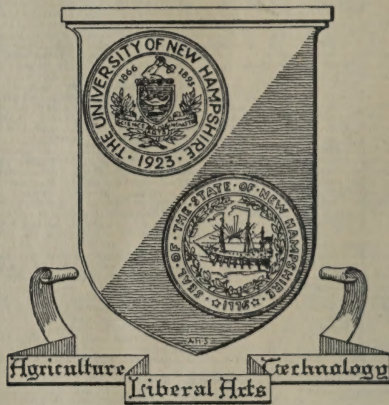

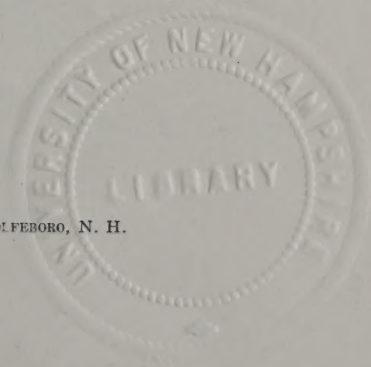

## Warrant for the Annual Town Meeting March 9, 1943

## THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of the Town of Tuftonboro in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the ninth day of March, next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray Town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same. (\$11,163.33) figures of the Budget Committee.
3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four hundred fifteen dollars and ninety-eight cents (\$415.98), the State to raise sixteen hundred and sixty-three dollars and ninety cents (\$1,663.90) for Town Road Aid.
4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) for tarring Town roads.
5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one hundred and thirty-two dollars (\$132) to the Lakes Region Association.
6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) for constructing a driveway to the Town House.
7. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes of the levy of 1943.

8. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
