(TOWN WARRANT) STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of the Town of Troy, in the County of Cheshire, qualified to vote in town affairs.

You are notified to meet at the Town Hall in said town on Tuesday, the tenth day of March next, at ten o'clock in the forenoon to act on the following subjects:

- Article 1. To choose a clerk for the ensuing year.
- Article 2. To choose a treasurer for the ensuing year.
- Article 3. To choose a selectman for the ensuing year. years.
 - Article 4. To choose all other necessary town officers.
- Article 5. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year, and make appropriation of the same.
- Article 6. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for repairing town highways and bridges.
- Article 7. To see if the town will vote to apply for state aid and permanent improvement of highways in accordance with an act of legislature of 1905.
- Article 8. To see if the town will vote to discontinue that part of the unused highway leading west from School St. toward the home of William Fleming.
- Article 9. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for state aid maintenance.

- Article 10. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for trunk line maintenance.
- Article 11. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$100.00 for the purpose of preservation of trees on highways and parks.
- Article 12. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary for the support of the poor.
- Article 13. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for street lighting.
- Article 14. To see if the town will vote to allow a discount of two percent upon all taxes, excepting poll taxes, paid previous to July 5th of the current year, and instruct the collector to collect all poll taxes before June 1st.
- Article 15. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) for the support of the fire department.
- Article 16. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money to be set aside as a sinking fund to pay for the water bonds at maturity.
- Article 17. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of employing a district nurse.
- Article 18. To see if the town will vote to instruct the Selectmen to borrow money to pay town charges.
- Article 19. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for the observance of Memorial Day.
- Article 20. To see if the town will vote to allow the American Legion to use the town hall one Friday night each month without pay.

Article 21. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the care and improvement of cemeteries.

Article 22. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in addition to the amount required by law for public library.

Article 23. To hear the reports of agents, officers or committees heretofore chosen, and take any action relating thereto.

Article 24. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

REPORT OF SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

To the Troy School Board:

I submit herewith my thirteenth annual report as Superintendent of Schools, this being the thirty-first in the series under union supervision. I also submit the report of Miss Margaret E. Harris, School Nurse, also the statistical table for 1929-30, and the first twelve weeks of the school year 1930-31, the roll of perfect attendance, and the graduates of the high and junior high school in June, 1930.

Only one change took place in the list of teachers for the present year. Miss Marion E. White who had taught the sixth grade during the past two years asked for a release to accept a position in Lexington, Mass. To fill this vacancy we were very fortunate in being able to secure the return of Miss Catherine R. Woodbury, who taught this grade previous to her service in New York.

The enrollment in the senior high school is the same as last year, thirty-five is given at the registration for each school year, while the junior high registration is thirty, a decrease of five from last year. The primary building shows a decrease of fifteen from the first twelve weeks of the school year 1929-30.

The work of all the schools has been very encouraging during the present year. I feel that if more parents were interested to visit the schools there would be a greater appreciation of the work that is being done by our teachers.

The health work, which was so effectively carried on by Mrs. Warner last year, was interrupted at the opening of the present school year, as her illness compelled her to give it up at that time, and it was not until the opening of the term in January that we were able to secure Miss Harris, who is now carrying on the work in a very thorough and capable manner.

The budget for the school year beginning July 1, 1931 has been very carefully made up in order to avoid asking for more school money than is actually needed to efficiently carry on the work.

It must be borne in mind, however, that Troy is a state aided town, and in order to comply with the requirements for state aid a certain approved standard of teachers, buildings, equipment and administration must be met. To lower the standard in any particular would mean a corresponding loss of state aid and a consequent increase in expense to the town.

For the past eleven years Troy has received a generous amount of state aid because the standards have been met, and I feel confident that the citizens have no desire to lower the efficiency of the school system.

I wish at this time to thank the school board, teachers, pupils, and all parents and citizens who have given their support and co-operation during the past year.

REPORT OF SCHOOL NURSE

Troy, N. H., Feb. 2, 1931.

To the Superintendent of Schools:

I submit herewith the following brief report of the health work in the school during the past year.

Fifty pupils had their teeth cared for.

Sixteen had tonsils and adenoids removed at the Keene hospital.

Ten had glasses fitted.

Thirty-three were vaccinated.

Thirty-five were given examinations at the clinic for underweight children.

A dental clinic for the convenience of school children is being conducted by Dr. Metevier at his office in Keene. The special reduced rates given makes it possible for the pupils to have their teeth cared for at very small cost.

Frequent inspections were made by the nurse for the detection of communicable diseases, including pediculosis, and whenever such cases were found the children were excluded from school until the danger of transmitting the disease was past.

Numerous visits were made to the homes to explain to the parents the necessity of having the defects of their children corrected.

In conclusion I wish to thank the teachers, parents, children, organizations and individuals, for their splendid co-operation in the health work in the schools.
