THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Exeter, in the County of Rockingham, in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs: [L. S.]

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Exeter on Tuesday, the twelfth day of March next, at ten of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1st. To choose by ballot and plurality vote a town clerk.

2d. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one select-

man for three years.

3d. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one trustee of the Robinson Female Seminary for the term of seven years.

4th. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one trustee of the trust funds held by the town of Exeter, to hold

office for three years.

5th. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one trus-

tee of the Swasey Parkway for three years.

6th. To choose all other necessary town officers.

auditors, or committees for the ensuing year.

7th. To see what sums of money the town will raise and appropriate for the maintenance of the poor, for repairing highways, for repairing and building bridges, for repairing and building sidewalks, for building drains and sewers, for oiling streets, for payments of the town debt, for lighting streets, for defraying expenses of decorating the graves of soldiers, for preventing the spread of insect pests within the town, for the control of the white pine blister disease, for the payment of firemen for the ensuing year, and for other charges arising within the town.

8th. To hear the reports of agents, auditors, and other officers and committees heretofore chosen and

pass any vote arising therefrom.

9th. To see if the town will vote to authorize the town treasurer, with the approval of the selectmen, to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.

10th. To see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of revenue of the water department.

11th. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the issuance and distribution of printed matter to call attention to the resources and natural advantages of the town and to assist on planning and development for the benefit of the town in cooperation with other towns coordinated in the Seacoast Regional Development Association, the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars (\$350.00).

12th. On petition of Daniel P. Herlihy and ten others to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of twelve hundred dollars (\$1,200.00) for the purpose of eight Band Concerts to be played in the Swasey Pavilion by the Exeter Brass Band during the summer of 1957.

13th. On petition of Edward J. Campbell and eleven others to see if the town will vote to increase the salary of each selectman from the present \$600.00 to \$1,000.00 annually.

14th. On petition of Phoebe Gay Nolan and eleven others to see if the town will vote to establish a Planning Board of seven members with duties as set forth in Sections 1-15, Chapter 36, New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, 1955, and to see if the town will vote to appropriate the sum of \$750.00 for the same.

15th. On petition of Alfred P. Bilodeau and twenty-six others to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for the purpose of installing a suitable sewer line from the southwesterly end of Arbor Street to the southwesterly end of Parker Street for a distance of approximately three hundred (300) feet.

16th. On petition of Bruno Kucharski and twenty-two others to see if the town will vote to transfer the powers and duties of the office of Tax Collector to the office of Town Manager as provided in Section 16, Chapter 37, revised laws annotated, said transfer to take place if the office of Town Manager remain established in said town.

17th. On petition of Eugene Cote and fifteen others to see if the town will vote to continue the Town Manager Plan and appropriate the sum of Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$6,500.00) for the same.

18th. On petition of James Rowe, Sr., and nine others to see if the town will vote to abolish the Police Commissioners through lawful procedure.

19th. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00) for the purchase of equipment for the Highway Department.

20th. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to have an annual Town Audit made by the Municipal Accounting Division of the State Tax Commission or an accountant approved by it and expend a reasonable amount for the same.

21st. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to sell property of the town acquired by tax collector's deeds as the result of tax sales.

22d. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.



Board of Selectmen, Exeter, New Hampshire Gentlemen:

Submitted herewith is the Audit Report as made by Hunt's Accounting Service, as requested by the vote of your Town.

Scope of Audit

All departments of the Town government were audited: The Board of Selectmen, Treasurer, Tax Collector, Clerk, Trustees of Trust Funds, Municipal Court, Police Department and Library.

Financial Statements

Exhibit A-1 contains the Balance Sheet for a twoyear period. This Exhibit reflects the Assets (or accounts due the Town) and the Liabilities (or the accounts owed by the Town). The difference of which would show a Surplus or Debt whichever was larger. The financial condition of Exeter at the end of December 31, 1956, shows a small Net Debt of \$29,328.29.

Exhibit A-2 contains the change in financial condition during the year. The debt increased by \$4,074.03, made by the following changes:

Exhibit A-3 shows the appropriations as raised by the Town vote, receipts and reimbursements of appropriations, expenditures, and balance as under-expended and over-expended. The final over-expenditure of \$20,-740.27 is shown in the budget summary on Exhibit A-4

Exhibit A-4 shows the anticipated revenues and the amounts actually received by the Town. The final excess of revenues was \$15,672.74 as shown in the Budget Summary.

Departments

Exhibits B-1 through K show the various town officers' accounts. All monies were accounted for by reconciling with the depository banks. Payroll accounts were checked and remaining balances verified.

Verification notices were sent on all delinquent taxes

for the 1956 levy.

Recommendations

A new payroll system was recommended and adopted for the Police Department.

Superintendent of Highway Dept. Report

To the Board of Selectmen and Town Manager:

Herein is my report for the year 1956 accounting

for some of the major activities of the Department.

The weather played a big part in our activities of the past year. It caused a considerable overdraft in our winter maintenance account, due to the heavy snow storms during February, March and December. The weather also reflects in our overdraft in general expense because of the additional work required of the equipment causing more repairs, gasoline etc.

We were able to apply about 60,000 gallons of asphalt

seal coat on several of our streets.

We were also able to complete surfacing on three newly accepted streets and did some grading on others.

Portsmouth Ave. from High St. to Highland St. was resurfaced along with the sidewalks and some new curb-

ing installed.

Approximately 2450 ft. of Front St. from the railroad tracks to the compact area line was resurfaced with State matching funds. We have a balance of \$5870.00 which the State will match for 1957 work.

In September the highway accounts were audited and the bookkeeping transferred to the Town office under the Town Manager. Elsewhere in the town report is the break down of expenditures for the various highway accounts.

Again I wish to thank the members of the Department, town officers, other Departments and citizens

for their cooperation this past year.

Public Library Report

To the Library Committee:

It is with sincere pleasure that the following report is presented. I wish to draw your attention particularly to the reference work and the circulation. These matters are of vital concern to all libraries.

The year 1956 has shown a steady increase in the amount of work necessary to help the school students. Many days all chairs are occupied by busy workers. The addition of several excellent sources such as "Shephards Historical Atlas" "Encyclopedia of Latin-American History" by Martin and Lovett and the eleven volume set of "Book of Popular Science" by the Grolier Society have been very valuable assets.

This growing demand holds true as well for the pupils of the lower grades. The Juvenile room is well equipped with good encyclopedias and they are put to

good use.

Our circulation showed an increase of over two hundred in the Childrens' Room. This is partly due to the teachers taking large amounts of books for use at school. By this plan the teachers have been doing a splendid job in encouraging the pupil to read more.

Adult circulation dropped over four hundred but since the number of new borrowers is increasing it is certain that another year will show an upward trend.

The observance of National Art Week was made more impressive by the exhibition of water color paintings through the courtesy of Mrs. Helen Bragdon. This was supplemented by drawings and paintings from the grades of the Elementary School.

There were four story hours held during the first of the year. Attendance was not large enough to warrant the continuing of such a project. At this time the writer wishes to thank the Junior Woman's Club for

their kindness in providing the readers for us.

Three of the elementary grades accompained by their teachers visited the library and received instruction by Mrs. Summerfield. Such groups are always welcome and we encourage them to come at any time. The painting "Crossing the Brook" by Elizabeth Gardner Bouguereau through the generousity of Miss Margaret Kent, a former library trustee, has been moved from the Robinson Seminary to the Library. The town should be extremely grateful to Miss Kent for her thoughtfulness in seeing that a valuable piece of art given to the town should be preserved in a fitting place where people can enjoy it.

The Library Committee purchased a Return Box for books which has proved to be of value to people who can't always come to the library during the open hours.

During the year we have received gifts of books from friends and the Davis Library. Sincere thanks goes to both sources for their thought of the library.

The staff welcomes our new committee member Mrs. Constance Perry who replaced the Rev. Paul T. Martin.

The continued loyal support and cooperation of the staff and Library Committee is deeply appreciated.
