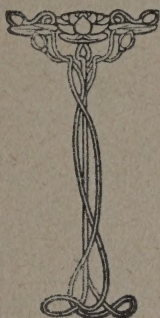

Health Board Report.

We, the undersigned, Health Board of the Town of Colebrook, herewith respectfully submit our 6th. annual report.

The town and village districts have been remarkably free from contagious diseases during the past year; no cases of Measles, Small Pox, Diphtheria, or Scarlet Fever having been reported, and but five cases of Typhoid Fever have occurred in the town; two occurring in the town, and three in the village district. In none of these cases were we able to trace the source.

The water derived from the village water supply has been examined twice during the past year, and at each examination we have taken the water from various sources, and it has been reported to be free from contamination of any sort.

The Health Board, as is their usual custom made systematic inspection of the village district, especially in reference to tenement houses, in the early spring, making such suggestions as in their judgement was required, and in most instances the same were complied with.

In July last, a complaint was entered to the Health Board regarding the unsanitary condition of the brook, known as the Parsons brook, leading from the buildings occupied and used by the Mohawk Dairy Co. On investigation of the same, we found it to be in an unsanitary condition and caused the same to be removed.

In the opinion of the Health Board the sewerage system of the Village district is in an unsanitary condition and that all sewers should empty into a main sewer which should terminate in the Connecticut river. Owing to the low water in the Mohawk river during the last summer, the Health Board were unable to keep the mouths of the sewers emptying into it in a sanitary condition, and the town was subjected to some expense in our efforts to do the same.

The Health Board have fumigated the school buildings located in the village district three times during the past year, have caused all public drinking cups and towels to be removed permanently, requiring students to use individual drinking cups and towels if desired, and have endeavored to keep said buildings in a sanitary condition.

In our work during the past year we have received the support of all well meaning citizens, who have health and welfare of our town and village at heart, and to them, we extend our thanks,
