

TOWN OF HART'S LOCATION

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of the Town of Hart's Location in the County of Carroll in the said State, qualified to vote in Town affairs.

You are hereby notified to meet at Notchland Inn, in the said Town on Tuesday, the eleventh day of March next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the ensuing year.

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray Town charges for the ensuing year, and make appropriations of same.

3. To raise and appropriate such a sum of money as may be necessary by taxation, to defray the Town debt for the years 1939 to 1941.

4. To authorize the selectmen to borrow sums of Money on taxes due the town of Hart's Location in the year nineteen forty-one by notes with interest, to be used in the payment of the Town debts.

5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate seven dollars (\$7.00) for the support of the White Mountains Regional Association.

6. To see if the Town will vote to petition the State Tax Commission to have an audit made by the Municipal Accounting Division and to make an appropriation to cover the expense of such an audit. 7. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for snow removal.

8. To see if the Town will vote to raise any needed sum for its share of any Town Road so-called, as its share for any State Highway Departments funds of any such road within the Town.

9. To act upon any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
