WATERVILLE TOWN REPORT FOR 1961

Twenty persons attended the May 5th meeting, of which ten were guests..all property owners in the town.

The appended reports from the treasurer and tax collector were approved by the auditor and accepted by the voters.

The road agent presented the road program for the coming year, with tar extensions due on the North Waterville and ski hill roads.

The library committee noted a happy balance of \$1321.06, after having purchased the customary new books. After a discussion relative to improving the usefulness and status of the library, a motion was passed authorizing the chairman to add books at her discretion so long as a balance of \$500 be maintained.
