SELECTMEN'S REPORT

The Selectmen are pleased to present the following report for 1968 together with some recommendations for 1969. There have been several changes in the officers of the town this past year. Mr. W. H. Sherman resigned as the Tax Collector as of April 1, 1968 and former selectman and treasurer Mr. R. I. Longever was appointed to the office. Mr. Longever resigned December 31, 1968 and Mr. Winston A. Wright was appointed to the vacancy. Anyone having poll, head, or property tax accounts to settle should contact Mr. Wright.

Members of the Board of Selectmen have continued to meet with the Planning Board and share its concern for the future development of our town. The report of the Planning Board and Articles 4, 5 & 6 deserve serious consideration by voters.

This is the first year that the town will be operated under the provisions of the Municipal Budget Law since a one years experience in 1954-5. A budget committee does not necessarily mean lower taxes, but the annual discussion of the town's requirements and problems by more tax payers should prevent excess in appropriations and a more stable tax rate. The budget for this years town meeting was prepared by the Budget Committee.

The sum of \$2,500.00 was voted at last years town meeting to redecorate the upper floor of the Town Hall. The walls and ceiling of the main hall and both large and small stages were given two coats of paint. All windows were removed for scraping, priming and painting. In addition, the lower hall was painted in the same manner. The Fire Department will reimburse the Town for this work. The lower hallway was also redecorated and paid for out of the regular Town Hall appropriation. The Selectmen recommend that sufficient money be appropriated this year to complete painting of the lower floor and replace slate on the main roof.

Fitzwilliam is fortunate to have an alert and dedicated volunteer Fire Department. The effort of its members to keep the Town's fire equipment in first class condition and up-to-date should be appreciated by the townspeople.

The sum of money voted last year under Article 23 to set up a Capital Reserve Fund for the purchase of equipment was deleted by the State Tax Commission from the 1968 list of appropriations because the article was improperly drawn and ammended. Articles 11-12 were inserted in this years Warrant to again bring the matter to the attention of the voters.

The report of the Police Department indicates many unnecessary calls and demands are being made for animal disturbances and domestic problems. Townspeople should be aware that members of the police force are paid on an hourly and mileage basis, not on a salary. Every unnecessary call means an added expense to the tax payers.

The Junk Yard Law as it applies to our Town Dump is still in effect. The Town is licensed to continue operations at the present site until April 1st. The Selectmen will make application for a renewal of the license before that date;

however, the validity of the license will be determined by our compliance with new state regulations issued by the New Hampshire Public Works and Highways as of January 15, 1969. The local maintenance division of N. H. Public Works and Highways has the duty to see that these regulations are observed.

The air-pollution or anti-burning law to become effective in 1971 dictates that steps be taken promptly to find another disposal site. Favorable action is recommended on Article 8.

An open road that can be travelled with reasonable safety 24 hours a day is probably the most important and valuable service that a town can provide its citizens. A snow-blocked road means that public service companies cannot repair lines or restore service and that fire or police cannot respond to calls for assistance. In this connection it should be remembered that there are nearly 45 miles of Class V roads to be regularly maintained, plowed and sanded as needed in the winter time. Hence, one snow storm means over 100 miles of plowing testing the endurance of highway personnel and equipment.

Another factor seldom thought of is that in the 45 miles of road there are over 30 deadends or turn-arounds. These latter situations slow down plowing operations and sometimes create the most aggravating problems.

As stated in the Highway Agent's Report, only a small amount of T.R.A. work was done this past year. The East Lake Road is being surveyed for a T.R.A. project this spring and early summer. How much is done will depend on labor and equipment available. Passage of Article 3 will ensure that two years work can be done if help is available.

The money appropriated for culvert pipe at Kemp Brook Bridge site has been carried over by the auditors report and is available for 1969. Title to the land necessary for a change in layout of the road was not received until too late to start the work last year. The culvert pipe has been ordered and is at a plant in Westminster, Vermont ready for delivery.

As recommended in last years report an article has been inserted in this years Warrant to discontinue, subject to gates and bars, the primitive section of roads as indicated in the N. H. Dept. of Public Works and Highways inventory of Town roads. Some of these may have been discontinued in previous years but in order to have the record all in one place, a resolution will be offered by the Selectmen under Article 9 to discontinue those sections of road listed as primitive with others of less significant facts.

The Selectmen recommend passage of Articles *13 establishing a Capital Reserve Fund for the purchase of highway equipment.

In response to several requests Article 10 has been inserted in the Warrant to discontinue the discount on property tax payments. Unless this article receives a favorable vote at this town meeting the sum of \$4,500.00 will have to be added to this years list of appropriations.

Fitzwilliam's financial situation in the Monadnock Regional School District remains the same. School costs continue to rise drastically without any relief for the taxpayer in sight.

The 1968 Town Meeting authorized the Board of Selectmen to serve as a legislative committee in school affairs . To implement the resolution adopted at last years annual meeting the Board of Selectmen appeared before the Interim Education Study Committee and presented a brief citing Fitzwilliam's experience in Monadnock Regional Cooperative and recommending the following legislative changes :

- 1 . To change the distribution of state aid . (Foundation aid Law)
- 2 . To permit a town to withdraw from a cooperative under the appropriate safeguards .
- 3 . To provide for assurance that all towns within a cooperative are assessed and taxed at the same rate .

The Board was favorably received by the Committee which appeared sympathetic to Fitzwilliam's plight . Subsequently the above recommendations were presented to Representative Allen , Senator English , Councilor Streeter and Governor Peterson .

The Governor has recommended changes in the school aid law . The legislature is currently studying these changes .

Two more towns in the district will be reassessed in the near future making five of the towns in the district nearly to the 100% level .

A study is being made by a "Future Needs Committee" of present and impending crowding conditions in some of the district's elementary schools . Before architects are hired or a greater indebtedness incurred a new hard look should be taken to see if a regrouping of the towns and school districts in the southwestern part of the state would not be of benefit to the taxpayers as well as the students .

The Board of Selectmen wish to thank the other officers of the town for their cooperation and the interest of other individuals and groups in town affairs is appreciated .

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

TOWN WARRANT

To the inhabitants of the Town of Fitzwilliam, New Hampshire, in the County of Cheshire, in said state, qualified to vote in Town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Fitzwilliam on Tuesday, the 11th day of March, 1969, at seven o'clock in the afternoon to act on the following subjects:

ARTICLE 1: To bring in your votes for the election of one selectman for three years, town treasurer, town clerk, one cemetery commissioner for three years, one trustee of trust funds for three years, one trustee of the library for three years, three fire wards, three commissioners at Plante Memorial Park, town hall agent, and constable and prosecuting agent, one member budgetcommittee six years.

Polls will be open not later than 2 o'clock P.M. and close not earlier than 7 o'clock P.M. or such later hour as shall be authorized by vote of the Town.

ARTICLE 2: To hear and act upon the reports of agents, committees and officers heretofore chosen.

ARTICLE 3: To see if the Town Meeting will adopt the budget as recommended by the budget committee or make any alterations thereto.

ARTICLE 4: To see if the Town will vote to establish the Historic Commission of Fitzwilliam consisting of five (5) members to be appointed by the Board of Selectmen in accordance with the enabling legislation of the State of New Hampshire, Revised Statutes Annotated 31:89, a-j inclusive.

ARTICLE 5: To see if the Town will vote the following ordinance:

"No trailer park or mobile home park shall be established in the Town and no existing trailer park or mobile home park shall be enlarged except upon prior approval of such establishment or enlargement at a duly constituted Town Meeting: the terms "trailer park" and mobile home park" shall mean an area or tract of land upon which are located for residential purposes two or more mobile homes and/or trailers."

ARTICLE 6: To see if the Town will authorize and empower the Planning Board to approve or disapprove in its discretion new subdivisions and plats thereof showing streets, or widening thereof, or parks, and upon the adoption of this Article, make it the duty of the Town Clerk to file with the Registry of Deeds of the County of Cheshire, a certificate or notice showing that said Planning Board has been so authorized, giving the date of authorization, as provided in the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated 36:19, and to issue any and all other certificates or documents required by the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated 36:20-29, inclusive.

ARTICLE 7: To see if the Town will authorize the Selectmen to sell all tax deeded property at public sale.

ARTICLE 8: To see if the Town will vote to sell all or part of the two tracts of land purchased from William Luopa and described more specifically in deeds from William Luopa to the Town of Fitzwilliam dated June 3, 1929 recorded in Vol.439, page 480 and December 4, 1951 recorded in Vol. 570 page 498 in the Cheshire Registry. And to authorize the Selectmen to purchase, or otherwise acquire, for and in behalf of the Town, other land suitable for a disposal site at a cost not to exceed the total sum realized from the sale of the Luopa tracts.

ARTICLE 9: To see if the Town will vote to discontinue, subject to gates and bars, all sections of primitive roads indicated on New Hampshire Department of Public Works and Highways road inventory of Town of Fitzwilliam, dated January 1, 1967 totaling in all 8.37 miles, or take any action thereon.

ARTICLE 10: To see if the Town will vote to rescind action taken under Article 29, Town Meeting of 1950, relating to the granting of discount on taxes or take any action thereon.

ARTICLE 11: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of \$2,000.00 to create a capital reserve fund for the purpose of purchasing Fire Department equipment.

ARTICLE 12: To see if the Town will vote to allow \$2,000.00 of the surplus to be put into the Capital Reserve Fund to replenish the amount lost from last year's appropriation at Town Meeting.

ARTICLE 13: To see if the Town will vote to establish a Capital Reserve Fund for the purpose of purchasing equipment for the Highway Department and to appropriate the sum of \$5,000.00 for this purpose.

ANNUAL TOWN MEETING-FITZWILLIAM, N.H. MARCH 12th & 23rd 1968

March 12, 1968

The meeting was called to order by Moderator Horace Firmin at one P.M., and voting started on Articles #1 and #2. Motion made and seconded that due to the fact that the Town Report had only just arrived and that the voters had not had a chance to study same - it was voted to postpone the formal meeting until March 23, 1968 at ten (10) A.M.

MARCH 23, 1968

The meeting was called to order by Horace Firmin, Moderator at 10 A.M. with a pledge to the Flag and the reading of the Warrant. Rev. Paul Simpson lead the prayer. The following was transacted as called by the Warrant:

ARTICLE 3: To hear and act upon the reports of Committees and Officers. Motion was made and seconded and passed to accept reports as read

ARTICLE 4: Motion made, seconded and passed to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.

ARTICLE 5: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$33,900.00 for Town charges. Motion made to take each item separately but same was defeated 26 to 56. Mr. Russell Raitto asked why the increases in both Fire and Police budgets. Chief Wright explained the increase in payroll and the need of purchasing hose. Chief Schimke said increase due to dogs - increased summer protection, etc. Motion made and seconded and passed and the following amounts were voted:

ARTICLE #6: \$2,500.00 Street lighting under a plan submitted by Public Service Company as voted for in Article #5 of the 1967 Town Meeting. Motion made, seconded and passed.

ARTICLE #7: \$8,500.00 for Oiling Town Roads - Motion made, seconded and passed

ARTICLE #8: \$16,000.00 for maintenance of Town Roads - Motion made, seconded and passed.

ARTICLE #9: \$1,036.16 TWA - State to give \$6,907.74 - Motion made, seconded and passed.

ARTICLE #10: \$1,500.00 Cemeteries - Motion made, seconded and passed.

ARTICLE #11: \$1,800.00 Town Library - Motion made, seconded and passed.

ARTICLE #12: \$300.00 Care of Common - Motion made, seconded and passed.

ARTICLE #13: \$300.00 care of Plante Park - Motion made, seconded and passed

ARTICLE #14: \$306.00 Monadnock Region - Motion made, seconded and passed

ADDITION TO ARTICLE #6: Voted to have Selectmen appoint a commission of 3 to work with them on this Article.

ADDITION TO ARTICLE #9: Voted to go on record the meeting's wish for considering work on the East Laurel Lake Road

ADDITION TO ARTICLE #10: Moved, seconded and passed to print the Trust Funds every three years instead of the present one year.

ARTICLE #15: \$375.00 Care of Tress-Common, Plante Park, Cemeteries and streets. Victor Dunham spoke about planting trees but no action was taken. Before voting this article was amended by Mr. Fitzgerald, to carry over the unspent monies each year to the next year. The article was past with the above amendment

ARTICLE #16: \$125.00 White Pine Blister Program - Article Passed

ARTICLE #17: \$300.00 Memorial Day Program - Article Passed

ARTICLE #18: \$100.00 Civil Defense - Motion made, seconded and passed

ARTICLE #19: \$637.00 Elliot Community Hospital - Article passed

ARTICLE #20: \$2,000.00 District Nursing Association - Article passed.

ARTICLE #21: \$600.00 Radio for Police Department. Was moved and seconded to indefinitely postpone this article but this was voted down 25 to 85, and the article was passed as written.

ARTICLE #22: \$300.00 State Tax Commission to assist in 1968 valuations of new property. Article passed.

ARTICLE #23: \$2,000.00 Contingency Fund. An amendment was offered but then withdrawn to use this fund for Fire-fighting equipment only. The article was then amended to read "to see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000.00 for a Capital Reserve Fund for the Replacement of fire equipment". The amended article was passed.

ARTICLE #24: \$6,000.00 Kemp Brook Bridge. Motion made, seconded to postpone this article but same was voted down and the article as written was passed.

ARTICLE #25: \$2,500.00 Painting interior of the Upper Town Hall. Article passed as written.

ARTICLE #26: Walter Stone Land - Article passed as written.

ARTICLE #27: Dumps and Junkyards. A motion was made and seconded to postpone this article but it was voted down 21 to 79. The Selectmen were called to account for not doing anything for the last three years and Mr. Fitzgerald answered that the Board was doing all that it could and mentioned the new blinker installed on Route #12. Mr. Daley Whipple proposed an amendment just adding the word "Private" before the word "Dump". Considerable talk about the dump hours to be open - costs, etc., but nothing was actually voted on.

ARTICLE #28 - Regulation on a water supply, shallow well, etc. - Regulation passed as written.

ARTICLE #29: To rescind article 29 of Town Meeting in 1950 regarding 2% discount for paying taxes within ten days of date of mailing taxes. The Meeting voted to postpone this article indefinitely.

ARTICLE #30: To make the office of Highway Agent an appointed office rather than an elected one. Motion made, seconded and passed to do so.

ARTICLE #31: Municipal Budget Law. Motion made, seconded and passed the acceptance of the law and the following were appointed:

ARTICLE #32: To have the Board of Selectmen serve as a legislative committee representing the Town in School and Town affairs - Motion made, seconded and passed.

ARTICLE #33: Sale of 1936 Stewart Fire Truck - Article passed authorizing the Fire Wards to make the sale.

ARTICLE #34: Selling tax deeded property. Amended to read "Public Sale" and the article was passed.

ARTICLE #35: Resolutions: - Made by Joseph Tardiff to combine Common, Plante Memorial Park with the Cemetery Department. The meeting voted to authorize selectmen to make this combination.

Resolution made by Miss Marcia Webber to direct the Board of Selectmen NOT to pay the School District more than \$202,406.10 and to instruct the Tax Collector to base the tax bills on this amount rather than the \$244,000 amount. This resolution was passed by the voters.

Resolution made by Howard Holman that the Town of Fitzwilliam petition the Interim Education Commission as per attached. Motion made, seconded and passed as noted.

The meeting adjourned at 2:36 P.M. 344 votes cast out of a checklist of 688 names.

All officers, elected or appointed were duly sworn in as by law prescribed.

TOWN MEETING - MARCH 23, 1968

ARTICLE 36 - RESOLUTION

"Be it resolved that the TOWN OF FITZWILLIAM petition the INTERIM EDUCATION COMMISSION, which was established under Chapter 287, Laws of New Hampshire Legislature of 1967, to EXAMINE° EVALUATE AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS relating to the formation and operation of the MONADNOCK REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT.

Specifically the Commission is requested to direct its attention to Section 287 .2, Item (4) the methods by which School Districts are combined into Cooperative School Districts or area Schools; and (6) changes which work towards better and more satisfactory functioning of our Public School System.

Be it further resolved that a copy of the Resolution and a summary of the forming of the MONADNOCK REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT BE SENT TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE INTERIM EDUCATION COMMISSION. Also that a like copy be sent to the Chairman of the Public School Association, the Chairman of the School Boards Association and to other Boards or Associations and Officials to whom such a resolution may be property directed".

The above resolution made by Mr. Howard Holman. A motion made to pass the above resolution, was seconded and voted for by the voters.

Gentlemen:

Submitted herewith is the report of the annual examination and audit of the accounts of the Town of Fitzwilliam for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1968, which was made by this Division in accordance with the vote of the Town. Exhibits as hereafter listed are included as part of the report.

One of the enclosed audits must be given the Town Clerk as part of the permanent records.

SCOPE OF THE AUDIT

Included in the examination and audit were the accounts and records of the Board of Selectmen, Treasurer, Tax Collector, Town Clerk, library, Village Precinct and Trustees of Trust Funds.

FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Comparative Balance Sheets - December 31, 1967 - December 31, 1968 (Exhibit A-1)

Comparative Balance Sheets as of December 31, 1967 and December 31, 1968 are presented in Exhibit A-1. As indicated therein, the Surplus decreased by \$228.42 from \$10,085.00 to \$9,856.58 in 1968. Inasmuch as there were no outstanding long term notes or bonds on December 31, 1968, the Balance Sheet Surplus of \$9,856.58 also represented the Current Surplus (excess of total assets over current liabilities) on that date.

Analysis of Change in Financial Condition: (Exhibit A-2)

An analysis of the change in financial condition of the Town during the year is made in Exhibit A-2, with the factors which caused the change indicated therein.

Comparative Statements of Appropriations and Expenditures - Estimated and Actual Revenues: (Exhibit A-3 & A-4)

Comparative statements of appropriations and expenditures, estimated and actual revenues for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1968, are presented in Exhibits A-3 and A-4. As indicated by the budget summary (Exhibit A-4.), a revenue deficit of \$1,556.68, less a net unexpended balance of appropriations of \$1,276.33, resulted in a net budget deficit of \$280.35.

Summary Statement of Receipts and Expenditures: (Exhibit B-1)

A summary statement of receipts and expenditures for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1968, made up in accordance with the uniform classification of accounts, is included in Exhibit B-1. Proof of the Treasurer's balance as of December 31, 1968 as indicated in Exhibit B-2.

AUDIT PROCEDURE

The accounts and records of all town officials charged with the custody, receipt and disbursement of public funds were examined and audited. Vouchers and cancelled checks were compared with supporting invoices and payrolls as well as with entries in the books of record. Receipts were checked by source insofar as possible and totals of receipts and expenditures verified. Book balances were verified by comparison with reconciled bank balances made from statements submitted by depository banks. Verification of uncollected taxes was made by mailing notices to delinquent taxpayers as indicated by the Collector's records. The amounts of uncollected and unredeemed taxes as indicated in this report are therefore subject to any changes which may be necessitated by the return of verification notices.

GENERAL COMMENTSUncollected Taxes:

As of December 31, 1968, delinquent property, poll and head taxes amounting to \$530.25 on account of the tax levies of 1966 and prior years remained outstanding on the Tax Collector's Warrants.

The list of these uncollected taxes should be reviewed and, where required, statements should be issued by the Selectmen. The Tax Collector should take the necessary steps required to enforce collection of the remainder of these delinquent taxes.

Unredeemed Taxes:

There were, as of December 31, 1968, unredeemed taxes from the tax sales of the levies of 1965 and prior years as follows:

Inasmuch as the two year period provided by law in which redemption from tax sales maybe made has expired on these unredeemed taxes, the Tax Collector should deed all of the properties involved to the Town.

Library:

We again recommend the use of columnar journals with appropriate headings for classification of receipts and expenditures be adopted by the Library Treasurer.

Conclusion:

The provisions of Chapter 184, of the Laws of 1955, require that this report or the summary of findings and recommendations (letter of transmittal) shall be published in the next annual report of the Town.

We extend our thanks to the officials of the Town of Fitzwilliam for their assistance during the course of the audit.

FIRE WARDS' REPORT FOR 1968

The year 1968 brought to your Fire Department a new idea in the use of hose. At the last Town Meeting we asked for money to buy hose to replace the old hose on Engine 3 at the Depot. After checking with the Jaffrey Fire Department and their use of 4-inch large diameter hose, we decided to purchase 600 feet of this hose. This hose is not new in the World, but it is new to the fire service in the United States. We feel this hose can deliver more water from greater distances than regular hose. Our only problem is this - we have in this year's budget an additional request for \$1,000 to buy 600 feet this year. This would give us 1200 feet of large diameter hose and when added to the 4,000 feet of Meadowood's 3-1/2 inch hose, would enable us to move water well over one mile to the fire area. This is an important factor, as we have many homes in Fitzwilliam this far away from ample water supplies. We hope you will approve of this budget item at Town Meeting.

In our Budget, we have also asked for \$900 to purchase a new 1500-gallon water tank to replace the one we have on our depot truck which is leaking and has been repaired three or four times in the past two years. We hope you will approve this item to allow us to keep our equipment in A-1 condition.

We wish to thank the following people for the free radio coverage given the Town, from their homes: Dorothy and Edward Grant, Marolyn and Robert Dunton, and Jane and Winston Wright. These people perform this coverage every year and without them our job would be much harder to accomplish.

To the men of the Meadowood County area Fire Department, we express as usual, our sincere thanks for their continued free support to our community of their equipment.

In 1968 the men of the Fitzwilliam Fire Department received a home monitor, which is tone controlled from Keene. These monitors allow the men living away from the alarm to hear the location and to respond in a faster time. This has been made possible by a donation of \$2900 to the Department from the Firemen of Fitzwilliam - in addition to this, the Fitzwilliam Firemen contributed over \$2300 to other organizations of need. This amount of money is almost as much as the Town spends to operate the Department. To these men we as Fire Wards express our appreciation for their support.

In 1968 Fitzwilliam had no major fire loss of homes for the first time in ten years. The people of Fitzwilliam have shown fire prevention at its peak.

For the Year Ended December 31, 1968

This Department operated this year with five regular officers. We have provided year-round police coverage for our Township and assisted other Police Departments when required.

in the Spring we conducted a census of all dogs here, along with a census of junk cars. Report was made to Selectmen.

The dog-restraining law in effect here for different periods each year, requires more cooperation from dog owners to restrain dogs as required. Enforcing this law causes a large burden to taxpayers and money appropriated for the Police Department.

Our new police radio was installed and in operation this past year and we are now able to communicate between patrols.

The Police Department sponsored the annual Halloween Dance for age groups 10 years and older. A live band was provided for dancing and refreshments served. During the Halloween season, we provided police duty at Emerson School. The 5 nights we were on duty in the school prevented vandalism at this area

We have had an excellent cooperation from the Sheriff's Department, State Police and police from surrounding towns this past year.

REPORT OF PLANNING BOARD

The Planning Board at its first meeting following Town Meeting attempted to evaluate the needs and problems of the Town. As a result of this meeting, it was voted to establish committees for the following:

1. To bring up to date the base map of the Town.
2. To check into the possibility of obtaining a public beach on Laurel Lake and public playgrounds for the children.
3. To suggest regulations for the preservation of the historic value of the Village District.
4. To draw up sub-division regulations for the protection of the Town.
5. To look into the possibilities of obtaining new industry for the Town.

The following committees were appointed:

1. Base Map - Joseph Tardiff, Chairman, Dudley Houseman, Silas White, Edwin Mattson, Arthur Raitto, Walter Stone
2. Recreation- William Skarin, Chairman, James Ayers, Walter Hill, Paul Hofmeister, Russell Raitto
3. Village District - Julian Brown, Chairman, Mrs. William Prigge, Mrs. Christopher Barnes, John Carpenter, Daniel Leary
4. Sub-Divisions - Frank Fiske, Chairman, Dr. James Inkster, Lashley Harvey, William Prigge, Warren Spicer
5. New Business- Kenneth Cavadini, Chairman, John Anketell, John Ilg, James Shanks, David Tommila

In an effort to obtain more information on town planning three board members (Cavadini, Skarin and Whipple) attended a ten-week seminar at St. Alsels College sponsored by the College and the N.H. Office of Planning. Some of the information gained there was:

1. Towns with lack of planning draw growth.
2. Growth causes problems.
3. N.H. is no longer a rural state - no town at least 50% agricultural.
4. State Planning Office is contacted by developers for list of towns without planning, this for the purpose of uncontrolled development.
5. The Population of N.H. will triple in the next few years--most of increase will be on southern border caused by influx from Mass.
6. Planning should be for at least 20 years in the future.

Due to the development of mobile home parks the Planning Board was approached by the selectmen to propose some type of zoning so the townspeople could voice their opinion. After two public hearings, the Planning Board presented to the Town at a Special Town Meeting, a proposed zoning ordinance which was defeated.

As a result the Planning Board has drawn up two articles for Town Meeting, one to set up an historic commission and one for authorizing the Planning Board to approve new sub-divisions. The board still feels there should be a public beach for the Townspeople and more recreational areas for the children.

Present members of the Board are Frank Fiske, Secretary, Julian Brown, Kenneth Cavadini, William Skarin, Joseph Tardiff and Howard Holman of the Board of Selectmen.

The board wishes to express its thanks to the sub-committees and the selectmen for their cooperation.

The Fitzwilliam Library Sewing Circle Woman's Club donated \$35 for children's books. These are on order and will be put into circulation soon. Book selection meetings were attended by both the Librarian and Assistant. Miss Mable Sturtevant has been an able assistant and I have been glad to have her help.

The grounds and shrubs have been kept in good order.

The librarians and trustees wish to express their gratitude to everyone who has donated books and services during the past year.
