Warrant for the Annual Town Meeting March 13, 1945**THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Tuftonboro in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town House in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the thirteenth day of March, next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same. (\$12,690.00, figures of the Budget Committee.)
3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four hundred and sixteen dollars and ninety-nine cents (\$416.99), the State to contribute the sum of one thousand six hundred and sixty-seven dollars and ninety-four cents (\$1,667.94) for Town Road Aid.
4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00) for tarring Town roads.
5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) to reimburse the Town of Wolfeboro for our proportionate share of rent paid for the Ration Board Offices, serving six towns in this community.

6. To see if the Town will vote to support United States membership in a general system of international cooperation, such as that proposed at the Dumbarton Oakes Conference, having police power to maintain the peace of the world.

7. To see if the Town will authorize the Selectmen to sell and dispose of any property which may be acquired by tax deeds.

8. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
