On forming an ad hoc review committee for the Discovery Program

1. Motion Presenter: Nicky Gullace, Faculty Director, Discovery Program
2. Date of Faculty discussion: 02/25/2019
3. **Rationale:** The implementation of the Discovery Program was endorsed by the Faculty Senate in the spring of 2009. A review of the program was conducted in 2015. Although another 5-year review is not required, the Discovery Committee and the Faculty Senate Agenda Committee feel that a review is warranted as we approach the 5-year anniversary of the last review.
4. **Motion:** The Faculty Senate endorses a review of the Discovery Program. The Faculty Senate will form an ad hoc review committee which will have faculty representatives from each college. The committee membership will include at least one faculty senator and at least one faculty member of the Discovery Program Committee. The Faculty Senate will invite the Director of the Discovery Program and selected non-faculty members to serve on the committee. The Agenda Committee will establish the goals of the ad hoc committee.
5. **Senate action:** The motion was put to a vote and passed with 60 voting in favor, none opposed, and no abstentions.
