

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of schools for the ensuing year.

3. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year.

4. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the repairs of highways and bridges for the ensuing year.

5. To see what sums of money the town will vote to raise for the public library for the ensuing year.

6. To see if the town will vote to new plank the old bridge, and to choose agents for the same.
