

#### TO THE CITIZENS OF THE TOWN OF DERRY:

The following report and summary of the several departments and their activities are assembled to better acquaint the voters with the operation of their Town.

The budget for the year 1958 will be considerably higher if approved at the Town Meeting in its present form. Some of the major increases are due to:

- 1. Payment of \$14,633.81 on the principal and interest on the bond issue for construction of the water main from Derry Village to Klev-Bro Shoe.
- 2. An increase in salaries to Town Employees.
- 3. An increase under the Spraying item to take care of cutting of dead and diseased trees and control of pine blister.
- 4. An item under New Equipment in the amount of \$15,000.00 for the purchase of new equipment.


It is our earnest desire to place before the public in as complete and concise a way as possible all the pertinent facts which you, as taxpayers, are interested.

## TOWN WARRANT

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Derry, qualified to vote in town affairs:

You are hereby instructed to meet at the Veterans Memorial Building, in said Town, on the second Tuesday of March next, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

By vote of the Selectmen, the polls for this meeting will remain open from ten o'clock in the forenoon until seven-thirty o'clock in the afternoon, and as much longer thereafter as the Town, at the opening of the meeting, may vote.

- 1. To elect a Selectman for three years, Town Clerk, Treasurer, Collector of Taxes, Library Trustees, Trustees of the Trust Funds, Cemetery Trustee, Auditors and other necessary Town officials for the year ensuing.
- 2. To vote to raise and appropriate such sums of money as may be necessary for the maintenance of the poor, for laying out and repairing highways, for building and repairing bridges, for the suppression of moths, for police department and municipal court, for hydrant service and electric lights, for salaries of Town Officials, for the Board of Health, for the expense of the Town Hall, for support of the libraries, for State and County taxes, for the observance of Memorial Day, for aid to the Derry Visiting Nurse Association, for playground purposes and for band concerts, for co-operating with the State and Federal governments in the control of insect pests and white pine blister and for all necessary charges arising in said Town, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 3. To see if the Town will authorize the Selectmen to sell at public auction and convey any real estate acquired through deeds from the Collector of Taxes or as reimbursement for assistance furnished to citizens, providing that in the case of tax deeded real estate the previous owner thereof, if known, shall have the first opportunity to purchase the same, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 4. To see if the Town will authorize its Selectmen to incur debts for temporary loans in anticipation of taxes of the municipal year in which such debts are incurred and made payable therefrom, by such vote, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 5. To see if the Town will direct the Collector of Taxes to allow a discount to all persons paying their taxes within such period as the Town shall limit, to fix the rate of such discount, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 6. To see if the Town will vote to approve the recommendation of the Budget Committee that the sum of \$500.00 be taken from

the income of the MacGregor Park Fund and expended during the summer of 1958 for band concerts at said MacGregor Park, and pass any vote relating thereto.

- 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1458.56 for aid under Apportionment A of Town Road Aid Plan to match a State appropriation amounting to \$9723.75 for the purpose of construction and reconstruction of Class IV and Class V highways, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3740.00 for aid under Apportionment B of Town Road Aid Plan to match an appropriation by the State of \$3740.00 for the purpose of construction and reconstruction of Town highways as provided for in said Town Road Aid Plan.
- 9. To see if the Town wishes to adopt the recommendation of the Budget Committee that \$6425.00 be transferred from parking meters receipts to the Police Department for the purpose of patrolling the meters, and that the sum of \$2400.00 from the parking meters receipts be transferred to the Highway Department for the purpose of cleaning about the meters, and that the balance of said receipts be transferred to the Trustees of the Trust Funds to be added to the capital reserve fund for the purpose of grading, surfacing and improving the public parking lots leased and owned by the Town, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 10. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the unexpended balance of sewer maintenance funds to the capital reserve funds held by the Trustees of Trust Funds as a sewer construction fund, plus any revenues in addition to those anticipated in the budget, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 11. By petition. "To see if the Town will appropriate a sum of money for the repair and renewal of the sidewalk located on the North side of Hampstead Road from the circle at Derry Village to the Grange Hall in East Derry, a distance of about three-quarters of a mile, more or less, to take any other action relative thereto."
- 12. To see if the Town will authorize the Board of Water Commissioners to grant up to 100 feet of water main to any new customer water user provided the customer water user pay the entire cost of excavation and backfilling, and provided that payment shall be made in advance for water main supplied in excess of the 100 feet of said main granted by this article, and to pass any vote relating thereto.
- 13. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the appropriate Town Officials to sell or lease a parcel of land owned by the Town, situated on the Easterly side of Cemetery Road in East Derry, to the East Derry Fire District for the purpose of erection of a fire

house thereon, and pass any vote relating thereto.

- 14. To head the reports of agents, auditors and committees heretofore chosen, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 15. To appoint any necessary committees on any article embraced in this warrant.
- 16. To transact any other business that may lawfully come before such meeting.

#### LIBRARIAN'S REPORT

The 53rd Annual Report is herewith presented:

#### 1957 Annual Report

The death of Mrs. Harriet Low was one of regret and sorrow to the staff of the library. Mrs. Low was a very helpful and faithful trustee for 50 years.

Many gifts of books have been received during the past year. Some of the current fiction were duplicates of books now on the shelves. If a second copy is not needed it is placed on a back shelf; when needed it is put into circulation.

The Derry Reading Club gave us a year's subscription to the American Heritage; a very fine book for the lover of antiques.

The books from the Ballard estate have made a very fine addition to our non-fiction collection. Many of them have already proved popular with our readers.

Book Week was observed as usual. Instead of the Librarian going into the classrooms to speak to the children, the teachers and children were invited to visit the library. Each forenoon during Book Week the library was open and classes had the opportunity to look at the new books, get acquainted with the card catalogue and choose a book to read.

The children of 4-5-6 grades were given a book story to read. The object was for the child to pick out the book titles which made up the story. This was very popular, many children spent most of their time in the library after school hours.

Mrs. French's class led with the highest score. Mrs. Moore's class came in second. Both classes were given a book for their homeroom library shelf. During the week a reading club was discussed and soon put into action.

The following week the Parochial School Sisters brought their classes in to see the new books. This group also took part in the Story book contest.

Many thanks to our thoughtful friends for the fine gifts the library has received during the past year. All gifts are well used and gratefully received.
