

1. Motion presenter: Joseph Dwyer, on behalf of the Academic Affairs Committee
2. Dates of Faculty Senate Discussion: 11/25/19, 12/09/19, 02/03/20, 02/17/20
3. **Rationale:** In order to maintain an approved five-year UNH E-term Calendar, the AY 23/24 and AY 24/25 must be reviewed and included as the last two years of the five-year UNH E-term calendar.
