TOWN WARRANT

To the inhabitants of the Town of Conway, County of Carroll, qualified to vote in Town Affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Conway Elementary School Auditorium at Conway, New Hampshire, March 14, 1967, at nine o'clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects:

Article 1. To choose all necessary officers.

Article 2. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the following purposes:

- Section a Town officers' salaries
- b Town officers' expenses
- c Office expenses
- d Election and registration expenses
- e District court expenses
- f Expenses town hall and other town buildings
- g Reappraisal of property
- h Employees' retirement and social security
- i Police department
- j Fire department
- k Blister rust and care of trees
- l Insurance
- m Damages and legal expenses
- n Civil defense
- o Health department, including hospitals
- p Vital statistics
- q Town dump
- r Town maintenance of highways -- summer and winter
- s Town road aid
- t Libraries
- u Town poor
- v Old age assistance

- w Memorial Day
- x Soldiers' aid
- y Parks and playgrounds
- z Interest on temporary loans and bonds
- a-1 Class IV urban
- b-1 New equipment
- c-1 Bonds

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to hire upon the credit of the town such sums of money as may be needed, such sums not to exceed the combined School, Town and County tax budget, in anticipation of taxes raised for Town, County and School purposes.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000 to help defray the expenses of the Water Safety Program as carried on by the Conway Chapter of the American Red Cross. Agreeable to a petition signed by Harvey C. Blake and others. Recommended by Budget Committee.

Article 5. To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000 to be divided evenly between the Chamber of Commerce in North Conway and Conway, for operation of information booths in both villages. Agreeable to a petition signed by Chester B. Lucy and others. Recommended by Budget Committee.

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000 for the purpose of uniting with 45 other towns in the White Mountains Region Association in the co-operative development of the North Country's economy. Agreeable to a petition signed by Arthur F. Brown, Jr., and others. Recommended by Budget Committee.

Article 7. To see if the Town of Conway will recommend to accept the road or highway in the development of Thaddeus Thorne, and disregard the requirements of the Selectmen with regards to acceptance of roads, streets or highways, with respect to the number of houses required. Agreeable to a petition signed by Glenn H. Hale and others.

Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to instruct the Selectmen to sell all real estate in the town to which the Town now has title by Tax Collector's deed, all such real estate to be sold and conveyed on or before December 31, 1967. Agreeable to a petition signed by F. Joseph Smith and others.

Article 9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,500 for the Eastern Slope Regional Airport. No recommendation by Budget Committee.

Article 10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1.00 for the purchase of the old Conway Junior High School building and land from the Conway School District. Recommended by Budget Committee.

Article 11. To act upon any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

CONWAY POLICE DEPARTMENT

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITY – 1966

During the year 1966, the Conway Police Department handled over 2,000 calls with 1,134 of these resulting in police action. This figure includes the investigation of 480 complaints and 140 motor vehicle accidents, 284 aid cases, assistance to other agencies in 52 cases and aid rendered to 188 motorists. Routine door checks during the night tours resulted in finding 135 doors and windows open or unlocked.

Summons and arrests during the year totalled 271 with motor vehicle and liquor violations accounting for 141 and 41 respectively. A total of 269 warnings were issued for improper operation of motor vehicles and five cases were referred to the director of the Motor Vehicle Division.

Court action resulted in 168 convictions, seven acquittals and three bind-overs to Superior Court. Five cases were placed on file, three were nol prossed and nine defendants failed to appear and were defaulted.

The acquisition of two portable two-way radios has made it possible to increase foot patrol at night and during peak periods of the day without loss of communication and this activity will be further extended during the coming year. Future plans also include twenty-four hour dispatching from the police station. If approved, this will eliminate the use of the recorder and the frequent necessity of making two phone calls to contact the department. This service could be made available for the dispatching of any type of emergency call. At the present time, night and week-end dispatching is on a voluntary basis.

With the co-operation of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the N. H. Department of Safety, the County Attorney and other state and federal agencies, a comprehensive course of in-service training has been planned for all regular and special officers of the department. Attendance at these sessions is compulsory. The first two sessions were held in January with Special Agent Thomas Hannigan, FBI as instructor. Members of nearby departments are invited to attend and several have taken advantage of these first sessions as have members of the State Police and Fish and Game Departments. Provision has also been made to send as many officers as possible to various seminars on Law Enforcement subjects such as the series now being offered by St. Anselm's College. During 1966 three officers were sent to seminars at St. Anselm's and, in the late summer and early fall, four in-service sessions were held at the station house.

On behalf of the entire department, I would like to express our appreciation for the co-operation and support we have received from other law enforcement agencies, and, in particular, from the board of selectmen, the town manager and the citizens of Conway. Without this support no police department can be effective. Law enforcement is everyone's business. Call 356-2401 if you see a crime committed, a suspicious person, vehicle or object. Remember, next to 356-2401, the most important number is the correct registration number of the vehicle involved. You do not have to give your name. We don't mind if the suspicion is unfounded. Our job is to investigate. Help your police help you.

Report of Forest Fire Warden

Fire records are made by people — those who cause fires and those who control them. Your forest fire warden, deputy wardens, fire chief and firemen have, in spite of a prolonged drought, made one of the best fire control records in recent years. Despite a very dry spring, we in New Hampshire working together, have substantially reduced our fire incidence (885 in 1965 to 595 in 1966.)

This enviable record is largely due to two factors:

1. A closely co-ordinated and integrated state-town organization jointly carrying out programs of forest fire prevention, training and suppression with dedicated personnel.
2. Your appreciation of our forest fire control program and your individual effort in practicing fire prevention.

Statistics show, however, there is room for improvement. Major problems are still with us: (1) the careless disposal of cigarettes; (2) the householder's carelessness in burning rubbish; (3) the failure of woodlot owners and contractors to completely extinguish their brush burning fires; (4) failure to extinguish camp fires; (5) unsupervised children playing with matches.

New Hampshire has 4,339,000 acres of woodland to be protected. In 1966 we experienced 595 forest fires on this area and restricted acreage burned to 395 acres — a fine testimonial to the efficiency and dedication of the men who make up our forest fire control organization.

1. If you must burn you will need a permit. Permits are not issued between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. except on rainy days. Permits are not needed when the ground is covered with snow. To minimize risk, the best way to dispose of rubbish is at your authorized town or municipal dumping area.

2. Be sure all discarded smoking material is out.

3. Don't leave a live camp or cooking fire.

4. Most important — Instruct your children that matches are not play things.

FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Comparative Balance Sheets — December 31, 1965-December 31, 1966: (Exhibit A-1)

Comparative Balance Sheets as of December 31, 1965 and December 31, 1966, are presented in Exhibit A-1. As indicated therein the financial condition changed from a Net Debt of \$26,494.37 to a Surplus of \$5,955.73 in 1966.

Statement of Bonded Indebtedness: (Exhibit I)

A statement of outstanding bonded indebtedness as of December 31, 1966, showing annual debt service requirements, is contained in Exhibit I.

AUDIT PROCEDURE

The accounts and records of all town officials charged with the custody, receipt and disbursement of public funds were examined and audited. Vouchers and cancelled checks were compared with supporting invoices and payrolls as well as entries in the books of record. Receipts were checked by source insofar as possible and totals of receipts and expenditures verified. Book balances were verified by comparison with reconciled bank balances made from statements obtained from depository banks.

GENERAL COMMENTS

Current Surplus:

The current surplus (excess of total assets over current liabilities) increased by \$12,450.10, from \$112,505.63 to \$124, 955.73 in 1966, as shown herewith:
