Town Warrant

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Tuftonboro in the County of Carroll in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at Town House in said Tuftonboro on Tuesday, the tenth day of March, next at nine of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriations of the same. Seventy-two thousand, nine hundred thirty dollars and twenty-three cents (\$72,930.23) as approved by the Budget Committee.
3. To see if the Town will vote to arise and appropriate the sum of eight hundred forty-nine dollars (\$849.) for Town Road Aid as approved by the Budget Committee, the State to contribute the sum of five thousand, six hundred sixty dollars (\$5,660.).
4. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of the collection of taxes for the current year, and issue notes therefor, said notes to be repaid during the current municipal year.
5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the necessary funds in an amount not less than \$849.00 in order to be eligible to receive State Town Road Aid funds, the combined total of these funds plus the Town Road Aid funds to be spent for the improvement and rebuilding of the Tuftonboro Neck Road. By Request.
6. To see if the Town will vote to establish a Planning Board of five (or seven) members with duties as set forth in Section 1-15, Chapter 36, N.H. Revised Statutes Annotated, to make a study of

the Town's development and report to the Town appropriate recommendations for the promotion and maintenance of the Town's best development. The Board shall consist of one Selectman and four (or six) other citizens appointed by the Selectmen as provided in Chapter 36, N.H. Revised Statutes Annotated. By Request.

7. To see if the Town of Tuftonboro will direct its Selectmen to appoint a Zoning Commission of five or more members for the purpose enumerated in the N.H. Revised Statutes Annotated 1955, Chapter 31:60-89, and direct that such Zoning Commission present its proposed zoning regulations at regular Town meetings or special meetings of the Town in order that such proposals may be individually voted upon by the Town. By Request.

8. To transact any other business which may legally come before the meeting.

Forest Fire Warden and District Chief

The 1969 fire season was a quiet one in this area. Frequent rains kept the danger to a minimum and there were few violations. Your Forest Fire Warden's job would be easier if everyone understood the State laws that govern the kindling of outdoor fires. A synopsis of these laws follow:

Fire Permit

A **fire permit** is needed for all outdoor fires in or near woodland anytime the ground is not covered with snow. This includes household waste burning, even if in an incinerator, grass burning, garden trash as well as brush burning. Such burning is restricted by regulation to be **prior to 9:00 a.m. and after 5:00 p.m.**

Exceptions

Commercial or industrial burning is allowed anytime under

normal conditions with permission of the District Chief and a permit from the Fire Warden.

Camp or cooking fires are allowed on your own property with permission of the Fire Warden. On another's property with written permission of the landowner and permission of the Fire Warden. The Warden can forbid such fires if in a hazardous area. Permits for cooking fires in the White Mountain National Forest can be obtained from the Laconia Office or at the Ranger Stations. Permits are not required in public camp or picnic grounds where fireplaces have been built for this purpose.

Penalties

1. For kindling a fire without a permit. Maximum of \$200.00 fine; or imprisonment for not more than 60 days.
2. For kindling a fire by any means willfully or recklessly that shall endanger woodlands the maximum fine is \$500.00 or one year's imprisonment.
3. For failure to totally extinguish a camp or cooking fire before leaving it the same penalties as in (1) above.
4. For dropping inflammable material in or near woodland maximum fine of \$25.00.

Fire prevention is a personal matter and a good habit. Keep our town free from smokes in 1970.

Conservation Commission

The Tuftonboro Conservation Commission is continuing to do research regarding the town's right-of-ways to open bodies of water. It is hoped that during the coming year at least some of these bounds can be definitely ascertained and properly marked.

As the Commission feels that education is the key to conservation, it is making a gift of subscriptions to the National Wildlife

Federation's children's nature magazine to all students of the fourth grade at the Tuftonboro Central School, to be used in their curriculum.

The Commission plans to supply rubbish barrels at the Lang Road right-of-way to Mirror Lake in an effort to decrease the litter problem in that area. The Road Agent has agreed to empty them.

We would like to take this opportunity to appeal for a solution to what we consider to be a town problem. We feel that valuable wetland is being filled behind the Nineteen Mile Bay parking area. The Board of Selectmen has ruled that an alternative dumping area must be found for dumping fill before that area can be closed. The Commission welcomes suggestions for a solution to this problem as well as any other suggestions or criticisms.

Another year has swiftly come to a close. It has been a very busy year for all of us.

On January 1, 1969, a part-time secretary joined our staff, she works one day a week, keeping the nurses' records up-to-date and taking care of the correspondence.

Brookfield joined our service after their town meeting in March.

On April 15, 1969 Mrs. Davena DeWolf, R.N. of Brookfield, N.H., was added to our staff to work a half day five days a week.

In October an occupational therapist was added on a part-time basis. Physiotherapy will also continue to be a provided service. Anyone wishing any information regarding these services please call the Public Health Nurse's office. We are now using a code-a-phone if you leave your name and telephone number, it will be recorded if the nurse is out of the office, and the call returned

when she comes into the office.

A series of immunization clinics were held at the Clinic Room in the Hospital in the spring and fall. A series of clinics were held in Wakefield, New Hampshire at Dr. Bozuwa's office.

An evaluation of our service was done in October under the guidance of Mrs. Betty Ann Noyes, Nursing Consultant in the Medical Care Division, New Hampshire Department of Public Health.

Several board members and one nurse attended a meeting of the newly-formed State Association of Home Health Agencies.

Professional and Educational meetings in Concord and Hanover, have been attended by both of our nurses.

The Nursing Committee has met with our nurses when necessary.

Our nurses have been well received in the communities served, and have had a busy year.

We wish to especially thank our doctors and the hospital for their co-operation and assistance.

Again, I wish to thank each and everyone for your support of the Public Health Nursing Association.

With your continued support we look forward to serving you.
