# Town Warrant

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## THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*To the Inhabitants of the Town of Exeter, in the County  
of Rockingham, in said State, qualified to vote in  
Town Affairs:* [L. S.]

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Exeter on Tuesday, the thirteenth day of March next, at ten of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

- 1st. To choose by ballot and plurality vote a town clerk.
- 2d. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one selectman for three years.
- 3d. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one trustee of the Robinson Female Seminary for the term of seven years.
- 4th. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one trustee of the trust funds held by the town of Exeter, to hold office for three years.
- 5th. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one trustee of the Swasey Parkway for three years.
- 6th. To choose all other necessary town officers, auditors, or committees for the ensuing year.
- 7th. To see what sums of money the town will raise and appropriate for the maintenance of the poor, for repairing highways, for repairing and building bridges, for repairing and building sidewalks, for building drains and sewers, for oiling streets, for payment of the town debt, for lighting streets, for defraying expenses of decorating the graves of soldiers, for preventing the spread of insect pests within the town, for the control of the white pine blister disease, for the payment of firemen for the ensuing year, and for other charges arising within the town.
- 8th. To hear the reports of agents, auditors, and other officers and committees heretofore chosen and pass any vote arising therefrom.
- 9th. To see if the town will vote to authorize the town treasurer, with the approval of the selectmen, to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.

10th. To see if the town will vote to authorize the water commissioners, with the approval of the selectmen, to borrow money in anticipation of revenue.

11th. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the issuance and distribution of printed matter to call attention to the resources and natural advantages of the town and to assist on planning and development for the benefit of the town in cooperation with other towns coordinated in the Seacoast Regional Development Association, the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars (\$350.00).

12th. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to take title on behalf of the town by deed, bill of sale or other document of title from the School District the Court Street school house and outbuildings, if any its leasehold interest in land abutting upon Court Street and South Street and its right, title and interest in land of the School District acquired by the School District by deed of John H. Brown et als dated June 4, 1888, and recorded in Rockingham Records Book 511, Page 396; such transfer to be made for a nominal consideration or upon such terms as the School Board and Selectmen of the Town may determine and agree.

13th. To see if the town will vote to contribute the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) to the New Hampshire Marine Memorial Commission to aid in the erection of the Marine Memorial at Hampton Beach.

14th. On petition of Daniel Herlihy and ten others to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of twelve hundred dollars (\$1200.00) for the purpose of eight Band Concerts to be played in the Swasey Pavilion by the Exeter Brass Band during the summer of 1956.

15th. On the petition of William P. Dudley and ten others to see if the town, when issuing tax bills for 1956, shall have printed by the lowest bidder a booklet for general distribution, listing property taxed at over \$100.00, grouping such items by streets, and giving street number, owner, and tax for each item, and appropriate money for the same.

16th. On petition of John A. Henry and eleven others to see if the town will convey, for the sum of one dollar, the old clock located in the tower of the Congregational Church to said church.

17th. To see if the town will vote to establish a Planning Board of seven members with duties as set forth in

Sections 1-15, Chapter 36, New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, 1955; and to see if the town will vote to appropriate the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00) for the same.

18th. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to have an annual Town Audit made by the Municipal Accounting Division of the State Tax Commission or an accountant approved by it and expend a reasonable amount for the same.

19th. On petition of Harold E. Carbonneau and 14 others to see if the town will vote to adopt the Town Manager Plan as provided by Chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes annotated.

20th. On petition of Harold E. Carbonneau and 13 others to see if the town will vote to transfer the powers and duties of the office of Tax Collector to the office of Town Manager, as provided in Section 16, Chapter 37, Revised Laws annotated, said transfer to take place if and when the office of Town Manager is established within said town.

21st. On the petition of Thomas Ball and 19 others to see if the town will appropriate the sum of two thousand, five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) to construct a permanent Baseball Field in the Seminary yard to be used by the Little League, the Summer Playground, and the Grammar School.

22d. On petition of John P. Kimball and nine others to see if the town will vote to extend the water main along Court Street from the corner of Court Street and Bell Avenue to Crawford Avenue, a distance of approximately five hundred (500) feet, and to install a hydrant for fire protection as needed, in the discretion of the Water Commissioners, on said extension, and to raise and appropriate the sum of twenty-seven hundred dollars (\$2700.00) for this purpose.

23d. On petition of S. E. LaPerle and 14 others to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four thousand, eight hundred dollars (\$4,800.00) to be used by the Exeter Fire Department for the purpose of employing and paying the wages of two additional firemen.

24th. On petition of Walter O. Pennell and 27 others to see if the town will vote to have the firm of John W. Durgin, the town's consulting sewer engineer, prepare a long-range sewer plan of Exeter for use as a guide and to avoid false work in future sewer construction and to appropriate the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for the same.



25th. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

# Report of the State Tax Commission

## DIVISION OF MUNICIPAL ACCOUNTING

Gentlemen:*

Submitted herewith is the report of the annual examination and audit of the accounts of the Town of Exeter for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1955, which was made by this Division in accordance with the vote of the Town. Exhibits as hereafter listed are included as part of the report.

### Scope of Audit

Included in the examination and audit were the accounts and records of the Board of Selectmen, Treasurer, Tax Collector, Town Clerk, Road Agent, Library Treasurer, Clerk of the Municipal Court and Trustees of Trust Funds.

### Financial Statements

*Comparative Balance Sheets — December 31, 1954 —  
December 31, 1955: (Exhibit A-1)*

Comparative Balance Sheets as of December 31, 1954, and December 31, 1955, are presented in Exhibit A-1. As indicated therein, the Net Debt decreased by \$25,424.70 during the year 1955.

*Analysis of Change in Financial Condition:*

(Exhibit A-2)

An analysis of the change in financial condition of the Town during the year is made in Exhibit A-2, with the factors which caused the change indicated therein. These were as follows:

*Comparative Statements of Appropriations and Expenditures — Estimated and Actual Revenues:*

(Exhibits A-3 & A-4)

Comparative statements of appropriations and expenditures, estimated and actual revenues for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1955, are presented in Exhibits A-3 and A-4. As indicated by the budget summary (Exhibit A-4), a revenue surplus of \$21,001.73, less a net overdraft of appropriations of \$7,934.78, resulted in a net budget surplus of \$13,066.95.

*Summary of Receipts and Expenditures:* (Exhibit B-1)

A summary of receipts and expenditures for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1955, made up in accordance with the uniform classification of accounts is included in Exhibit B-1. Proof of the Treasurer's balance, as of December 31, 1955, is indicated in Exhibit B-2.

*Statement of Bonded Debt:* (Exhibit J-1)

A statement of bonded indebtedness (Town and Water Department) as of December 31, 1955, showing annual debt service requirements, is contained in Exhibit J-1.

### Audit Procedure

The accounts and records of all town officials charged with the custody, receipt and disbursement of public funds were examined and audited. Vouchers and cancelled checks were compared with supporting invoices and payrolls as well as entries in the books of record. Receipts were checked by source insofar as possible and totals of receipts and expenditures verified. Book balances were verified by comparison with reconciled bank balances made from statements obtained from depository banks.

### General Comments

*Current Surplus:*

During 1955 the current financial condition of the Town changed from a current deficit of \$6,678.96 to a current surplus of \$17,745.74, as shown by the following statement:
