TOWN WARRANT

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Stoddard in the County of Cheshire in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Stoddard on Tuesday, the fifth day of March, next at seven-thirty of the clock in the afternoon, to act upon the following subjects:

- l. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
- 2. Polls will be open at 1 P.M. and will remain open until 7 P.M. The business of the Town Meeting will open at 7:30 P.M.
- 3. To elect a Delegate to the Constitutional Convention to be held May 8, 1974.
- 4. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same.
- 5. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the Highways and Bridges for the ensuing year.
- 6. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for Snow Removal for the ensuing year.
- 7. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the general expenses of the Highway Department for the ensuing year.
- 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Three Hundred Forty-Two Dollars and Thirty-Two Cents (342.32) for T.R.A. so called.
- 9. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for the purpose of starting a rebuilding program on the necessary sections of the Juniper Hill, Bailey, and Old Antrim roads.
- 10. To see if the Town will vote to eliminate the job of Road Agent. All former duties of the Road Agent to be performed under direct control of the Selectmen of Stoddard. By Petition.

- 11. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the maintenance of public landings.
- 12. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the maintenance of the Fire Department for the ensuing year.
- 13. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars to put into a capital reserve fund for a new fire truck.
- 14. To see if the Town will vote to authorize withdrawal from the Revenue Sharing Fund established under the provisions of the State and Local Assistance Act of 1972 the amount of FIVE Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars and Forty-Six Cents (\$5,184.46) to be transferred to the Capital Reserve Fund for the new fire truck.
- 15. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum not to exceed Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) to build a new Fire Station. Said Fire Station to be a one story, 40' by 60' building, built on land given the Town, opposite Eaton's General Store. To authorize the selectmen to accept one of at least four bids for the construction of this building, to be paid for over a period of years, and to further authorize the selectmen to borrow on notes or bonds. To determine the time and place of payment of such notes or bonds, and to determine the rate of interest thereon, and to take such other steps as may be necessary to negotiate such notes or bonds as shall be in the best interest of the Town of Stoddard.
- 16. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the maintenance of the Police Department for the ensuing year.
- 17. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Two Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars (\$238.00) in support of the operating costs of the Cheshire Hospital for the year 1974.
- 18. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Four Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars (\$492.00) for the support of the Monadnock Region Association.
- 19. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for street lights for the ensuing year.
 - 20. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise

and appropriate for the maintenance of the Public Library.

- 21. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of Taxes.
- 22. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the Town Dump.
- 23. To see if the Town will vote to join with other communities to use a particular solid waste disposal facility, with each participating community paying their pro-rate share of the costs of establishing such a facility and the operating costs thereof, as permitted under R.S.A. 53-A.
- 24. To see if the Town will vote to accept the provisions of the Municipal Budget Act.
- 25. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) to be used by the Bi-Centennial Committee in preparation and presentation of the 1974 Celebration. Any proceeds above expenses will revert to the Town.
- 26. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) to be used by the Stoddard History Committee to pay for the publication of the Town Histories. Any income over and above expenses from the sale of said Histories will revert to the Town.
- 27. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$121.00) to support the services of the Community Health Clinic of the Monadnock Family and Mental Health Service.
- 28. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$130.00) as its fair share of the operating costs of the North Cheshire County Home Health Service.
- 29. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the necessary funds to construct two bathrooms in the Town Hall, also to complete bringing the water into the building.
- 30. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to hire one or more competent persons to start work on a Tax Map for the town and to raise and appropriate Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for this purpose.

- 31. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the necessary funds to paint the interior and exterior of the Town Hall, the exterior of the Fire Station, Town Barn, and Library.
- 32. To see if the Town will vote to become a member of the regional planning commission, now organized and named the Southwestern New Hampshire Regional Planning Commission, and vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars and Sixteen Cents (\$178.17) as the Town's share for the studies and operation of the Southwestern New Hampshire Regional Planning Commission.
- 33. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to appoint an ad hoc committee of no less than three persons to study the feasibility of incorporating a recycling program into the Town's solid waste disposal plan, said committee hereinafter to be called the Recycle Feasibility Committee. The Recycle Feasibility Committee shall report its findings to the Selectmen on or before June 1, 1974. Also to see if the Town will raise and appropriate a sum, not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) to cover legitimate expenses of the Recycle Feasibility Committee in carrying out its study.

SELECTMEN'S REPORT

During the past year, the selectmen have spent a great deal of time on the re-evaluation of properties, as well as new developments. We believe that with few exceptions, the property values will remain stable for some time. This means that your taxes should not change unless so voted at the Town Meeting.

Early in the spring, State engineers were asked to explore the problems involved on installing the water and sewer systems in the Town Hall. Plans were submitted to the selectmen calling for the septic system to be installed below the Town Hall. After several meetings with the State officials, it was decided that this area was too close to the adjoining property. It was also decided that we could not meet the requirements to drill a well on town property. This made it necessary to look for alternate sources of water. It was finally decided to utilize the school well, which we were assured has an ample supply. New plans were also drawn up to install the septic system in the rear of the hall.

When the water project was started, it was necessary to go around the school house so as not to disturb the school's septic system. We then went across the Church yard, Center Pond Road and down the east side of Route 123, crossing the road in front of the Town Hall.

After reviewing the additional cost, which was higher than the appropriation, it was decided that it would be in the best interest of the Town to go ahead as soon as possible, so that it would be available for the Bi-Centennial.

The water pipe is now all laid and ready to connect at both ends. Some smoothing of the yards will be necessary in the spring. The septic system is also all installed and ready to be connected to the Hall.

Soon after town meeting last year, we decided to vacate the Library, as they were badly in need of more space. To do this, we moved into the old office room at the Town Hall. However, to carry on in cold weather, it was necessary to make some changes in the heating system. We also at this time, made the arrangements for the heat in the new toilets. This, with the increased fuel cost, has increased our cost of Town Hall expenses over the last year.

We are pleased to report that the new truck has proven very

satisfactory.

During the past year, we have received many complaints about the condition of the town roads. We have tried to keep them in passable condition with the money available; however, we believe a definite program of rebuilding should be undertaken in the spring, the town to raise the money accordingly.

During the past year, we were forced to rebuild the lower end of the old Antrim Road, a portion of Shedd Hill Road, as well as part of the Bailey Road, and Juniper Hill Road. These were all badly washed out, as we were not eligible for Federal Aid, this was all charged to our summer road account.

ANNUAL REPORT TO TOWNS

The Agency has provided the services of a registered nurse on a visiting part-time basis for twenty hours per week. A registered physical therapist and a male licensed practical nurse are available by appointment on a contract arrangement. Nursing services offered include skilled care of the sick at home, health guidance and assistance in referral to other community resources.

The Child Health Conference which provides free medical supervision and immunizations to low-income families has been maintained. The clinics are held in the Gilsum Church on a monthly basis. This program has provided children in 21 families with 97 doses of vaccines in 96 clinic visits.

In addition a family health discussion group has been held in conjunction with the C.H.C. All parents are invited to this informal discussion with the doctor about pertinent health topics.

It is the people of the towns who have made these services available with tax money and contributions to our membership drive. Many have helped by volunteering their time to serve on the Board, on committees, in membership drives, assisting at clinics and providing transportation. Without all of your help it would be impossible to provide these important services.

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said district on the seventh day of March 1974 at seven-thirty o'clock in the afternoon to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose by non-partisan ballot the following school district officials:
 - A. Moderator for the ensuing year.
 - B. Clerk for the ensuing year.
 - C. Treasurer for the ensuing year.
 - D. A member of the School Board for the ensuing three years.
 - E. A member of the School Board for the ensuing two years (to complete the unexpired term of Charles Hill and filled for one year by the appointment of Andrew T. Anderson)
 - F. Auditor for the ensuing year.
- 2. To determine and appoint the salaries of the School Board and fix the compensation for any other officers or agents of the district.
- 3. To hear the reports of Agents, Auditors and Committees or Officers chosen and pass any vote relating thereto.
- 4. To choose Agents and Committees in relation to any subject embraced in this warrant.
- 5. To see what sum of money the District will vote to raise and appropriate for the support of schools, for the payment of salaries for school district officials and agents and for the payment of statutory obligations of the district.

- 6. To see if the district will enter into contract with another school district to pay tuition in excess of the state average.
- 7. To see if the district will vote to authorize the School Board to make application for, and to accept on behalf of the district any and all grants or other funds for educational purposes which may now or hereafter be forthcoming from the United States Government or from the State of New Hampshire for the school year 1974-75.
- 8. Shall the school district accept the provisions of R.S.A. 195-A, or any amendments thereto, providing for the establishment of an area school in Keene to serve grades nine through twelve from the school districts of Marlow and Stoddard in accordance with the provisions of the plan on file with the district clerk.
- 9. To see if the district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.) to establish a Capital Reserve Fund for building purposes, or to take any other action relative thereto.
- 10. To see if the district will vote to adopt the provisions of RSA 31:105, and thereby indemnify and save harmless district employees or agents from claims arising out of their employment with the district, or take any other action in relation thereto.
- 11. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

This report is an account of the school health program for the school year 1972-73.

The heights and weights, eye examinations, and hearing tests were recorded of the twenty-one students with votification of the results sent to the parents. One student obtained glasses.

The state dental hygenist presented a program reminding the students of the need of daily dental care.

A clinic sponsored by the State Health Services was held in February at the Hillsboro-Deering School. Thirteen students received polio vaccine and one student received the measle vaccine.

The Tine test for tuberculosis was administered to the school personnel.

Several preventative health films were shown throughout the school year.

SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS MESSAGE

An annual message is most difficult this year in this period of national duress with everyone at uned to the energy crisis, overall economic unrest, political chaos and the many socio-economic pressures generated from these factors. Education in depth has become intrinsically more and more significant through the years to preserve individual identity and help to prepare all members of our society to be able to effectively cope with the pressures wrought.

We have seen educational strides in the district with sound efforts being made to broaden programs of studies and at the same time attempting to meet individual differences. Throughout the Supervisory Union the staff turnover has been higher than normal as has been the administrative change, but curricular improvement has been effected.

With some new programs, new approaches, greater interaction, and focusing on student individuality, the schools' administrators and teachers have worked hard in improving the educational process. Discussion is under way relative to vocational education and seeking outlets for students desirous of intensive programs. Additionally there has been far more concern manifested for children with learning handicaps, and additional staffing has been added to help correct deficiencies in language arts, assist slow learners, and assist in learning disabilities.

The proposed budget reflects the inflationary factors that have reached every facet of our economy. Wherein previously the fixed cost budget was computed using past performance criteria and standard rates, the recent energy crisis issues have grossly inflated here-to-fore stabilized prices and left us with many doubts and fears of under-budgeting. As we have all seen in our day to day living costs, no single area is exempted from increase and critical shortages exist with many products.

Many legislative changes occurred as a result of the last legislative session. The majority of changes were procedural, but direct impact items include: (1) Each school board shall make a nutritious breakfast or lunch available to every pupil under its jurisdiction. Schools that have not previously had meals may make application for waiver, but no waiver may extend beyond September 30, 1979. (2) Nutrition education shall be integrated into the regular courses of instruction for grades K-12. (3) In addition to alchol and drug education, instruction shall also be given on venereal diseases and their effect on the human system.

(4) Districts not maintaining high schools must now pay full tuition of its students who attend high schools in other districts, (5) and of course, amendments or insertions for legal age of eighteen in the many statutes.

Although less emphasis has been forthcoming, the initial goals for implementation of local minimum standards to correct deficiencies have been largely or totally met at this juncture.

The voucher system has been discussed with each board and now some districts are making preparations for institution of this educational alternative project.

Through the years we have seen an ever expanding educational process and many ramifications have evidenced themselves, sometimes budgetarily, some with major problems in articulation, but in every instance we have packed more and more into a 180 day schedule. We have had good community support for which we are most appreciative. The interactive process of education and society brings a multiplicity of opinions and standards, thus making decision-making most difficult. I thank you for your support, understanding and assistance in improving our educational ventures.
