- Faculty Senate motion on Open Access (2010)
“the senate supports the establishment of self-archiving in an institutional repository for scholarly work”

Scholars' Repository – what goes in?

Faculty Work

Now: Published journal articles in compliance with publisher policies

- Published version as PDF
- Pre-print
- Post-print
- Record only with link to published version

Scholars' Repository – what goes in?

Faculty Work

Later:

- Technical reports & white papers
- Data sets
- Music scores, compositions, recorded performances
- Artwork (images & other media)
- Monographs

Scholars' Repository – what goes in?

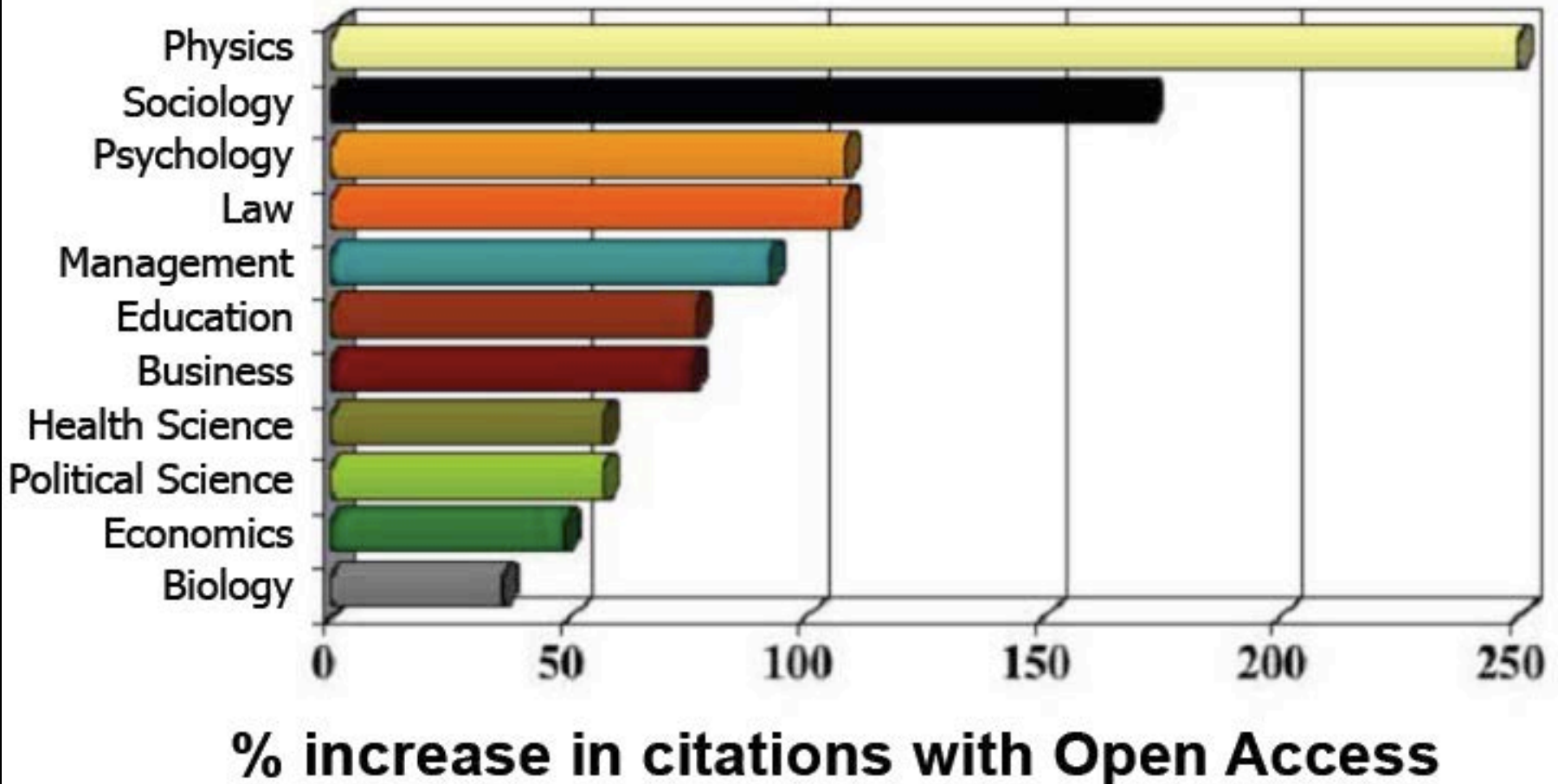
Student Work

- Theses & dissertations
- Research projects
- Honors program

Benefits for faculty

- Increased exposure and impact of work – everyone can read
- Better understanding and control over intellectual property rights
- Centralized management of publications – one place to go.
- Potential for new connections and collaborations
