Warrant for the Annual Town Meeting March 11, 1941**THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**

To the inhabitants of the Town of Tuftonboro, in the County of Carroll, in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the eleventh day of March, next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same. (\$10,396.50) figures of the Budget Committee.
3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one thousand nine hundred and eleven dollars, (\$1,911), the State to raise a like amount for State Aid Construction on the Ledge Hill Road.
4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four thousand dollars, (\$4,000), for tarring parts of the following roads: Tuftonboro Neck, Wawbeek, Union Wharf, Ledge Hill, High Street, Wharf Road and the New Road, the balance to be expended for improving the balance of the Union Wharf Road.
5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one hundred twenty-seven dollars (\$127) to the Lakes Region Association of New Hampshire for the issuance and distribution of printed matter and newspaper and magazine advertising calling attention to the resources and natural advantages of the Town, in cooperation with other towns in the Lakes Region.

6. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue the McDuffee road, so-called, in the Canaan District.

7. To see what action the Town will take regarding the raising of pay of Town employees, as per petition.

8. To see what action the Town will take regarding the Budget Committee, as per petition.

9. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to discontinue printing the tax inventory in the Town Report except once in five years.

10. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes of the levy of 1941.

11. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
