To the inhabitants of the town of Stewartstown in the County of Coos and State aforesaid qualified to vote at Town affairs.

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Stewartstown on Tuesday the 10th day of March next at ten of the clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects:—

- 1st To choose all necessary Town officers for the year ensuing.
- 2nd To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray
 Town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriation of
 the same.
- 3rd To see what sum of money the Town will raise to apply on the Town debt
- 4th To see what sum of money the Town will raise in addition to that raised by Law to be expended on Roads & Bridges.
- 5th To see what sum of money the Town will raise "if any" to be expended on winter roads and make appropriation of the same.
- 6th To see what the Town will let the Grangers have the use of the Town Hall for.
- 7th To see if the Town will vote to establish a Police Court in the Town.
- 8th To express by Ballot, whether the alterations and Amendments of the Constitution proposed by the Constitutional Convention shall be approved.
