TOWN WARRANT

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Tuftonboro in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the eleventh day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same. (\$14,969.00) figures of Budget Committee.

3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four hundred and sixty dollars and sixty nine cents (\$460.69), the State to contribute the sum of one thousand eight hundred and forty two dollars and seventy six cents (1842.76).

4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4000.) for tarring Town roads.

5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to go with the balance of one thousand one hundred and seventy nine dollars and sixty one cents under New Equipment to be used to buy a Bull Grader to be used with present tractors.

6. To see if the Town will authorize the use of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) from the General Fund and the hiring of four thousand dollars to be paid at one thousand per year for the construction and erection of the following Memorials for all persons from the Town of Tuftonboro who have served in the Armed forces of the United States in time of War.

First — To complete the baseball field at the Central School to be called the Davis-Robblee Memorial Field and be so marked.

Second — To erect in front of the School a Bronze Plaque mounted on a native boulder set on a cement foundation. The Plaque to contain the names of all persons from the Town of Tuftonboro who have served in the Armed Forces of the United States in the time of War.

7. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

Given under our hands and seal, this 22nd day of February, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and forty seven.
