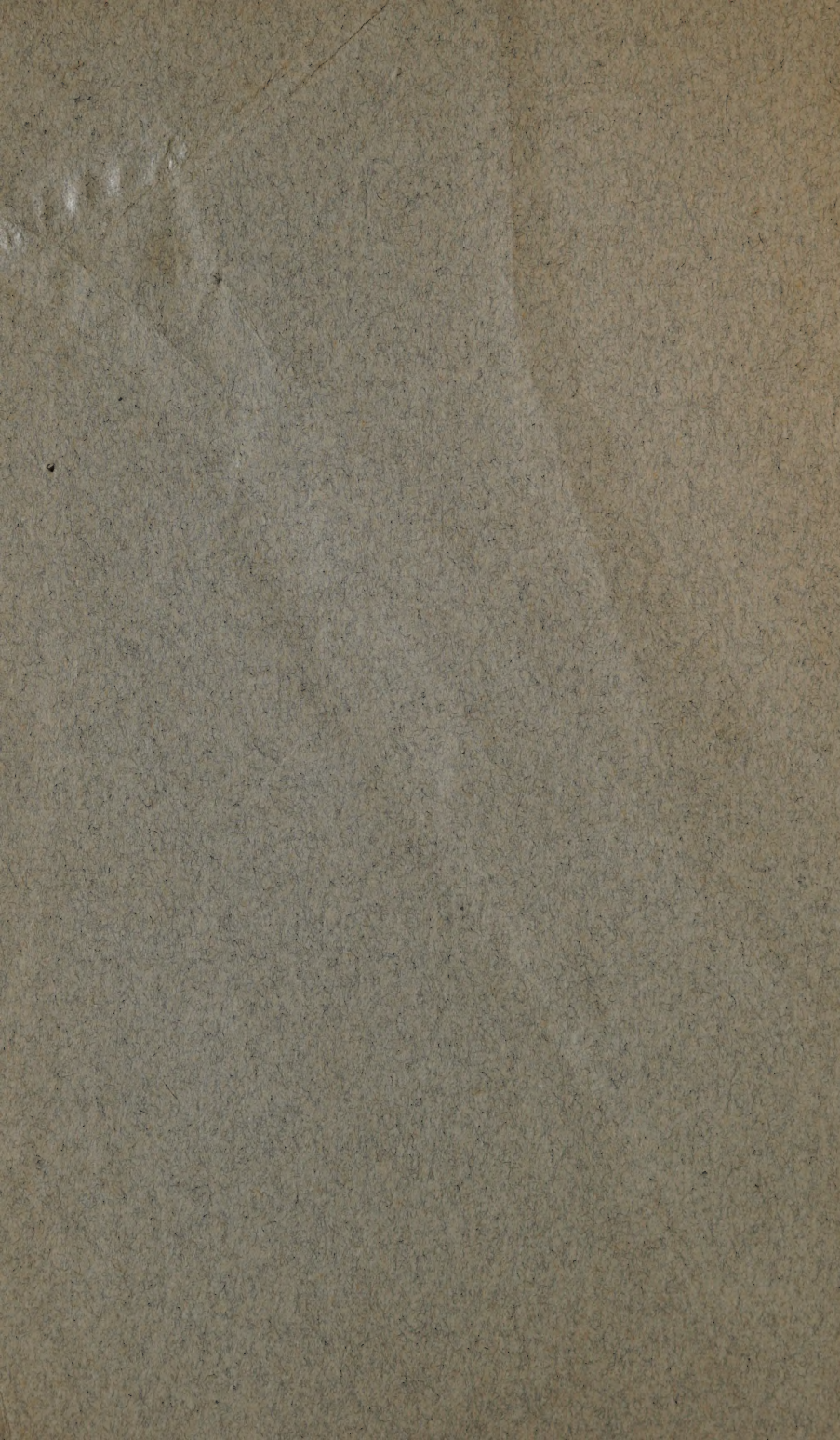

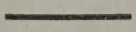

Warrant for Annual Town Meeting.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE.

L. S. } *To the Inhabitants of the Town of Lebanon qualified to vote in town affairs.*

You are notified to meet at the Town Hall in said town on the second Tuesday of March next, at ten of the clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects:

First—To choose a Town Clerk for the ensuing year.

Second—To choose three Selectmen, Overseer of the Poor, Collector of Taxes, and all other necessary town officers for the ensuing year.

Third—To choose a Trustee to administer the Trust Funds of the town for three years.

Fourth—To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year.

Fifth—To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to construct and repair highways and bridges for the ensuing year.

Sixth—To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the construction and repair of sewers and sidewalks the ensuing year.

Seventh—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the improvement of the cemeteries of the town, or act thereon.

Eighth—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the proper observance of Memorial Day, or act thereon.

Ninth—To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of six hundred dollars to provide a free bed at the Mary Hitchcock Hospital, or act thereon.

Tenth—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the benefit of the West Lebanon Library, or act thereon.

Eleventh—To see what sum the town will vote to raise to assist in the work of the Visiting Nurse Association, or act thereon.

Twelfth—To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of five hundred dollars to be expended under direction of the Lebanon Chamber of Commerce for Community gardens, or act thereon.

Thirteenth—To see what action the town will take to enable it to secure the provisions of "An act in amendment of Section 8, Chapter 35 of the Laws of 1905, and Section 20 Chapter 155 of the Laws of 1909" relating to maintenance of Highways approved April 15, 1911, or act thereon.

Fourteenth—To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of twenty five hundred dollars to enable it to secure the benefits of State Aid and for the improvement of the Main Highways throughout the State, under "Chapter 155 Laws of 1909 or Chapters 158, 162, or 168 Laws of 1913 or Chapters 51 or 93 Laws of 1915" or act thereon.

Fifteenth—To determine the division of the school money.

Sixteenth—To hear the report of the Auditors.

Seventeenth—To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of one hundred dollars to hire Rogers and Whitney Park for a Victory garden, or act thereon.

Eighteenth—To see if the town will vote to raise the sum of fifty dollars to hire a playground at West Lebanon, or act thereon.

Nineteenth—To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the benefit of brass bands, or act thereon.

Twentieth—To see if the town will vote to raise four hundred dollars to be expended under the direction of the Lebanon Chamber of Commerce to properly repair and furnish the present Police Department headquarters, or act thereon.

Twenty-first—To see if the town will vote to reimburse the committee for expenses of the celebration, upon notice of the signing of the Armistice, or act thereon.

Twenty-second—To see if the town will vote to sell a portion of the Mason Addition, Glenwood Cemetery to the Catholic Society, or act thereon.

Twenty-third—To see if the town will vote to allow a discount on taxes, if paid before specified dates, or act thereon.

Twenty-fourth—To see if the town will vote to have Liquor Agents or a Liquor Agent in Lebanon for the ensuing year beginning May 1, 1919, to sell as provided in "Chapter 147 Laws of 1917" pure spirituous liquors for medicinal, sacramental, mechanical, or scientific use, or act thereon.

Twenty-fifth—To see if the town will vote to give prescription permits from May 1st 1919, according to the provisions of Chapter 147 Laws of 1917, to Druggists who are registered pharmacists doing business in Lebanon to sell liquor for medicinal, sacramental, mechanical, or scientific use, or act thereon.
