**TOWN WARRANT****THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Tuftonboro in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town House in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the ninth day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing, also a Delegate to Constitutional Convention.

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same. (\$17,916.00) figures of Budget Committee.

3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four hundred sixty-two dollars and fifty-four cents (\$462.54), the State to contribute the sum of one thousand eight hundred and fifty dollars and fourteen cents (\$1850.14) for Town Road Aid.

4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4000.) for tarring Town Roads.

5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2000.) to be used on the Davis Memorial Field.

6. To see if the Town will vote to replace the present wooden bridge on Tuftonboro Neck with a cement bridge, the water-way to be approximately 2

feet wider and 2 feet higher than the present bridge, by petition of Frank Wiggin and others.

7. To see if the Town will vote to accept as a town road the right of way known as Barber's Pole Road which runs from the State road 109 near Kenneth King's residence to the Lake near the Annie Lindol camp at Barber's Pole.

8. To see if the Town will appoint a Citizens Committee to handle the question of the Town Dump according to instructions of said meeting.

9. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
