Warrant for the Annual Town Meeting March 14, 1944**THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Tuftonboro in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the fourteenth day of March, next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same. (\$11,337.00 figures of the Budget Committee.)

3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of two hundred eight dollars and twenty cents (\$208.20), the State to raise eight hundred thirty-two dollars and seventy-eight cents (\$832.78) for Town Road Aid.

4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for tarring Town roads.

5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300) to be used for one or more Town dumps.

6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500) and authorize the Selectmen to use a sum from the General Fund up to five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the purchase of snow removal equipment, if avail-

able. If such equipment is not available such sums to be set aside until such equipment can be purchased.

7. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes of the levy of 1944.

8. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
