



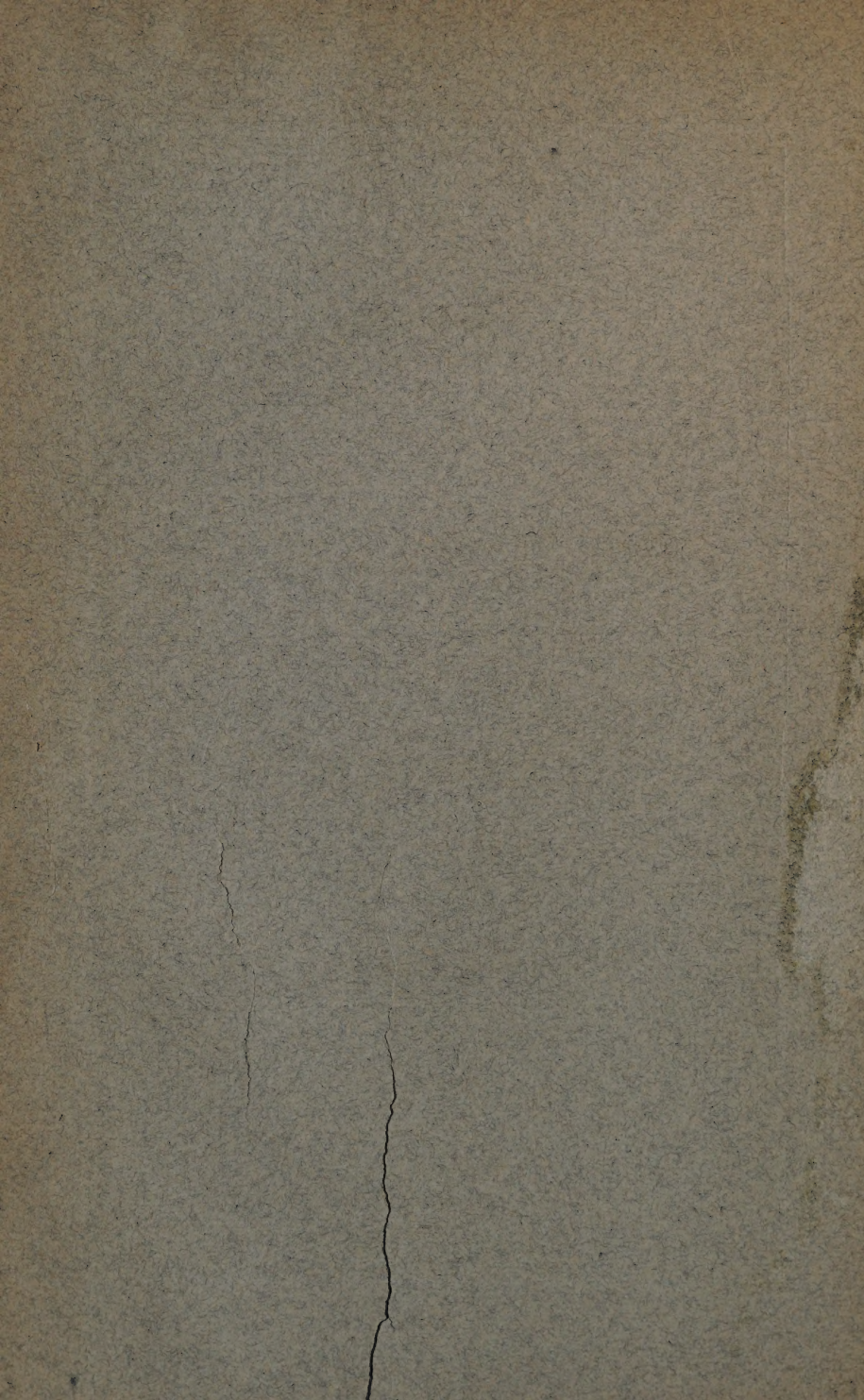

# WARRANT FOR ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

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## STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE.

{ L. S. }

*To the Inhabitants of the Town of Lebanon qualified to vote in town affairs.*

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said town on the **Second Tuesday of March** next at **ten** of the clock in the forenoon to act on the following subjects:

**First**—To choose a Town Clerk for the ensuing year.

**Second**—To choose three Selectmen, Overseer of the Poor, Collector of Taxes, Highway Agent and all other necessary town officers for the ensuing year.

**Third**—To choose a Trustee to administer the Trust Funds of the town for three years.

**Fourth**—To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges the ensuing year.

**Fifth**—To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to construct and repair highways and bridges for the ensuing year.

**Sixth**—To see if the town will vote to instruct the Selectmen to raise money by bonding the town as occasion may arise, to build new bridges.

**Seventh**—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the construction and repair of sewers and sidewalks, the ensuing year.

**Eighth**—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the improvement of the cemeteries of the town, or act thereon.

**Ninth**—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the proper observance of Memorial Day, or act thereon.

**Tenth**—To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of six hundred dollars to provide a free bed at the Mary Hitchcock Hospital, or act thereon.

**Eleventh**—To see what sum the town will vote to raise to assist in the work of the Visiting Nurse Association, or act thereon.

**Twelfth**—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the benefit of the West Lebanon Library, or act thereon.

**Thirteenth**—To see if the Town will vote to accept the provisions of Chapter 117 Laws of 1917 on a section of the Mascoma Road, so called and appropriate or set aside from the amount raised for highway work, the sum of two hundred dollars for this purpose.

**Fourteenth**—To see what action the town will vote to take to enable it to secure the provisions of an Act Chapter 35 Laws of 1905 and Chapter 155 Laws of 1909 or Chapter 158-162 or 168 Laws of 1913 or Chapters 51 or 93 of Laws of 1915 or 162 or 224 Laws of 1917 or Chapter 118 Laws of 1919 in relation to improved highways, and of Chapter 133 Section 27 of the Laws of 1911 in relation to the maintenance of the roads, or act thereon.

**Fifteenth**—To determine the division of the school money.

**Sixteenth**—To hear the report of the Auditors.

**Seventeenth**—To see if the town will vote to raise one hundred dollars to hire Rogers and Whitney Park for a playground, or act thereon.

**Eighteenth**—To see if the town will vote to raise fifty dollars to hire a playground at West Lebanon, or act thereon.

**Nineteenth**—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the benefit of brass bands, or act thereon.

**Twentieth**—To see if the town will vote to raise thirty-five hundred dollars for the maintenance of the Police Department, or act thereon.

**Twenty-first**—To see if the town will vote to allow a discount on taxes, if paid before specified dates, or act thereon.

**Twenty-second**—To see if the town will vote to build a sidewalk on Spencer Street, or act thereon.

**Twenty-third**—To see if the town will vote to build a sidewalk on Pine Street from Spring to Valley Street, or act thereon.

**Twenty-fourth**—To see if the town will vote to build two catch basins at the East end of Valley Street, or act thereon.

**Twenty-fifth**—To see if the town will vote to discontinue the highway from the Stearns place to the top of Slack's hill, at West Lebanon.



**Twenty-sixth**—To see if the town will vote to instruct the Selectmen in relation to calling special town meetings.

**Twenty-seventh**—To see if the town will vote to rescind the vote passed December 30th, 1919 exempting from taxation the New York Knitting Mills.

**Twenty-eighth**—To see if the town will vote to exempt from taxation Wm. M. Wood on the basis of his proposed Lawrence, Mass. store for the sale of general merchandise for a period of ten years.

**Twenty-ninth**—To see if the town will vote to build a new fence or wall around the School Street Cemetery, appoint a committee and raise money for that purpose.

**Thirtieth**—To see if the town will take action in relation to the observance of Old Home Week.

**Thirty-first**—To see if the town will vote to give prescription permits from May 1st 1920 to May 1st 1921 according to Section 9 Chapter 99 of the Laws of 1919 to druggists who are registered pharmacists doing business in Lebanon to sell liquor for medicinal, sacramental, scientific or mechanical purposes, or act thereon.

**Thirty-second**—To see if the town will vote to build a sidewalk on the East side of Church Street from Valley to Spring streets, and on the South side of Valley street from Church to Pine streets and to widen Valley street from Church street eight feet, and establish a catch basin in front of George Decoto's.

The Lebanon and Whipple beds were together occupied 601 days from February 1, 1919 to February 1, 1920 by 23 people.
