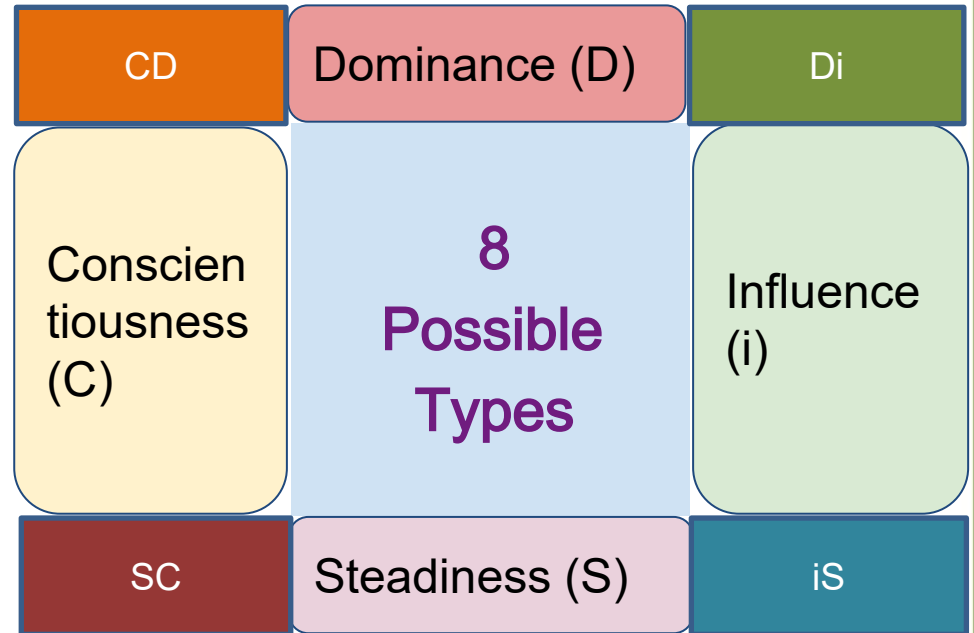

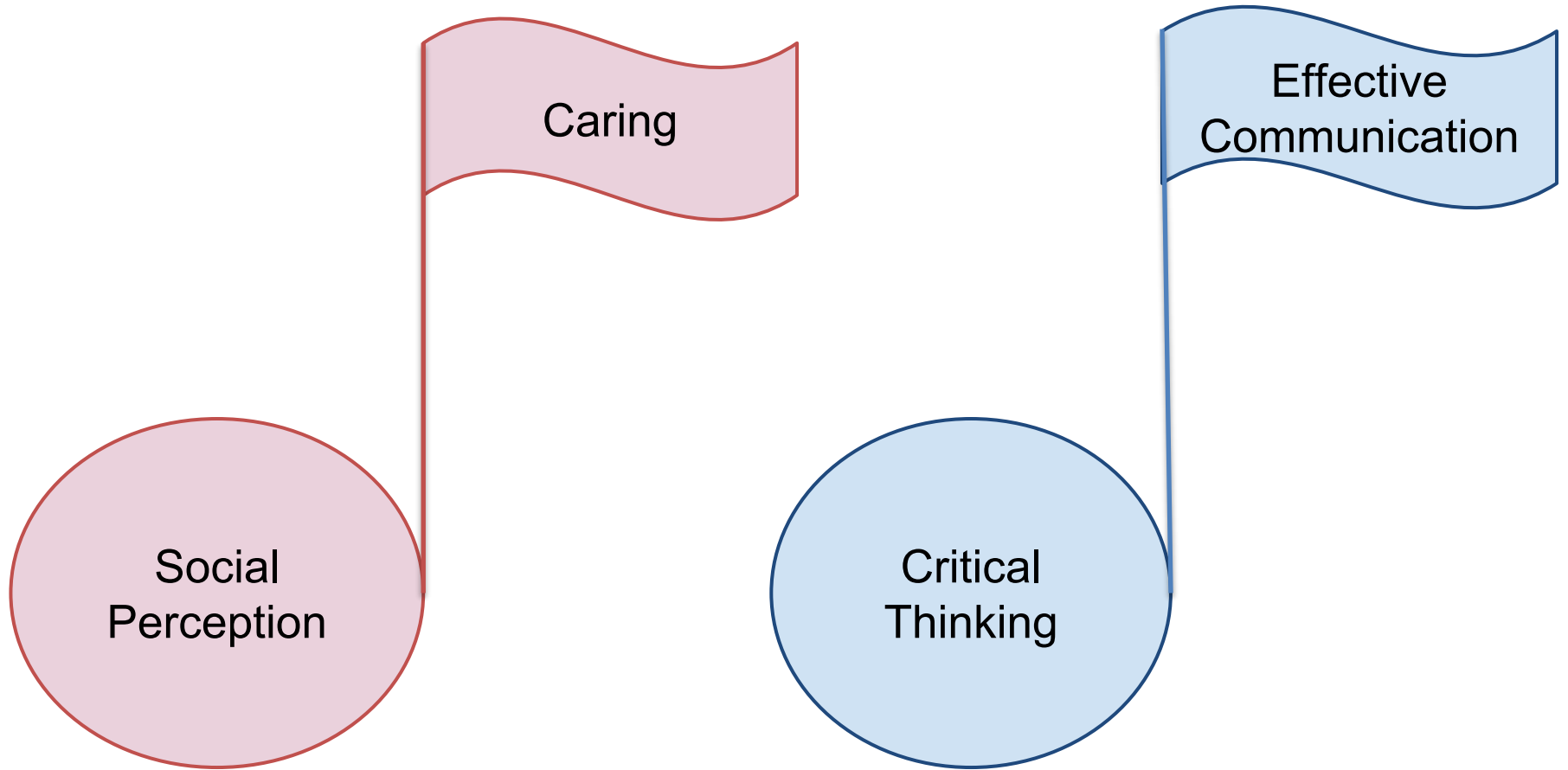
Enneagram

- Type three - Self-projection


- Type four - Self-expression

- Type nine - Mediation (balance)


