You are hereby notified to meet at the Town House, in said town, on Tuesday the Fourteenth day of March next, at Ten of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

1. To choose by ballot and major vote a town clerk for the ensuing year.

2. To choose by ballot and major vote three selectmen for the ensuing year.

3. To choose all other necessary town officers and agents for the ensuing year.

4. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of poor.

5. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the repair of highways and bridges.

6. To see what sum of money the town will raise for the observance of Memorial Day.

7. To see what sum of money the town will raise for Public Library.

8. To see what sum of money the town will raise for police service.

9. To see what sum of money the town will raise for the repairs and building of sidewalks.

10. To see what sum of money the town will raise for town charges.

11. To see if the town will vote to discontinue the highway East of the house of Herbert R. Brigham, which was laid out to the Mohawk Lumber Co. Mill for mill purposes.

12. To see if the town will vote to discontinue the highway leading from the highway leading onto Titus Hill near the house of Chas. Sisco, Easterly to the highway on Titus hill near the house of Roy Martin.

The town for the past year have been unusually free from contagious diseases, there being only two mild cases of diphtheria reported. There has been no cases of typhoid.

The School Board has made every change and improvement suggested in and around the district school houses, and conditions along the line of sanitation are now, unusually good.
