

WARRANT

To the inhabitants of the Town of Temple in the County of Hillsborough, in said State, qualified to vote in Town affairs:

You are hereby notified to met at the Town Hall in said Temple, on Tuesday the Tenth day of March next, at eight o'clock in the morning, to act upon the following subjects.

Article 1. To cast your ballots for the election of all officers required to be elected to serve the Town of Temple for the ensuing year.

Article 2. To cast your ballots for the election of such officers as may be required, by law, to serve the Contoocook Valley School District for the ensuing year.

THE POLLS SHALL OPEN AT EIGHT O'CLOCK IN THE MORNING, AND SHALL CLOSE NOT EARLIER THAN SEVEN O'CLOCK IN THE EVENING.

You are further notified to meet at the Municipal Building in said Temple, on Saturday, the Fourteenth Day of March next, at ten o'clock in the morning, to act upon the following:

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **\$800,403.34** for Town charges and other necessary maintenance and operating expenditures.

Recommended by Selectmen - unanimous

Article 4. To hear reports of agents, auditors and committees or officers heretofore chosen and to pass any vote relating thereto.

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **\$50,000.00** to be put into the Bridge Capital Reserve Fund and to name the Selectmen of the Town of Temple to act as agents for the expenditures of this fund, or take any other action relating thereto.

Recommended by Selectmen - unanimous

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **\$28,428.00** for the purpose of purchasing and equipping a new police cruiser for the Police Department, or take any other action relating thereto.

Not Recommended by Selectmen - 2 to 1

Article 7. To see if the Town will vote to request the Selectmen of the Town of Temple to discontinue the use of the Inventory for Taxable Property form, under RSA 74:4-a or take any other action relating thereto.

By Petition

Not Recommended by Selectmen - unanimous

Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **\$40,000.00** for the purpose of reevaluating all real estate in the Town of Temple, or take any other action relating thereto.

Recommended by Selectmen - 2 to 1

Article 9. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen of the Town of Temple to appoint a committee to further study whether the Town of Temple should purchase the old Temple Elementary School from Contoocook Valley Regional School District, and how to best utilize the structure. Said committee shall report to the 1999 Town Meeting with detailed recommendation and cost estimates. Further to see whether the Town shall raise and appropriate the sum of **\$500.00**, to cover the expenses of said committee, or take any other action thereto.

Recommended by Selectmen - unanimous

Article 10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **\$1,300.00** to pay for certain studies of electric load profiles within the Town and other related research in furtherance of the possible aggregation of the Town's and/or its residents' and businesses' electric loads in the NHMA Pooled Energy Plan in preparation for deregulation of the electric industry in New Hampshire.

Recommended by Selectmen - unanimous

Article 11. To see if the Town will vote to retain and hold for public uses three parcels of land; taken by Tax Deed for back taxes, reference Map 2 Lots 41, 41-1, and 41-2, under the management of the Conservation Commission of the Town of Temple.

SELECTMEN'S REPORT

1997

During the year of 1997 we initiated many changes for the Town of Temple. The Highway Department got its new dump truck and plowing equipment, a new bridge was constructed on Hadley Highway, we joined the Wilton Lyndeborough Ambulance Service, we repaired and painted parts of the old Town Hall, the E911 Addressing is nearing completion, and the new cemetery is slowly but surely being prepared for the future.

During the year of 1998 we hope to be initiating some or all of the following proposals.

1. To start the process of preserving the old records of the town.
2. To upgrade the Tax Maps.
3. To repair and paint the windows at the old Town Hall.
4. To install a security system at the Municipal Building.
5. To continue to improve the new cemetery for the future.
6. For the town to keep three lots taken for back property taxes on Rt. 45 known as Map & Lot numbers 2-41, 2-41-1 and 2-41-2 for the future.
7. To keep our annual inventory of taxable property system intact as it is.
8. To appropriate money for a new bridge on Webster Highway at the intersection of Putnam Road and Webster Highway and to construct that new bridge as soon as possible.
9. To appropriate money to reassess the whole town.
10. To appropriate money to continue studying the space needs of the town in general and, in particular whether the town should purchase the existing Temple Elementary School from the ConVal School District.
11. To see the E911 Addressing through to completion.
12. Last but not least, to initiate and run a 2.3 million dollar business for all the residents of the great Town of Temple. Thank you!

For the Year of 1997

The population of the town of Temple, New Hampshire on December 31, 1997 was 1,257 to the best of my knowledge.

1997 saw big changes in the Temple Fire Station. On December 1 the 1973 pumper was retired and in its place sets a Wilton, Lyndeborough, Temple ambulance. The Temple Rescue Squad disbanded and medical care is now controlled by the new Wilton, Lyndeborough, Temple Ambulance Service. An Emergency Equipment line item has been added to the Temple Fire Department budget. These funds are to be used to purchase and maintain equipment for ambulance personnel of Temple. Thanks to the hard work and dedication of Temple emergency medical technicians. Ambulance response is now the best Temple has ever had, and among the best in the state.

Vehicle maintenance was quite more than we expected last year due to the tanker. Budgeted maintenance on the transmission went well but radiator repair and replacement of two expensive tank valves put the budget over.

In April, a positive pressure ventilator (PPV) was purchased to quickly remove heat, smoke and gasses from a burning structure. Firefighting in a smoke filled building is extremely dangerous due to the high temperatures and the blinding smoke. We have used the PPV at several fire drills and our one structure fire and have found it very effective.

Please be vigilant at home about any potential fire source. A candle started the one structure fire last year. In the past ignition sources have been stove ashes, paper too near a wood stove, dirty chimneys, toaster ovens on unground-faulted circuits, portable electric heaters and cigarettes. The number of fire calls in town were down last year, and that is fine with us. We will keep training, preparing for the worst and hope for the best.

**FOREST FIRE WARDEN
AND
STATE FOREST RANGER**

To aid your Forest Fire Warden, Fire Department and State Forest Ranger, contact your local Warden or Fire Department to find out if a permit is required. Violations of RSA 227-L:17, the fire permit law and the other burning laws of the State of New Hampshire are misdemeanors punishable by fines of up to \$2,000.00 and/or a year in jail. Violators are also liable for all fire suppression costs.

There are ten Forest Rangers who work for the New Hampshire Division of Forests and Land, Forest Protection Bureau. State Forest Rangers are available to assist communities with forest fire suppression, prevention and training programs as well as the enforcement of forest fire and timber harvest laws. If you have any questions regarding forest fire or timber harvest laws, please call our office at 271-2217.

There are 2400 Forest Fire Wardens and Deputy Forest Fire Wardens throughout the state. Each town has a Forest Fire Warden and several Deputy Wardens who assist the Forest Rangers with forest fire suppression, prevention and law enforcement. The 1997 fire season was a safe period for wildland firefighters with no major injuries reported. The drought conditions experienced during the early summer months were a significant factor resulting in the total number of fires reported during the season.

The State of New Hampshire operates 15 fire towers, 2 mobile patrols and 3 contract aircraft patrols. This early detection and reports from citizens aid in the quick response from local fire departments. This is a critical factor in controlling the size of wildland fires and keeping the loss of property and suppression costs as low as possible.

TOWN FORESTER'S REPORT

For the tax year April 1, 1996 through March 31, 1997, 14 Reports of Wood or Timber Cut were received by the Town. Yield taxes assessed for these harvesting operations totaled \$8,509.45.

The lumber market has continued to improve over the past year. The demand for forest products in our area has remained strong and stumpage prices have continued to increase. As of February 5, 1998, 15 Intents to Cut have been filed with the Town for the current tax year. The projected yield taxes that will be generated from the harvesting operations filed for so far this year are estimated to be about \$17,238. The number of timber harvests in Town has remained consistent with last year. However, the size of the jobs have increased resulting in a substantial increase in Yield taxes for the period.

The State RSA specifies that any person owning land upon which wood or timber is cut, either for sale or for services rendered, must first file an Intent to Cut form with the Town Selectmen or assessing officials. The exception to this is a person cutting up to 10,000 board feet of logs for their own use, or a person cutting up to 20 cords of fuel wood for their own domestic fuel purposes, within the tax year. Under these exceptions an individual does not have to file an Intent to Cut form. The tax years runs from April 1st to March 31st.

The RSA also states that within 60 days of completion of the operation or by April 15th, a Report of Wood or Timber Cut must be filed with the Town specifying the exact volume cut by species. The Town will levy a 10 percent yield tax based on the stumpage value of the material cut. If the job is not completed by March 31st or did not take place, a Report of Cut must still be filed by April 15th. At that time, a new Intent to Cut should be filed to renew the permit. If the job is not completed by March 31st but will be completed by June 30th, a 90 day extension may be granted without having to renew the permit. To do this the Selectmen must be notified in writing by the Owner, prior to April 15th.

Finally, during a harvesting operation, if the volumes to be harvested are going to exceed the estimated volumes on the original Intent to Cut, a supplemental Intent should be filed immediately showing the additional estimated volumes.

Landowners considering a timber harvest should be aware that there are State harvesting regulations that must be followed. If you have any questions regarding this or the permitting process, contact me at the Selectmen's Office, or by phone at 654-6868.

SOUTHWEST REGION PLANNING COMMISSION

The Planning Commission, with a service area covering 35 municipalities in Cheshire and Hillsborough Counties, is one of New Hampshire's nine regional planning agencies established by RSA 36. We continue to provide planning-related assistance to member communities and to represent the Southwest Region in state and federal programs. Our diverse work program covers activities such as local planning assistance, regional information systems & mapping, transportation planning, community & economic development, and natural resources planning. We are funded through multiple sources including local dues contributed by member municipalities. For every dollar of local dues, the Commission's operating budget includes over four additional dollars to assist in meeting the needs of the Region and its municipal members. These additional funds are provided in the form of various federal, state and local grants and contracts. These resources provide the Commission the ability to assemble a professional staff which member municipalities have direct access to.

Highlights of Commission activities for the past year include establishing an economic development planning program; award of a contract to study the Route 101 corridor from Keene to Milford; facilitation of a 10-year Transportation Improvement Program for the Southwest Region; preparation of a document and process to promote natural resources planning; participation in sponsoring several educational forums on planning related topics; and, use of a federal grant award to construct a mobile resource awareness center for educational purposes. In addition to the above, we provided oversight assistance pertaining to the Temple Mountain project being considered for submittal under the State's Community Development Block Grant program. We were also fortunate to conduct our Quarterly Commission meeting in Temple this past October.

The actual cost of all services provided in 1997 with all funding sources is projected to be \$21,470.70.

These services have been supported to the greatest extent possible by Medicare, Medicaid, other insurances, grants and patient fees. Services that were not covered by other funding have been supported by your town.

For 1998, we recommend an appropriation of \$1,750.00 to continue home care services at the current level.

As you know, Monadnock Family Services is active in your community providing quality mental health services to all residents who need them regardless of their ability to pay. As part of this mission, we feel it is important to let you know the extent of our work. We are pleased to give you the enclosed census report which outlines the services provided to Temple residents during the 1996/1997 fiscal year.

MFS is requesting financial support to help underwrite services we provide to uninsured and underinsured individuals in Temple. We are asking for an amount equal to \$1 per capita based on figures from 1993 population estimates from the NH Office of State Planning. For Temple, this amounts to \$1,373.00. We work continually to keep our costs down, and to identify, whenever possible, alternate sources of funding for this population. As a result, our requests to towns have remained unchanged since 1990.

The support you have provided to MFS in the past is deeply appreciated, and we hope that our partnership in caring for the citizens of Temple will continue with the incorporation of this request in your town's budget.

In addition to the census report, I have enclosed a number of materials describing the services we provide. If you have any questions, or require further information, a representative from the agency will be happy to speak with you, or the Budget Committee.

Again, we appreciate the assistance you have offered in the past. In light of the current pressures and challenges we all face as town administrators, helping professionals and private citizens, it is more important than ever that we work together for the health and well-being of our communities.

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

Winter:

The winter months of 1997 were very busy months for the highway crew. We had about 21 small snowstorms in January, February, and March. Most of the snowstorms ended with rain causing the sand and salt bills to run higher than usual. Fortunately, we had good stockpiles and didn't run out of either. Then of course was the 27" snowstorm to start spring off on April 1.

The snowstorms started earlier than usual in November and continued on into December. This gave us a white Thanksgiving as well as a white Christmas. Altogether, things went quite well. With no major breakdowns or problems, we ended the year with about \$11,000.00 left over.

Summer:

We had a lot of projects to do along with our normal maintenance in the spring and summer of 1997. Our "mud season" came but dried up quite quickly in April allowing us to get the ditching and grading done fairly early. Thanks to a lack of thunderstorms and heavy showers, the dirt roads held up well for the remainder of the summer.

In July we worked on replacing and repairing various culverts, hauling gravel, and mowing roadsides. I would like to thank the Lorden family for donating approximately 900 yards of gravel to the Highway Dept. This gravel was mixed together with another pile of gravel that we already had, crushed down to 1 1/2" size, then used to help rebuild a section of East Rd.

The month of August was spent mainly on preparing East Rd. and Webster Rd. for paving and sealing. We cleaned the culverts and ditches then dug big rocks out of the roads.

September was very busy. We had F.W. Whitcomb start rebuilding the bridge on Hadley Hwy. over Gambol Brook. J.G.E. Excavating came in with a machine to grind up the pavement on the section of East Rd. that we were rebuilding. When our reconstruction was finished, Brox Paving came in to repave 5/10 mile of East Rd. and 4/10 mile of Webster Rd. When this was completed, we shimmed up a few more of the bad sections of these roads then sealed and sanded them.

Our new dump truck arrived in October. It is an impressive piece of equipment and should serve the town quite well for many years. The bridge over Gambol Brook was completed in October also. This bridge should be good for 75 - 100 years due to the excellent workmanship that was done both in the engineering and in the construction of it. I would like to thank Ben Tirey and Dick Keuper for their professional help in choosing an engineering firm to design the bridge for us. Their help was very much appreciated.

Then came time to prepare for winter again. We graded most of the dirt roads. We also put in our stockpile of winter sand and readied the equipment for the winter months.

In 1998, the Highway Dept. will be working quite a lot on Hadley Hwy. and in that area of town. We plan on installing a large amount of drainage on Mountain View Dr. and replacing some of the culverts. We also hope to get started with the engineering of a new bridge to replace the existing bridge on Webster Rd. by the Pony Farm. If we can get that done we should be able to schedule the rebuilding for the summer of 1999.

CEMETERIES 1997

In addition to our usual maintenance, we had to do a little serious tree work in 1997. Two of the large pine trees in Miller Cemetery were getting sickly and had to be taken down and the stumps removed. We also lost the top half of a large pine tree in the April 1st snowstorm. Fortunately, it did very little damage when it came down, missing all of the gravestones. Still another of the pine trees was struck by lightening on July 9th and it will probably need to be removed in 1998. The huge maple tree in East Cemetery is slowly dying. We had a tree surgeon come in, remove all of the dead limbs, then cable the two sections that are beginning to split apart back together, rather than take it completely down.

It was very fortunate for the town that the excavating company for the new school needed a place to dump a lot of fill in July. We had them haul approximately 3000 yds. of it to the new cemetery site across from the ballpark. They also donated 700 yds. of topsoil which has been stockpiled towards the back side of this area.

In the 1998 budget, you will notice that \$5000.00 has been added. This will be used to screen and move the pile of topsoil that we have collected at the site. It will also be used to build an entrance road down into the site and to move the fill around in preparation for more fill being hauled in. Bit by bit the site is taking shape.

by Robert Frazier to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$764,409.18 for town charges and other necessary maintenance and operations expenditures. Seconded by Brian Kullgren. Voted in the affirmative.

Article 3: To hear the reports of agents, auditors, and committees or officers heretofore chosen and to vote relating thereto. No vote taken.

Article 4: Motion by Debra Shea to see if the town will vote to accept the provisions of RSA 72:28 for an expanded qualifying war service for veterans seeking the tax credit. (This would allow a resident who has served a qualifying war or armed conflict since May 8, 1975 and earned an armed forces expeditionary medal or theater of operation medal to qualify for the veterans credit). Seconded by James LaPree. Voted in the affirmative.

Article 5: Motion by Debra Shea to see if the town will vote to modify the elderly exemptions from property tax in the Town of Temple, based on assessed value for qualified taxpayers, to be as follows: For a person 65 years or older, \$25,000.00. To qualify, the taxpayer must have been a N.H. resident for at least 5 years. In addition, the taxpayer must have a net income of not more than \$13,400.00 or if married, a combined net income of less than \$20,400.00; and own assets not in excess of \$35,000.00 excluding the value of the persons residence. Seconded by Brian Kullgren. Voted in the affirmative.

Article 6: Motion by Sherry Fiske to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 to the Milford Area Mediation Program. The Mediation Program will provide service to any Temple family requesting said services free of charge. Seconded by Debra Shea. Voted in the affirmative.

Article 7: Motion by Sherry Fiske to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100.00 to Project Lift, an organization which provides free individualized instruction for area residents over the age of 16 and without a high school diploma or a GED. Seconded by Brian Kullgren. Voted in the affirmative.

Article 8: Motion by Tim Fiske to see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen for the Town of Temple to enter into a lease purchase agreement for the purpose of leasing a new dump truck and plowing equipment for the Highway Department, and to raise and appropriate the amount of \$28,500.00, minus any value realized from vehicle trade-in for the first years payment for that purpose. Seconded by Debra Shea. Voted in the affirmative.

Article 9: Motion by Debra Shea to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$160,000.00 to rebuild a town bridge. This amount is required to be voted on by the Town of Temple in anticipation of reimbursement by the State of N.H. for this amount as their share of this project. Seconded by Brian Kullgren. Voted in the unanimous affirmative.

Article 10: Motion by Debra Shea to see if the town will vote to adopt the provisions of RSA 202-A:4-D authorizing the Library to accept gifts of personal property, other than money, which may be offered to the Library for any public purpose, provided however, that acceptance of personal property by the Library Trustees shall not be deemed to bind the Town of Temple or the Library Trustees to raise, appropriate, or expend any public funds for the operation, maintenance, repair or replacement of such personal property. Seconded by Brian Kullgren. Voted in the unanimous affirmative.

Article 12: Motion by Robin Downes to amend article to read: to see if the town will vote to authorize and selectmen for the Town of Temple to appoint, and raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 to fund, a committee to study the space needs of the town in general and, in particular, whether the town should purchase the existing Temple Elementary School and land from the ConVal district following completion of the new elementary school. This committee would be directed to present recommendations at the 1998 Town Meeting. Seconded by Robert Frazier. Voted in the unanimous affirmative.

Motion by Richard Beringer to adjourn Town Meeting. Seconded by William Wildes. Voted in the affirmative. Meeting adjourned at 2:55 p.m.
