WARRANT FOR ANNUAL TOWN MEETING.

The State of New Hampshire

(L. S.) To the inhabitants of the Town of Lebanon qualified to vote in town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at J. H. Bushway's Garage in said town on the second Tuesday of March next at ten of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

First—To choose a Town Clerk for the ensuing year.

Second—To choose one Selectman for the ensuing three years, Overseer of the Poor, Collector of Taxes, Highway Agent, and all other necessary town officers for the ensuing year.

Third—To choose a Trustee to administer the Trust Funds of the town for three years.

Fourth—To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year.

Fifth—To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the construction and repair of highways and bridges for the ensuing year.

Sixth—To see what sums of money the town will vote to raise for the construction and repairs of sewers and sidewalks for the ensuing year.

Seventh—To see what sums of money the town will vote to raise for the improvement of the cemeteries of the town, or act thereon.

Eighth—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the proper observance of Memorial Day, or act thereon.

Ninth—To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of Six hundred dollars to provide a free bed at the Mary Hitchcock Hospital, or act thereon.

Tenth—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise to assist in the work of the Visiting Nurse Association or act thereon.

Eleventh—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the benefit of the West Lebanon Library, or act thereon.

Twelfth—To see if the town will vote to accept the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of 1917, on a section of the Mascoma Road, so called, and appropriate, or set aside from the amount raised for highway work the sum of One Hundred Seventy Dollars for this purpose.

Thirteenth—To see what action the town will take to enable it to secure the provisions of Chapter 35, Laws of 1905, in relation to improved highways, and of Chapter 133, Laws of 1911, Section 27, in relation to the maintenance of the roads, or act thereon.

Fourteenth—To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to hire money, in anticipation of taxes.

Fifteenth—To determine the division of the school money.

Sixteenth—To hear the report of the Auditors.

Seventeenth—To see if the town vote to raise the sum of One Hundred Dollars to hire Rogers and Whitney Park for a playground, or act thereon.

Eighteenth—To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of Fifty Dollars for the benefit of a playground at West Lebanon, or act thereon.

Nineteenth—To see if the town will vote to construct a sewer on Perley Street.

Twentieth—To see if the town will vote to allow a discount on taxes, if paid before specified dates, or act thereon.

Twenty-first—To see if the town will continue the inspection of milk, raise money therefor, or act thereon.

Twenty-second—To hear the report of Committee on Town Hall.

Twenty-third—To see if the town will vote to give prescription permits from May first 1923 to May first 1924 according to Section 99, Laws of 1919, to druggists who are registered Pharmacists doing business in Lebanon. to sell liquors for medicinal, sacramental, scientific or mechanical purposes, or act thereon.

Twenty-fourth—To see what action the town will take to raise money by bonds or otherwise to pay for town hall.

Twenty-fifth—To see if town will vote to discontinue road on Spencer street.

Twenty-sixth—To bring in your ballots upon the question as to whether the amendment proposed by the Convention to revise the Constitution shall be approved.

REPORT OF SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

March 1, 1923

To the Citizens of Lebanon:

At the request of the Board of Education, I am combining the reports, which are usually presented at this time in a school report, into a brief presentation of a few statistics in regard to our schools, together with a brief statement of some of the activities which are taking place at the present time.

In administration, the combining of the two districts has made possible a closer correlation of the work of the various schools, and has greatly simplified the clerical work of administration. As a rule, I have tried to continue the progressive policies started by Supt. Sawyer.

Teachers

Teachers of Lebanon are, on the whole, well trained, experienced, efficient and progressive, and are doing a splendid work. I believe that a slight increase in the amount paid our rural school teachers will enable us to secure teachers of some Normal training and some experience for these difficult and very important schools. Without question the greatest need of good teaching today lies in these rural one-room schools. Salaries of our elementary and high school teachers are about the same as paid elsewhere in the state in communities of the size of Lebanon. We

cannot, however, afford to lose our best teachers to other communities when a matter of \$100 or so would keep them here. We do not care, no matter how great the honor may be, to have Lebanon considered a training ground for the teachers of other communities. The professional spirit of our teachers is vouched for by the fact that thirty are now enrolled in an extension course in education conducted by Prof. A. D. Wright of Dartmouth College.

Junior High School under the direction of Mr. Kendall has reached a stage of development and organization surpassed by few, if any, in the state. According to the official report of the state inspector, who visited us recently, we have not a single poor teacher in either Junior or Senior High Schools, and the impression of our schools received by him was very favorable.

In the Senior High School, few changes have been made. The Mechanics Arts Curriculum has been strengthened by replacing one of the four shop periods, previously given, by a related subject, such as mathematics, chemistry, etc.

In spite of many reports to the contrary, Lebanon High School does prepare for college. We cannot, however, guarantee admission to a particular college, unless advised by the pupil of his intention to enter college (not later than the end of his Freshman year). Our better pupils have little trouble in getting on in college. This is shown to be true by a study now being made of some twenty-eight L. H. S. graduates, who are now in normal school and college. I believe that few High Schools have better records. Our poorer students we *cannot* and do not recommend for college. Lebanon High School is given all the privileges of certification granted to any school. We are approved by the State Dept. of Education and by the New England College Entrance Board.

Medical Inspection

Medical Inspection of all pupils of the district has been continued this year. Results in this important part of activities were very satisfactory and expenses for this work are to my mind fully justified. Monthly reports of the

school nurse, Miss Parmentier, published in the Free Press, give very interesting statistics.

Building

Many repairs of a minor nature have been made on several of our schools.

It seems almost unnecessary to call your attention again to the crowded condition of our High School. More class rooms, laboratory space, cloak rooms, toilet facilities, a gymnasium, an auditorium and a library, are among the essential needs at the present time. Plans for a new building will be presented at the school meeting. I do not see how Lebanon High School can maintain its present high rating unless something be done to provide proper facilities.

I wish to express my appreciation of the untiring efforts and fine spirit of co-operation on the part of all teachers, and of the hearty support of the members of the Board of Education who have been of great assistance to me in this my first year of supervision.
