#### TOWN WARRANT

#### The State of New Hampshire

To the Inhabitants of the Town of New Hampton in the County of Belknap in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town House in said New Hampton on Tuesday, the 13th day of March, next at ten of the clock in the forenoon, the polls to close not later than the end of the transacting of business on said day.

- 1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing. Business meeting on all other articles to begin at 8:00 P.M.
- 2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray Town Charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations for the same.
- 3. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the repairs and maintenance of Highways and Bridges.
- 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$869.02 for Town Road Aid, the State to contribute the sum of \$5,793.45.
- 5. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the maintenance and tarring of Class V Roads.
- 6. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 to assist in building an access to the river on the right hand side of the bridge approaching the town of Bristol so that the Bristol Fire Department may, in case of fire, back the pumping truck to the river in order to secure water for the fire protection of several houses and the factory in that area.

- 7. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.
- 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,850.00 for the payment of principal and interest on the Fire Truck note.
- To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to administer and dispose of any real estate acquired by the Town through Tax Collector's Deeds.
- 10. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for Memorial Day.
- 11. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for Old Home Day.
- 12. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for Old Cemeteries.
- 13. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the care of the village cemetery.
- 14. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100.00 for the control of White Pine Blister Rust.
- 15. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,500.00 to finish black topping and other necessary work on the back road from New Hampton to Bristol. Being that portion of the road running from the Fiske School house to the point where the black top terminates as a result of last year's work.
- 16. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for the support of hospitals.
- 17. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money, \$400.00 for the Newfound Area Nursing Association.

- 18. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$475.00 for the purchase of a resuscitator with dual resuscitator-inhalator mechanism for simultaneous treatment of two persons. (By request)
- 19. To see if the Town will vote to purchase a new truck, applying an old truck towards the cost of the new one, and raise and appropriate \$3,500.00 for the same.
- 20. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100.00 for the Community Center.
- 21. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.

- 3. To choose a member of the School Board for the ensuing three years.
  - 4. To choose a Treasurer for the ensuing year.
- 5. To determine and appoint the salaries of the School Board and Truant Officer, and fix the compensation of any other officers or agent of the District.
- 6. To hear the reports of Agents, Auditors, Committees or officers chosen, and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 7. To choose Agents, Auditors, and committees in relation to any subject embraced in this warrant.
- 8. To see if the District will vote to make any alteration in the amount of money required to be assessed for the ensuing year for the support of public schools and for the payment of the statutory obligations of the District, as determined by the School Board in its annual report.
- 9. To see if the School District will authorize the School Board to appoint a committee of three persons, including one member of the Board of Selectmen, to investigate participation by the New Hampton School District in a cooperative school district and to report their findings at a spec-

10. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.

### SCHOOL HEALTH SERVICES REPORT 1960 - 1961

### New Hampton Community School

All students were given vision and hearing tests. The hearing tests were made possible through the purchase of a Maico audiometer by the School Board. Heights and weights were recorded at the beginning and end of the school year. Routine examinations were made each week. Parents were notified of 17 defects. 13 of these were corrected. A pre-school clinic in June was attended by 17.

Dr. William Walsh examined 84 pupils. 31 defects were found with referrals to family physicians through the parents. 25 of these defects were corrected.

85 students had a communicable disease. German Measles was the predominant disease, thus did not constitute great time loss from class. Careful observation before children are sent to school would be beneficial in such cases.

8 children attended State Health Clinics, transportation being provided when necessary.

Through continued Parent-Teachers Association support 126 pupils had Sodium Fluoride Prophylaxis for prevention of tooth decay.

50 home visits were made.

The Bristol Rotary Club and Bristol Lion's Club provided examinations and glasses for several youngsters.

Social welfare conferences were held as necessary.

I wish to thank the staff, the School Board and parents for their continued cooperation.

### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

## To the Board of Education and Citizens of the New Hampton School District:

I herewith submit my annual report as Superintendent of Schools.

### Personnel

School opened this Fall with two changes in the staff. Mr. Edwards, the principal, accepted a teaching position in Pelham and Miss Helen Anderson took a position in Bedford. Replacing Mr. Edwards is Mr. Frank Finley, a graduate of Keene Teachers College and principal for the past two years at the elementary school in Rindge, N. H. Miss Jeanne Lachance, a graduate of Keene Teachers College in June, has replaced Miss Anderson.

Once again this year as last I believe that our Community School is fortunate in having such an excellent staff attending to the education of the children of New Hampton.

### Enrollment

One year ago we had an increase of twenty-three pupils in our school. With that increase our school opened in September of 1960 with an enrollment of 149 pupils. This Fall school opened with 145 pupils, a slight decrease over 1960.

Following are the starting enrollments for the past three years:

1959 - 126

1960 - 149

1961 - 145

### Curriculum

We have expanded our use of the education tele-casts from the University of New Hampshire to include the phonics program that is new this year. We are now using New Hampshire History for grade 4, Science programs for grades 3, 5 and 6, French for grades 4, 5 and 6, Music for grades 1 and 2 and phonics for grades 1 and 2.

Since the cost of the television reception equipment at the Community School was small due to the help from the National Defense Education Act and the New Hampton Library this has paid for itself many times over in the past three years in the excellent instruction that we have received to supplement our own program.

We are continuing to emphasize reading instruction to build stronger readers yet without sacrificing any of the necessary foundation in arithmetic or social studies. Budget

The budget is up \$7,708.44 over last year. Due to one of the largest eighth grades in our history, the major portion of this increase is caused by tuitions, an item in the budget over which we have no control. This item is up \$4,976.00 over last year.

It is felt by the School Board and Superintendent that the recommended budget is necessary for effective operation of the Community School.

At this time, I would like to express my appreciation for your support and cooperation this past year.
