
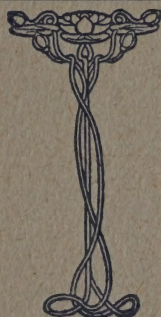

Report of expenses of repairing the highways in Colebrook, caused by the breaking of the Hale dam.

After the washout of the highways caused by the Hale dam the road was carefully examined by the Selectmen and it was decided when making repairs to make some permanent and substantial improvements by means of which a great saving could be made in future repairs. A new bridge was put in near Mrs. George Woodrow's with good stone abutments. The road was straightened, raised and otherwise improved. A new bridge was built across the Mohawk at C. E. Fletcher's. One new stone abutment was put in and a new bridge at Charles Woodrow's. At the Patterson meadow there were three bridges, two of which would have had to have been rebuilt last year. The road was carried to the north into the bank and all three bridges dispensed with. Two new bridges were built across the Paterson road and two more with stone abutments on the Dixville road.

The location of these last two bridges was changed so as to be more easily kept in repair.

The expense of the entire repairs was	\$ 3542 86
of which Henry S. Hale paid	2440 00

Leaving the expense to the town	\$ 1102 86
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For this sum of \$ 1102.86 the town has seven entirely new bridges instead of seven old ones, several new stone abutments instead of the old log ones, three bridges entirely dispensed with and many other permanent and needed improvements that will last for years.

The detail of this expenditure is in the hands of Darwin Lombard who kept the books for Mr. Hurlbert while doing the work and he will exhibit them at any time to any person interested.

Health Board Report.

We the undersigned, Health Board of the town of Colebrook, respectfully submit herewith, our 5th. annual report.

The town and village districts have been for the past year remarkably free from contagious diseases, no cases of Scarlet Fever, Diphtheria, or Measles having been reported, and but one of Typhoid Fever, which was of very mild form, has occurred within the town limits during that time. The Health Board have made systematic inspection of all tenement houses within the village limits twice during the year and made such recommendations as they deemed necessary for the protection of the public health, and with but one exception such recommendations have been readily complied with.

The Board have submitted to the State Chemist, samples of the public water for examination twice during the year, and in each case it has been reported free from contamination. We would again call attention to the necessity for the construction of a sewer from a point near the Congregational Church, extending north to Beaver Brook, below the buildings known as the Dunn blacksmith shop, to receive the sewerage of the buildings in that vicinity. The Board desires to express its thanks to those who have in any way assisted it in its work, and have by their ready compliance with our instructions shown a commendable interest in the health and welfare of our town.
