ARTICLES FOR TOWN WARRANT

March 8, 1932

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Ellsworth, in the County of Grafton in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the School House in said Ellsworth on Tuesday, the eighth day of March next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriation of the same.

3. To see how much money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the support of highways and bridges.

4. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate \$82.50 to secure from the State \$1,000.00 for State Aid Construction.

5. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate \$167.00, to secure from the State \$1,336.00 for State Aid Maintenance.

6. To determine and appoint the salaries of the Town Officers and make appropriation for the same.

7. To see what action the town will take relative to buying a snow plow.

8. To see what action the town will take relative to buying snow fence.

9. To see if the town will vote to qualify for State Aid on bridges.

10. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to hire money in anticipation of uncollected taxes and to give notes countersigned by the Treasurer.

11. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the care of cemeteries and elect an agent to expend the same.

12. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
