TENTATIVE WARRANT
STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Tuftonboro in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town House in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the twelfth (12) day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same. (\$12,942.00 figures of Budget Committee).

3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four hundred and fifty-eight dollars and seventy-nine cents (\$458.79), the State to contribute the sum of one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five dollars and seventeen cents (\$1835.17) for Town Road Aid.

4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4000.00) for tarring Town roads.

5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of three hundred and seventy-five dollars (\$375.00) for the Public Health Nursing Association of Wolfeboro and Vicinity, Inc.

6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and authorize the use of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) from the general fund to be used toward making a Town Map.

7. To see if the Town will vote to allow 1% discount on all taxes paid before August 1st each year, continuing until rescinded.

8. To see if the Town will authorize the Selectmen to sell and dispose of any property which has been acquired by tax deeds, effective until rescinded.

To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
