To the Inhabitants of the Town of Boscawen in the County of Merrimack in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Boscawen on Tuesday, the 9th day of March, next at ten of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
  - a. Town Officers' Salaries
  - b. Town Officers' Expenses
  - c. Election & Registration
  - d. Expense Town Hall & Town Buildings
  - e. Employees' Social Security
  - f. Police Department
  - g. Fire Departments
  - h. Care of Trees
  - i. Insurance

  - k. Health Officer & Hospitals Art. 4-5
  - l. Vital Statistics
  - m. Sewer Maintenance
  - n. Town Dump
  - o. Highways & Bridges

\*\*\*Business meeting for Appropriations only will be called for 7:30 in the evening.
3. To see if the Town will vote to empower the Selectmen to borrow such sums of money as may be necessary to meet current expense of the Town until the taxes are paid to the Treasurer.
4. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for Concord Hospital.



5. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for Franklin Hospital.
6. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for use at Rolfe Park.
7. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the Penacook Youth Center.
8. To see if the Town will vote to give the Selectmen authority to transfer or sell property taken by Town in default of Redemption from Tax Sale.
9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum not to exceed \$4,000 for the purchase of a new highway tractor to replace the one now in use and authorize the sale or trade of the tractor to be replaced.
10. To appropriate a sum for the Town's share of operation of a Central New Hampshire Regional Planning Commission. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of \$2,131.80 as the Town's share for the studies and operation of the Central New Hampshire Regional Planning Commission. These funds will be used for financing the staff, operation expenses, planning studies, technical assistance and other programs of the Commission. These funds may be used in conjunction with other State and Federal funds available for planning purposes.
11. To see if the town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$12,050.00 (twelve thousand and fifty dollars) for the initiation of a full time Police Department. (See Selectmen report)
12. Shall the zoning ordinance as proposed by the planning board be adopted for this town? (article for vote on printed Town ballot)
- 13 To see if the Town will vote to give the Selectmen authority to transfer any unexpended balance of money from one appropriation to another.
14. To transact any other business which may legally come before this meeting.

## SELECTMEN'S REPORT

The Selectmen have inserted Article No. 11 in the Warrant because we recognize the fact that the town is growing in population. To keep pace with orderly growth, changes and improvements in public service are mandatory. At this point in time there are two agencies, one state, and one Government sponsored, who will give financial assistance to towns that qualify under their respective programs. The Selectmen anticipate aid from the Government Commission on Crime and Delinquency in the amount of approximately \$9,000 for the first year. Unfortunately the state sponsored program has already allotted their funds for this fiscal year. However, the Selectmen, if this Article is passed, will make application immediately for future funds to:

1. Purchase a new cruiser
2. Renovate the old Much-I-Do Fire Station and use as a police cruiser garage and office
3. Train policeman and special officers

The amount of aid from this agency varies, but it is safe to say that upon approval of our projects approximately 50% of the costs would be forthcoming.

The Selectmen feel that the residents of our town should be aware of this condition before it becomes a serious problem, and of course the best time and place to discuss our future problems is at Town Meeting. We urge as many as possible to attend Town Meeting this March because all appropriations will affect our tax rate next year.

**BOSCAWEN PLANNING BOARD**

In 1970, the Planning Board gained experience in administering the Town's sub-division regulations. The purpose of the ordinance is to require sub-dividers and developers to provide lots of such size and nature as to be suitable for water and septic tank systems where these services are not now provided by the Town. Where a sizeable sub-division is involved, the Board sets up requirements for the layout, including streets and utilities. It is intended that sub-divisions will be a credit to the Town, and not result in a future burden on the taxpayers.

The Planning Board has held hearings on the proposed zoning ordinance. We continue to advocate zoning as a method whereby the voters can have a voice in the development and changes which are coming.

Boscawen is a member of the Central New Hampshire Planning Commission. The Commission was formed to help member towns with problems which come with rapid population growth. Of immediate interest is the sewer project. Participation in a regional plan will enhance, but not guarantee, the Town's eligibility for increased grant assistance by the Federal Water Quality Administration. Based on Engineer's estimates, this additional sum would be in the range of \$50,000.

Another Commission project deals with rubbish disposal. This concerns us because the State has set July 1, 1974 as the date when open air burning in dumps is to stop.

## BOSCAWEN COMMUNITY PARK

The activities in Community Park in 1970 were numerous and varied. Two skating areas were maintained during the winter of 1969-70 and were much enjoyed by the children and a few adults. Only our skating area has been maintained during the 1970-71 winter and it has been used a great deal.

The summer program was an Office of Economic Opportunity-sponsored project and we were privileged to have Robin Hodge of Concord as supervisor. Her salary for this pilot project was paid by the Spaulding-Potter Fund. Mrs. Hodge conducted a varied and interesting program and with over ninety children registered and had an average attendance of 45.

A number of interested parents volunteered to help in the program and their assistance was greatly appreciated by Mrs. Hodge and the Park Committee. Mrs. Hodge also had the assistance of High School students from the Youth Corp.

The athletic part of the program was diversified, consisting in part of soft ball, baseball, tether ball, badminton, and horse shoe pitching.

Mrs. Hodge carried on a hand work program which was particularly interesting to the younger set.

Softball teams and Little League baseball teams used the ball field in addition to the regular park program.

Physical facilities at the Park have been improved especially with the completion of the fence along the street and improvement and relocation of the tennis court back stop. The flag pole, dedicated to the memory of Edward (Larry) Sweeney, an enthusiastic and dedicated member of the Recreation Commission, fills a real need.

Vandalism continues to be a very real problem and considerable damage has been done to the toilet and storage building and to some of the other property. The Commission is certain this damage is done by a very small number of thoughtless people but the end result is the same. We hope some solution can be found for this problem.

**REPORT of the FOREST FIRE WARDEN and DISTRICT CHIEF**

The 1970 forest fire season was a quiet one in this area, quiet in part because of your continued cooperation and favorable weather conditions.

Fires that did occur were, for the most part, caused by debris burning, children and smokers.

The elimination of these three causes of forest fires would drastically change this picture – to bring about this change we make the following suggestions:

1. When the ground is not covered with snow a permit to burn must be obtained from the Forest Fire Warden. This permit covers waste burning, even if in an incinerator, grass burning, as well as garden trash and brush burning such burning is restricted by regulation to prior to 9:00 A. M. and after 5:00 P. M. with the following exceptions:

Commercial or industrial burning is permissible at any time under normal conditions but only with the approval of the District Chief and a written permit from the Forest Fire Warden.

2. Fires caused by children can be prevented only with the complete cooperation of parents in the supervision of their children, keep matches out of reach of children, this action will help to prevent fires and may save a life, the life of your child. Try to explain this to your child, won't you?

3. Forest fires caused by smokers can be reduced in number by the exercise of more care in the discarding of matches and smoking material whether from a vehicle or by a hiker. In all cases, make sure that the butt or match you discard is out, dead out. Smokey says, "Thanks for your help", and invites you to join with him in setting a good example for others in the prevention of fires and the protection of our environment.

5. To see if the Precinct will vote to give the Commissioners authority to transfer any unexpended balance of money from one appropriation to another,
6. To see if the Precinct will vote to raise and appropriate a sum not exceeding three thousand (\$3,000.00) for the acquisition of land and rights in land bordering Walker Pond,
7. To see if the Precinct will vote to authorize the Commissioner to purchase a new backhoe and dispose of the backhoe now owned by the Precinct,
8. To see if the Precinct will vote to authorize the Commissioners to negotiate with Merrimack County, relative to extending the water main to the Merrimack County Nursing Home and Hospital on the following basis:
  1. Merrimack County to pay all costs of construction (approximately \$27,000.00),
  2. Precinct to provide free water to the County for a period of six (6) years or \$12,000.00, whichever comes first, based on present meter rates,

9. To transact any other business which may legally come before the meeting.

## COMMISSIONERS' REPORT FOR 1970

We installed approximately 3200 ft. of 8" main on Goodhue Road, two hydrants and two line gates. Also one 8" reducing valve had to be added because of high pressure on the lower elevation.

In accordance with the vote of the special meeting we laid approximately 4500 ft. of 8" main on Route 3 north of Goodhue Road to serve the new development. Five hydrants and five line gates were installed. Approximately 1500 ft. of 6" main was installed in the development with Mr. Hollins supervising the work.

Approximately 600 ft. of 6" main was installed in Birchwood Knoll Development. One hydrant branch and one line gate were used with the hydrant to be put in this year.

Our standpipe on Queen Street was drained and cleaned and painted by Law Brothers, Inc. The inside was sand-blasted to bare metal then given three coats of vinyl paint. The outside was spot-primed and given one coat of aluminum paint.

We have had two breaks in the main on Elm Street, two on Goodhue Road, one on Route 3, and one on Woodbury Lane. We have had a problem with frozen services due to the extreme cold weather.

The land and buildings on Sweatt Street were advertised last summer but no bids were entered. We intend to put it out to bid again this year.

Mr. Bailey was cutting lumber last fall near precinct property on the South side of Walker Pond, so we had him cut some lumber at that time. The proceeds (\$1,647.00) were carried forward and used in the 1971 budget to reduce precinct taxes.

Approximately 177,778,150 gallons of water were pumped in 1970. This is about 13,241,150 gallons more than in 1969. We think this could be due to the Concord gate being partly open while the tank was being painted.
