7. To see if the Town will vote to buy the Concord truck of E. W. Philbrook and make appropriation for same.

8. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue any unnecessary Highways.

9. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.

As a supplement to the foregoing Auditor's Report we wish to submit the following to show more clearly the purposes for which the debt was created.

First the sum of \$3,600.00 which is a part of net debt as shown, is money advanced by Town to New Trunk Line Construction.

**SELECTMEN'S REPORT**

Too conservative Budget estimating on the side of expenditures can have but one result, namely, a deficit at the end of the fiscal year.

With the welfare of the taxpayers always in mind we have endeavored to hold tax rates down as low as reasonably possible.

This, with the addition of unseen contingencies such as Highway damage, more help to the poor than usual, tax abatements, involuntary litigation and advance contributions to the new Trunk Line construction, has brought about an undesirable situation, though not by any means a dangerous one.

A town with no bonded debt, no long term notes and with almost unbounded natural resources should not be unduly alarmed if from time to time a small balance shows up on the wrong side of the ledger.

In keeping with the advice and instructions of the State Tax Commission valuations have been cut from \$4,000,000.00 a few years ago to about \$3,000,000.00 at the present time. This naturally raises our tax rate in a like proportion.

Even so we still have a lower rate than the average for the State, and considerably less than our surrounding towns.

This year's Budget, allowing \$2,275.96 to apply on principal of debt and with a School Budget that asks for \$2,000.00 more than usual, is still \$2,000.00 under last year's.

With town buildings in excellent repair, cemeteries in good condition, a public water system that is paying a fair dividend, besides supplying water for Town Hall; with a three years' stock of fire wood on hand, the cutting of which has furnished work for many of our unemployed, with our Town and State Aided Highways showing a marked improvement, with Elementary and High Schools second to none in the state, with the new Daniel Webster Highway extension nearing completion, let us all look back with a feeling of just and pardonable pride on last year's achievements.

During the last two or three years the high school has maintained a high record of attendance leading the state in per cent of attendance, in lowest per cent of tardiness and in tests in English, intelligence and geography.

In addition to these high attainments it was thought best last May to enter three teams in a state-wide test program conducted at Plymouth and Keene Normal schools. All the big high schools of the state entered the contest. The Pittsburg team in geography took third place for the entire state, outranking all rivals in the whole northern half of the state.

They also stood well up in French and chemistry, the other two contests entered.

The high school has also kept up its good training in tennis and other healthful out-of-door games, also in basket ball, all of which conduces to good spirit when well managed, as it has been, and is a distinct and beneficial stimulus to good interest in school work.

Due to the policy of the School Board in making it possible to have material for liberal and rather extensive reading in the form of magazines, dealing with current events, science, English, business training, French and literature, the opportunity is furnished for gaining extensive acquaintance in fields not covered by ordinary test books. This in no small degree aids to high attainments in the tests already mentioned.

### **Grades in Town School**

Good results in high school are further evidence of good training in the lower grades. There is no place for neglect anywhere in a good school system. The primary, intermediate and grammar grades are just as important if not more so. The pupil who gets the best start in the primary school never ceases to show that early training even in college and beyond.

Our graded schools are constantly showing a better product for admission to the junior and senior high schools through the continued use of skilful method and greater experience in their practice.

Many commendable public programs have been presented by all grades as well as by the high school.

The term grades as used here applies equally to all schools in town below the high school.

#### **Tendencies in Education.**

The aim of modern education is to help children to organize, extend and improve their individual and cooperative tendencies. Real everyday living in school should, so far as possible, serve as the curriculum.

Choice by the pupils, interest in carrying out their own plans, learning by actual doing, computing of figures that have meaning in practical life, solving of problems along the same line, are important objectives.

Sewing, cooking, mechanical training are illustrations of such activities.

Study and meditation and reading for acquisition of knowledge for its own sake is often pleasant but it must be mingled with practical work at home and in school to realize the greatest benefits.

Working in groups, teams, clubs and classes leads to better understanding and practice of cooperation. Experiences of this sort often lead to a choice of vocations for life.

It is in many cases wise and helpful for young people to look forward to some calling for which they themselves, their parents and teachers deem them best fitted to pursue. The different departments of school work such as general academic study, commercial training and practices; mechanic arts, economics and team work in any game or project are designed to acquaint young people with their own interests and abilities. Pittsburg schools would do well to extend its opportunities for more extensive practice in mechanic arts and in some equipment for visual education. Neighboring schools enjoy such equipment and we are feeling the need of it in the Pittsburg schools.

Our financial policy has been one of strict economy, limiting our expenses to the most apparent needs for text books and scholars supplies.

Due to more pupils in junior and senior high schools the expense of transportation has increased but such money as is paid for transportation goes to the citizens of Pittsburg and to them only. In other lines of school management too much economy is not



always a wise policy for the town's people nor for the pupils in it.

An appreciable number of recent graduates of the high school are attending higher institutions with creditable records. We also have several teachers in the schools who are Pittsburg graduates. We are fortunate in having the services of other teachers who were educated at the expense of other communities.

It is clear then that educational outlay in one community is not only for the social welfare of its own people but also for the welfare of other communities to which individuals may move for employment in their various lines of occupation. This redounds to the benefit and uplift of the whole state and nation.

To all those, who by word or deed or contribution aid a child to a realization of his needs and of his strivings for betterment we extend our most hearty appreciation and thanks.
