TO THE TAXPAYERS:

Herewith find the financial statement of your town for the year ending January 31, 1928.

ROADS

During the past ten years it has been apparent to your town officers that we were approaching the time when our tax inventory would suffer a tremendous shrinkage, either by the cutting of timber or the sale of forest lands to the Federal Government. It has been our endeavor during this period to permanently improve our bridges and road.

Last Fall we started at Snow Brook the last cement bridge needed in Waterville. The road between Elliott Dam and Dry Brook was widened and graded and the new approaches to Snow Brook Bridge partially built.

FLOOD

In less than twelve hours the November flood completely destroyed one section of road half a mile long and removed from the greater part of the balance all indications of an improved road. The fact that all bridges remained intact proved the wisdom of the policy of State Aid Bridges adopted some years ago. Fortunately the actions of the State in providing relief for towns in the flood area will provide funds for the rebuilding of the road with the exception of one fifth of one percent of the valuation, which must be raised by the town. It is expected that our road will be restored to normal by June first.

FEDERAL OWNERSHIP OF TOWN LANDS

It is confidently expected that the 17,730 acres of taxable land will become the property of the Federal Government during the year.
