SELECTMEN'S REPORT

We are pleased to point out that 1978 has been, in our opinion, a good year for the Town of Deering. The tax rate for the last three years has been stable and this year it was a little lower than previously. However, due to many factors this fortunate situation cannot continue. The new building program of the Hillsboro-Deering Cooperative School, increased material costs of the highway department, higher fuel oil and utility costs, increased insurance costs -- all mitigate against this eventuality.

During the year there was more work done to renovate the town hall. Much of the old wiring has been replaced and additional furniture and equipment have been purchased. The front stairway as well as the Town Clerk and Tax Collector's office has been refurbished. Currently the old Selectmen's office on the ground floor is being converted into a serviceable kitchenette.

We believe that the Highway Department has done an excellent job in keeping the roads open under the very adverse weather conditions of this and last year. We anticipate that the Town will be obliged to provide hospitalization insurance for the employees of the Highway Department. Then too, sub-divisions may require more road maintenance. At this point we should like to commend Gordon (Skip) Rich for outstanding service to the Town in his capacity as Road Agent during the past six years.

We would like to emphasize that the law requires that Property Inventory Forms be filed by April 15th. Delinquents will be subject to a penalty and will forfeit any right of appeal. The Inventory Form is enclosed with each Annual Town Report. New applicants for Open Space however, must request the appropriate form from the office of the Selectmen.

The ordinance concerning abandoned vehicles as well as the ordinance prohibiting overnight parking on Town roads from November 1st to April 1st are still in effect.

We urge each property owner who has had his property surveyed to submit a copy of his map to the Selectmen. This will enable us to keep the Town Tax Map current.

It is our hope that the Town will continue to grow, but in an orderly, planned manner, so that Deering will retain its rural quality.

TOWN WARRANT

To the inhabitants of the Town of Deering in the County of Hillsborough, in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs,

GREETINGS:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Deering on Tuesday, the 13th day of March next, at 12:00 P.M. (Noon) to act upon the following subjects:

Article 1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the ensuing year. Polls will open at 12:00 P.M. (Noon) and will remain open until 6:00 P.M. (The polls may be continued to be open following the above hour by vote of the Meeting, but may not be closed before the hour of 6:00 P.M. - RSA 39:2).

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to adopt the Floodplain Building and Development Regulations as proposed by the Planning Board? (Ballot Question).

Additionally, pursuant to RSA 39:2a and the vote of the Town at the March 8, 1976 Annual Meeting, you are hereby notified that Article 3 through 28 will be taken up at 7:30 P.M.

(All Articles hereinafter are submitted by the Selectmen unless otherwise noted.)

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to accept the reports of the Town Officers, Agents, Committees, and Auditors for the year 1978.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the following sums of money: Town Officers Salaries \$9800.; Town Officers Expenses \$9500.; Election and Registration \$500.; Town Buildings and the purchase of office equipment \$5500.; Social Security Payments \$3500.; Insurance \$7800.; Damages and Legal Expenses \$1000.; Dog Expenses \$400.; Dumps and Trash Removal \$8250.; Vital Statistics \$25.; Street Lighting \$1600.; Library \$35.; Town Poor \$1000.; Old Age Assistance \$1000.; Aid to Permanently and Totally Disabled \$1000.; Cemetery Care \$1000.; and to raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary to defray Town charges for the year 1979 or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to auction property taken by Tax Collector's Deeds, in accordance with the provisions of RSA 80:42.

Article 7. To see if the Town will vote to continue membership in the Central New Hampshire Regional Planning Commission and raise and appropriate the sum of \$540. for the Town's share of the operating costs of said Commission, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$400. for the current operating expenses of the Planning Board and the sum of \$250. for the current operating expenses of the Conservation Commission, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500. for continuing and making corrections to the Town Tax Map, which is required by RSA 31:95a, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$9500. for the Police Department, the sum of \$4000. for the Fire Department, and the sum of \$200. for Civil Defense, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$200. for the support of the Hillsboro Rescue Squad and the sum of \$100. for the Weare Rescue Squad, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$200. as the Town's share of the Hillsboro District Nursing Association, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 13. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3500. to continue the renovations of the Town Hall, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 14. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the following sums of money for Highway purposes: (1) \$47,500. for Road Maintenance; (2) \$16,000. for the General Expenses of the Highway Department; (3) \$9000. for Road Sealing; and to raise by State Grant, Highway Subsidy, and appropriate the sum of \$13,353.90 to be used for the maintenance of Town Highways under the provisions of RSA 241:14 as amended; and to further raise by State Grant, Highway Subsidy, and appropriate the sum of \$8,658.10 to be used for the maintenance of Town Highways under the provisions of RSA 214:15 as amended, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 15. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1240.02 to secure Town Road Aid (State Share \$8266.78) or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 16. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$30,000. for the construction of a new Town Garage, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 16a. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$30,000. for the construction of a new Town Garage, and to raise such sum by the issuance of bonds or notes under and in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 33, as amended, New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated (Municipal Finance Act), and to authorize the Selectmen to determine the date and place of payment of such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon, and to take such steps as may be necessary to negotiate such bonds or notes as shall be to the best interests of the Town, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 17. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2000. as the Town's share of a Communication Dispatch Center to be located in the Town of Hillsboro, to serve the Town's Police and Fire departments, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 18. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$5000. for a Highway Equipment Capital Reserve Fund and authorize the withdrawal of this sum for this purpose from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 19. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$5000. for a Fire Truck Capital Reserve Fund and authorize the withdrawal of this sum for this purpose from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 20. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate and authorize withdrawal from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972 for use as setoffs against budget appropriations in the amount indicated; and, further to authorize the Selectmen to make pro-rata reductions in the amounts if estimated entitlements are reduced, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 21. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate and authorize withdrawal from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972

for use as setoffs against budget appropriations in the amount indicated; and further to authorize the Selectmen to make pro-rata increases in the amounts if estimated entitlements are increased or pro-rata reductions in the amounts if the estimated entitlements are reduced, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 22. To see if the Town will vote to rescind the adoption of the building permit ordinance adopted under Article 30 at the March 12, 1968 Annual Town Meeting, and as subsequently amended, and in place thereof, adopt the following new Building Permit Ordinance in accordance with the Provisions of N.H. RSA 31:39 and N.H. RSA 156

Town of Deering
Building Permit Ordinance

Section 1. The Board of Selectmen shall be the Building Inspector for the Town of Deering.

Section 2. No person, firm or corporation shall erect, construct, enlarge, alter, improve, move or demolish any building or structure within the Town of Deering without first obtaining a separate building permit for each building or structure from the Board of Selectmen.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of \$10.00 and each day's neglect to obtain such a permit shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 4. Appeals shall be as provided in N.H. RSA 156:4a, b and c.
or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 23. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to apply for and accept grants of Federal or State Aid, or both, relative to disasters, civic improvement, highway safety, and the detection, deterrence and apprehension of crime or criminals, any or all, as may be available, and to do all things necessary to carry out this Article, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 24. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to accept or purchase on behalf of the Town any Federal or State surplus fire or highway equipment, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 25. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to trade, sell or otherwise dispose of any surplus Town property, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 26. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to grant a franchise to erect, install and maintain in, under, or over streets, highways, and other public ways of the Town, wires, cable, and other equipment related to the delivery of enhancement of television signals and other electrical impulses in accordance with New Hampshire Law RSA 53-C:1 (Supp. 1974)., or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 27. To see what photograph or picture the Town will vote to place on the cover of the next annual Town Report, or to take any other action relating thereto.

Article 28. To transact any other business that may legally be brought before this meeting.

CONSERVATION COMMISSION REPORT

The Deering Conservation Commission recognizes with great appreciation the many years of effort given by Lotte Jacobi and Tom Copadis who retired in the spring of 1978.

Ms. Jacobi was the last charter member to serve on the Commission, filling that capacity since the inception of the commission. Mr. Copadis has worked diligently for several years as secretary/treasurer. Both have been notably instrumental in the designation of a number of Deering roads as scenic according to statutory provisions.

Neale Bacon and Jean Feather were the new appointees to the Commission.

Townspople voted at Town Meeting to designate Bartlett Hill Road and Pleasant Pond Road as Scenic under the provisions of RSA 253:17 & 18.

In early May trash was collected from Deering roads by over 50 participants in our Annual Clean-Up Day. The morning's work was followed by a softball game and lunch served at the Deering Community Church Hall.

A Public Hearing was held in late May to review proposed alterations to Glen Road, previously designated a Scenic Road. The Commission members voted unanimously to approve the necessary tree removal and trimming for the installation of the power lines, which was done under the direction of a Selectman/Planning Board member and Conservation Commission member.

Under the sponsorship of the Commission, Rebecca Ramsay attended a week of Conservation Camp at Interlocken in Hillsboro Upper Village. Enthusiastically reporting on the week's events, she described her experience as a rewarding one.

The annual meeting of the New Hampshire Association of Conservation Commissions in Concord was attended by Neale Bacon,

Marguerite Dutton and William Kulbacki in the fall of 1978.

Members of the Conservation Commission have been attending the Planning Board meetings in order to act as a liason between the two groups.

Recently, Jean Feather resigned from the Commission and Polly Pierce is welcomed as her replacement.

The Health Officer first became acquainted with the Deering Lake as a young boy, fishing winter and summer, skating, swimming and boating. It has been interesting watching the lake shore grow from just a few cottages near the dam to the present numerous fine cottages all around the lake. The orderly growth especially with respect to pollution control is a credit to the lake people and the Town of Deering.

It is good to see the lake being used more during the winter for not only ice fishing but for skimobiling and especially by property owners. Where problems for suitable trails and safe parking exist, perhaps reasonable solutions can be found through the office of the Board of Selectmen.

Persons planning to build in Deering are reminded to check first with the New Hampshire Water Supply and Pollution Control Commission and also obtain a Building Permit from the Selectmen's Office.

The Health Officer again asks that any Deering resident or non-resident who has a question or problem relating to the health and well being of the community, which is everyone's business, please feel free to contact him.

On 1978 Town Meeting Day WELCOME HOME TO DEERING, NEW HAMPSHIRE (Deering's two century history) was distributed to those who had reserved copies and to others purchasing them at the time. Copies were on sale at the Church Fair in August too.

315 books have been sold and a dozen complimentary copies have been distributed to the author, members of the editorial committee, Phelps Studio for the use of their photos, and to the Monadnock Committee on the Bicentennial, a condition of their grant.

We have over 400 copies still for sale. They may be obtained at the Town Treasurer's office when she is at the Town Hall and at Mrs. Heath's home as well as by mail, addressing your request to Mrs. Heath. Extra maps and trivets are for sale.

As Historian several old Town Reports were sent to the University of New Hampshire Library, and information about Deering's cemeteries was sent to the Old Graveyard Association. Information was also given by phone.

REPORT OF THE FOREST FIRE WARDEN AND DISTRICT CHIEF

For more than 80 years, a cooperative effort between the State of New Hampshire and local forest fire authorities has created a forest fire prevention and suppression program that is recognized as superior throughout the United States.

Since the first forest fire laws were written in 1895, the state and local community governments have worked together to prevent and combat forest fires.

Today, 249 forest fire wardens and more than 1,800 deputy wardens are appointed every three years by the State Forester to work with the members of the State Forest Fire staff in this effort. State funds are used to pay one-half the cost of forest fire suppression costs incurred by local forest fire organizations, within pay rates established by the Governor and Council. State funds matched by local funds are used to purchase hand tools to suppress forest fires, to train local forest fire crews and in forest fire prevention work.

All outside burning, when the ground is not covered with snow, is permitted only after obtaining a written fire permit from your local Forest Fire Warden. Penalty for burning without a permit when one is required is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine up to \$1,000 or a jail term of up to one year or both.

PLANNING BOARD REPORT

1978 was another busy year for the Planning Board. Twelve subdivisions were considered. Ten were approved as presented, one was partly approved and partly disapproved, and one was approved in 1979. These 12 subdivisions created 28 additional lots.

We were pleased to have good participation by the Townspeople at our hearings as well as at our regular meetings. We welcome visitors at our meetings held the second Wednesday of each month (except August) at 7:30 P.M. in the Town Hall.

Our public hearings have convinced us that the people of Deering do not want rapid development. We have found that our existing regulations are inadequate to prevent some undesirable growth. Recent New Hampshire Supreme Court rulings indicate a willingness to help Towns control growth only if they have complied with State regulations and lawful local regulations. With that in mind we have spent many hours revising our regulations so that we can prevent subdivisions which would cause the Town unreasonable expense. We have also shifted more of the expenses to the subdivider instead of the Town. We are not opposed to the inevitable growth but we want to control it so that the new families can be absorbed without materially increasing our taxes.

Our next project is to complete a Town Plan which will be an additional aid in preventing development in unsuitable areas.

We want to thank all those who attended our hearings and meetings. Your opinions are always welcome. We are your Planning Board and represent you to the best of our ability.

MINUTES OF THE TOWN MEETING

MARCH 14, 1978

A legal meeting of the inhabitants of the Town of Deering qualified to vote in Town Affairs was called to order at 12: P.M. (Noon) March 14, 1978.

Article 1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the ensuing year. Total ballots cast 119.

Selectman for three years - Thomas G. Allen - 103.

Town Treasurer - Clara T. Rich - 113.

Auditors - Marjorie A. Campbell - 93, Marjorie A. Heath - 105.

Tax Collector - Eleanor B. Fitzpatrick - 106.

Library Trustee, 3 years - Virginia I. Bittenbender - 103.

Trustee of Trust Funds, write in vote - 17 Gladys Snow.

Supervisor of Check Lists, 6 years - Rocco Marotta - 95.

Moderator for Two Years - George F. Wolf - 105.

Article 2. It was voted to accept the reports of the Town Officers, Agents, Committees, and Auditors for the year 1977.

Article 3. It was voted to raise and appropriate the following sums of money; Town Officers Salaries \$9,500.; Town Officers Expenses \$8,500.; Election and Registration \$800.; Town Buildings and the purchase of Office Equipment \$5,000.; Social Security Payments \$3,300.; Insurance \$5,000.; Damages and Legal Expenses \$1,000.; Dog Expense \$400.; Dumps and Trash Removal \$8,250.; Vital Statistics \$25.; Street Lighting \$1,500.; Library \$35.; Town Poor \$1,200.; Old Age Assistance \$1,000.; Aid To Permanently and Totally Disabled \$1,000.; Cemetery Care \$500.

Article 4. It was voted to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.

Article 5. It was voted to authorize the Selectmen to auction property taken by Tax Collector's Deeds.

Article 6. It was voted to continue membership in the Central New Hampshire Regional Planning Commission and raise and appropriate the sum of \$497. for the Town's share of the operating costs of the Commission.

Article 7. Negative vote on the Monadnock Region membership.

Article 8. It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$300. for the current operating expenses of the Planning Board and the sum of \$250. for the current operating expenses of the Conservation Commission.

Article 9. It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,500. for continuing and making corrections to the Tax Map.

Article 10. It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$9,500. for the Police Department and the sum of \$4,000. for the Fire Department, and the sum of \$200. for Civil Defense.

Article 11. It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,500. for continuing renovations of the Town Hall.

Article 12. It was voted to raise and appropriate the following sums for Highway purposes, (1) \$38,000. for Road Maintenance; (2) \$15,000. for the General Expenses of the Highway; (3) \$9,000. for Road Sealing; and to raise by State Grant, Highway Subsidy, and appropriate the sum of \$13,800.25 to be used for the maintenance of Town Highways under the provisions of RSA: 241:14 as amended; and to further raise by State Grant, Highway Subsidy, and appropriate the sum of \$7,904.87 to be used for the maintenance of Town Highways under the provisions of RSA 241:14.

Article 13. It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,123.17 to secure Town Road Aid.

Article 14. It was voted 72 yes - 24 no to raise and appropriate the sum of \$9,100. for a fully equipped police cruiser and authorize the withdrawal of \$5,460. for this purpose from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972 with the balance to be raised by Federal Grant.

Article 14a. It was voted to appropriate and authorize withdrawal from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972 for use as setoffs against budget appropriations in the amount indicated and, further to authorize the Selectmen to make pro-rata increases in the amount if estimated entitlements are increased or pro-rata reductions in the amounts if estimated entitlements are reduced.

Article 15. It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$200. for the support of the Hillsboro Rescue Squad and the sum of \$100. for the Weare Rescue Squad.

It was voted to appropriate and authorize withdrawal from the Anti-recession Fiscal Assistance Program established under the provisions of the Public Works Employment Act of 1976 for use as setoffs against budget appropriation in the amount indicated, and further to authorize the Selectmen to make pro-rata increases in the amount if estimated entitlements are increased or pro-rata reductions in the amount if estimated entitlements are reduced.

Article 17. It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$350. as a contribution to the Contoocook Valley Mental Health Center.

Article 18. It was voted to authorize the Selectmen to apply for and accept grants of Federal or State Aid, or both, relative to disasters, civic improvements, highway safety and the detection, deterrence and apprehension of crime or criminals any or all, as may be available.

Article 19. It was voted to authorize the Board of Selectmen to accept or purchase on behalf of the Town any Federal or State surplus fire or highway equipment.

Article 20. It was voted to authorize the Selectmen to trade, sell or otherwise dispose of any surplus Town Property.

Article 21. It was voted to designate Bartlett Hill Road from Route 149 to the Francestown Town Line as scenic under the provisions of RSA 253:17 and 18 for the purposes of protecting and enhancing the scenic beauty of Deering.

Article 21a. It was voted to designate Pleasant Pond Road from Route 149 to the Francestown Line as scenic under the provisions of RSA 253:17 and 18 for the purposes of protecting and enhancing the scenic beauty of Deering.

Article 22. It was voted to confirm the status of the following roads as Class VI highways (not maintained by the Town).

- a. Bartlett Hill Road from Poor Farm Road to Weare (.45 mile).
- b. Codman Hill Road, entire length (.80 mile).
- c. Driscoll Road from Tubbs Road to Range Road (.61 mile).
- d. Falls Road, Hunters house to Second N.H. Turnpike (1.19 miles).
- c. Gregg Hill Road, from Rush's house to Tubbs Hill Road (.39 mile).
- f. Hedgehog Mountain Road from McQuirk's house to Chamberlin's house (2.02 miles).
- g. Homestead Road from the Homestead east to Bartlett Hill Road (1.79 miles).
- h. Mine Road, entire length (.72 mile).
- i. Old Bennington Road, entire length (.40 mile).
- j. Old Clement Road, entire length (.71 mile).
- k. Old Francestown Road from McConnell's house southeast across Bartlett Hill Road and continuing to end (2.02 miles).
- l. Old Route 149 from East Deering Road to Route 149 (.54 mile) and across 149 to Weare Line (.13 mile).

- m. Tubbs Hill Road from Tolles house to Driscoll Road (1.59 miles).
- n. Wolf Hill Road from Long House Building to Fisher Road (.97 mile).

Article 23. It was voted to accept the gift of a small triangular piece of land located at the intersection of Tubbs Hill Road and Driscoll Road from Land Systems Inc.

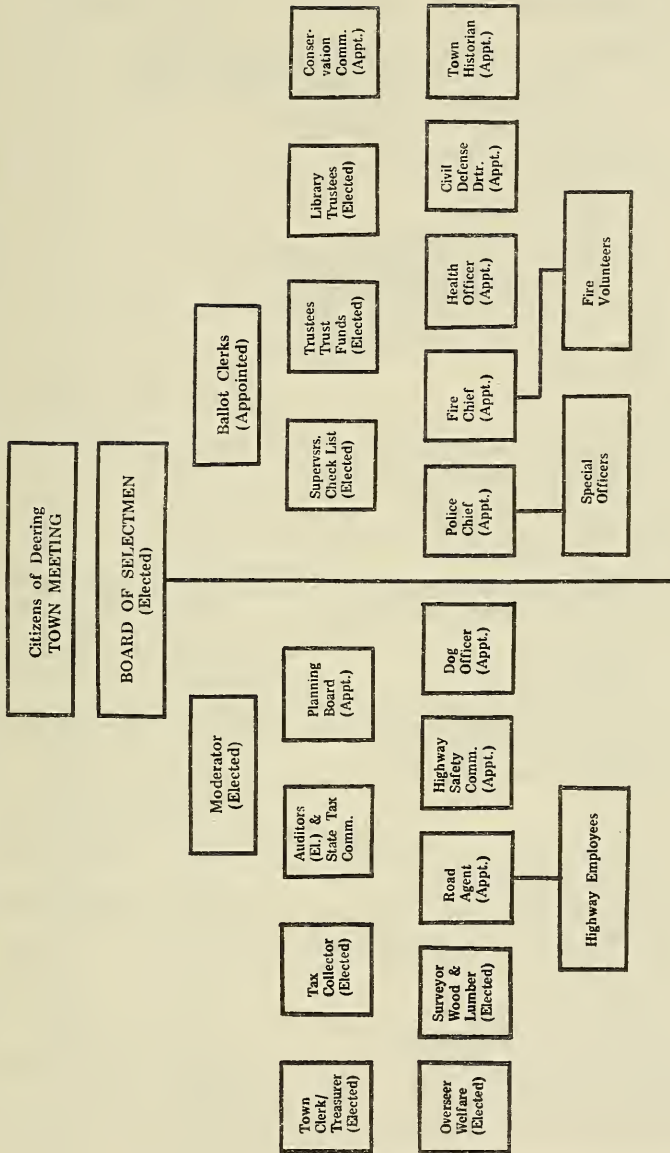
Article 24. It was voted to authorize the transfer of the School House Lot, so-called, bordered by land now or formerly of Purdy Laferriere located on the Second N.H. Turnpike, to said Purdy Laferriere upon such terms and conditions as the Selectmen see fit.

Article 25. It was voted to change the custom of putting pictures of people who have departed on the cover of the Town Report and instead honor the living. It was voted to so honor Howard E. Whitney next year.

Article 26. It was voted to thank Edwin Dutton and his committee for the fine job done on the Town History. Clara T. Rich and Marguerite Dutton were given a vote of thanks for their many years of service to the Town. It was voted to keep the polls open Town Meeting until the start of the meeting in the evening in order to give every one a chance to vote. It was moved that this Town Meeting instruct our Representatives to seek and actively support an effective Beverage Container Deposit Law at the next and, if necessary, ensuing legislative Sessions. It was voted to adjourne without date.
