

These latter changes involve about 12% of the Western periphery of the Town in establishing a new District called Commercial-Industrial. There are seven of these districts as shown on the map. Those nearer the major highways are the more important, especially the areas 1, 2, and 3. Area 3 is important because of the availability of millions of gallons of water daily.

Your Board has also drawn up some regulations to control any objectionable industry which might like to settle here.

We hope that the voters of the Town will go along with us on this project. If it does not seem to be going in the right direction, we can always revert back to the old status. Under the Enabling Act, all it requires is a petition of 25 registered voters to bring any amendment to the Planning Board and to a vote of the whole Town. Copies of all these latter amendments are posted at the Selectmen's Office along with maps.

The Board wishes to assure the residents that they have put in many long hours with no other compensation other than the satisfaction of a job well done. We hope you will feel the same way and pass these amendments.

REPORT OF THE HEALTH OFFICER

Your town has, during 1967, been relatively free of contagious disease.

As far as I know, at this time, there are very few problems with the sanitary systems of the existing houses. If there are any, I would appreciate knowing about them.

It would be well for the people to know that there has been considerable antipollution legislation passed on the State level, and this does affect a certain number of projects in the Town. This new law makes it mandatory for anyone building or rebuilding within 1,000 feet of any stream, pond, lake, river or even on the crest of the watershed to have surveys made and submitted to the State Department of Public Health in Concord before any building is started. Once these plans have been approved and construction of the leach beds completed, except for fill, your Health Agent has been appointed to make the final inspection.

REPORT OF THE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION

During 1967 the Industrial Commission was reorganized with a charter to accelerate their activities. The Commission's goal was to present a plan for industrial development to the Planning Board in time, so that some action could be taken by the people of the Town by spring.

Numerous meetings were held among the Commission members, and also conferences were held with State officials, seeking their advice with respect to acceptable areas to be designated for industrial development.

The most desirable areas are those along main highways, along railroads, and near super highways.


The results of the studies and conversations of the Commission are shown on the map by seven areas for industrial development and one area for commercial development.

The reasons the members of the commission designated the proposed areas are listed:

- A. Areas 1, 2, and 3 were proposed because of Highway 111. As can be seen, area 3 includes the land along the proposed route.
- B. There have been many inquiries in connection with the Gibson property, and all inquiries have indicated a need for property in Atkinson. For this reason, areas 4 and 5 have been proposed.
- C. Area 6 is proposed because it is the nearest to Highway 495.
- D. Area 7 is the only property in Atkinson adjacent to a railroad.
- E. Because the Commission felt that Atkinson would experience considerable growth, they felt that some central area should be designated as commercial so that members of the Town could satisfy many of their shopping needs without traveling outside the Town. This area is designated (D).

REPORT ON BICENTENNIAL WEEK

On August 28, 1967, Atkinson's 200th birthday festivities began. Preceding the hectic happenings of these eight eventful days were fourteen months of planning and plodding by many people. The fourteen months were marked by problems, setbacks and disappointments. Looking back, it seems little short of miraculous that the celebration ever actually became a reality. The reason it did was that there were always enough people who felt that this was important - and who cared enough to make it happen.

Bicentennial Week started in a beautiful way - with a Flower Show sponsored by the Atkinson Garden Club. There were also historical and art exhibits at the Kimball Library. Tuesday evening, the Boy Scout Court of Honor was held out-of-doors.

Wednesday was exciting, starting with the afternoon motorcade through Atkinson with visiting Miss New Hampshire. The motorcade finished at the chicken barbecue. In the evening, Wright's Field and a pleasant summer evening sky provided the backdrop for the colorful re-enactment of The Original Town Meeting, with special guest of honor, Governor John W. King. After the open air town meeting, there was wonderful cake, coffee and barbershop harmonizing by the Haverhill Barbershop Quartet.

Thursday saw a real old Country Auction in full swing, and ended with a glorious evening of music at Dyke Auditorium, as the Atkinson Women's Club presented the Timberlane Choral Society.

Children's Day was Friday, and what a day it was. It was games, contests, prizes and fun. In the afternoon, the carnival, sponsored by the Atkinson Volunteer Fire Department, got underway. Teenagers had their special dance on Friday night, and this featured a battle of the bands. Wow!

Saturday - The Big Parade! Several thousand people lined the two-mile parade route, and afterwards summed it up as "the best parade they had ever seen." U. S. Senator Norris Cotton was special guest of honor and rode in the parade - as did George H. Mason, 91, Atkinson's oldest citizen. (Mr. Mason has since passed away, but none enjoyed this day more than he).

The Atkinson Grange sponsored an Old-Fashioned Bean Supper, and after two capacity feedings, had to turn customers away.

Saturday evening, colorful costumes highlighted the occasion, as the Bicentennial Costume Ball magically turned our town into an Atkinson of 1767. It was truly a night to remember!

Ecumenical Church Service was held Sunday afternoon at the Atkinson Congregational Church, followed by a reception in the parsonage. Sunday also featured an Old-fashioned Clambake, and ended with an exciting display of fireworks.

Labor Day began with the Firemen's Parade, but the feature event was the big Firemen's Muster sponsored by the Atkinson Junior Fire Department. It included

11 hand-tub entries, some from as far away as Bath, Maine. Beard judging and Shaveoff climaxed the week-long celebration.

The enthusiasm which greeted all phases of the 8-day celebration indicated that Atkinson's 200th Birthday Party was thoroughly enjoyed and will be long remembered.

Note: On Friday evening, February 9, 1968, the final meeting of the Atkinson Bicentennial Committee was held. It was voted unanimously to donate the balance in the treasury (\$1,143.91) to the Atkinson Recreation and Conservation Commission to benefit the town in its recreation program.
