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CLINTON HOLDS BIG 2016 LEAD IN NH, NO GOP FRONTRUNNER

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DURHAM, NH – Hillary Clinton remains the heavy favorite among New Hampshire Democrats for the 2016 New Hampshire Primary. There is no clear frontrunner among Republicans but a few names are rising to the top. The great majority of voters have not decided who they will support.

These findings are based on the latest WMUR Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Five hundred and seven (507) randomly selected New Hampshire adults were interviewed by landline and cellular telephone between April 4 and April 9, 2013. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 4.4 percent. Included in the sample were 171 likely 2016 Republican Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 7.5%) and 188 likely 2016 Democratic Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 7.1%).

Three Years Until NH First in the Nation Primary

Although it is three years before the First in the Nation New Hampshire Presidential Primary, prospective Republican and Democratic candidates have already been testing the waters here for presidential runs in 2016. While many of the candidates tested will decide not to run, and others may enter who are not tested, candidates who are the early identified frontrunners have typically won past New Hampshire primaries.

Very few voters have made up their minds about who they will support in 2016. The great majority of prospective primary voters, 80% of Democrats and 91% of Republicans, say they are still trying to decide who to support.

Democratic Primary

Despite the primary being almost 3 years from now, former Secretary of State and 2008 NH Democratic Primary winner Hillary Clinton is the clear current favorite among Democratic voters. In April 2013, 61% of likely Democratic Primary voters say they plan to vote for Clinton, 7% prefer Vice President Joe Biden, 3% prefer New York Governor Andrew Cuomo, 3% prefer Massachusetts Governor Deval Patrick, 2% prefer Virginia Senator Mark Warner, 1% prefer Newark Mayor Corey Booker and 1% prefer former Indiana Senator Evan Bayh. All other potential candidates mentioned received less than 1% support and 22% say they are undecided.

When asked which potential candidate they would NOT vote for under any circumstance, 7% of likely Democratic Primary voters say they would not vote for Biden, 4% would not vote for Clinton, 4% would not vote for Bayh, 3% would not vote for Patrick, 3% would not vote for Warner 3% would not vote for Los Angeles Mayor Antonio Villaraigosa, 2% would not vote for Cuomo, 1% would not vote for Montana Governor Brian Schweitzer, 1% would not vote for Colorado Governor John Hickenlooper, 1% say they would not vote for some other candidate, 33% think that all of the prospective candidates are acceptable, and 38% are unsure.

Democratic Favorability Ratings

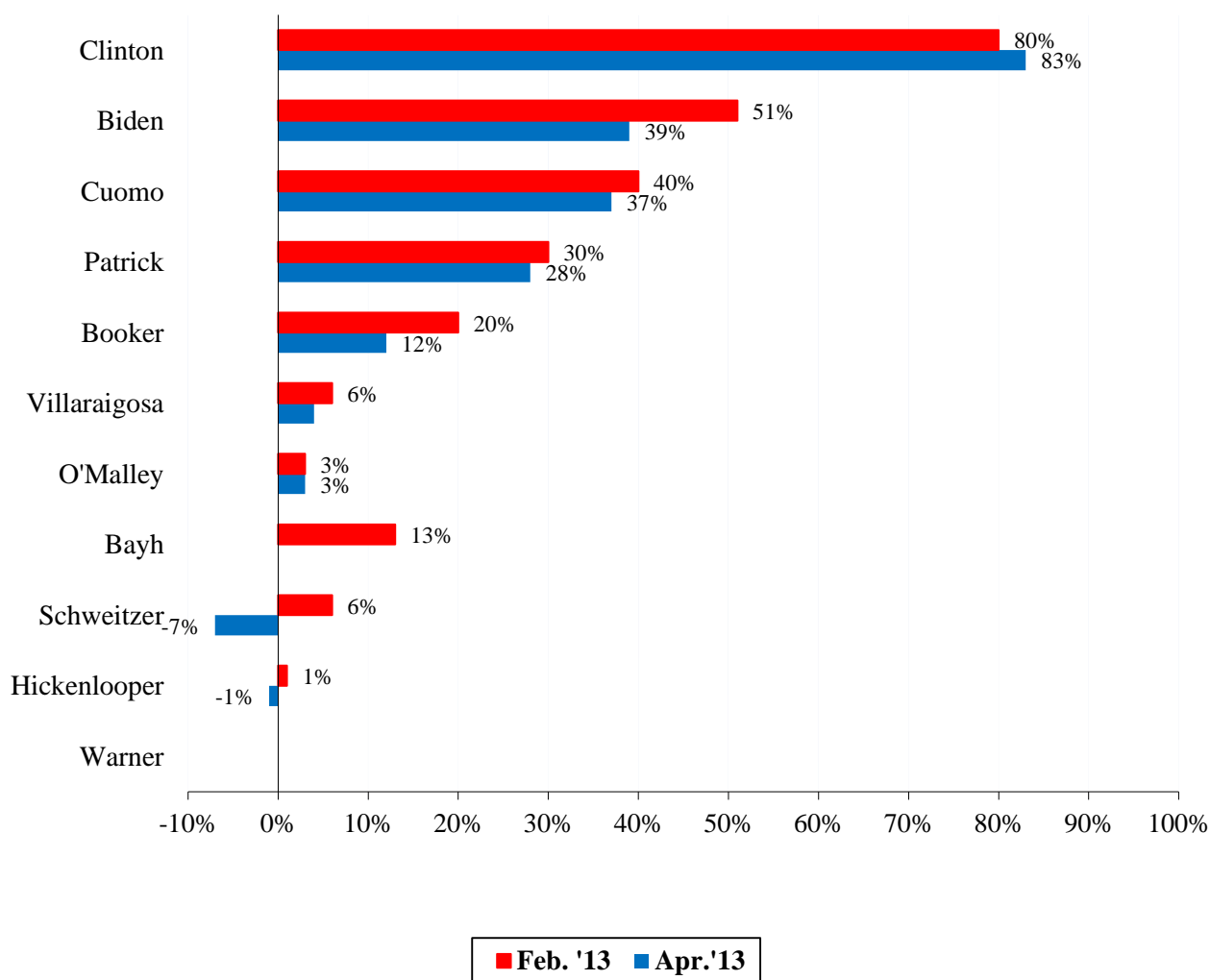
Hillary Clinton is also the most popular potential Democratic candidate among likely New Hampshire Democratic Primary voters. The great majority of Democratic Primary voters, 88%, have a favorable opinion of Clinton, only 5% have an unfavorable opinion of her, and 7% are neutral or unsure. Her net favorability rating, the percentage who have a favorable opinion minus those who have an unfavorable opinion, is an extremely high +83%.

The potential candidate with the next highest net favorability rating is Joe Biden, who saw his net favorability drop from 51% to 39% since February.

The other potential Democratic candidates that have moderate net favorability ratings include Andrew Cuomo (+37%), Deval Patrick (+28%), Cory Booker (+12%).

Los Angeles Mayor Antonio Villaraigosa (+4%), Maryland Governor Martin O'Malley (+3%), Former Indiana Senator Evan Bayh (0%), Virginia Senator Mark Warner (0%), Colorado Governor John Hickenlooper (-1%), and Montana Governor Brian Schweitzer (-7%), are less well known and have much lower net favorability ratings.

Republican Primary

Among likely Republican Primary voters, there is no clear frontrunner. Currently, 15% of likely Republican Primary voters saying they would vote for Kentucky Senator Rand Paul, 15% prefer Florida Senator Marco Rubio, 11% prefer New Jersey Governor Chris Christie, 11% prefer Wisconsin Congressman Paul Ryan, 5% support New Hampshire Senator Kelly Ayotte, 5% support former Utah Governor Jon Huntsman, 5% prefer former Florida Governor Jeb Bush, 4% support former Pennsylvania Senator Rick Santorum, 2% prefer Louisiana Governor Bobby Jindal, 2% prefer Texas Senator Ted Cruz, 1% prefer Wisconsin Governor Scott Walker and 1% support Ohio Senator Rob Portman. All other potential candidates receive less than 1% support, and 23% say they are undecided.

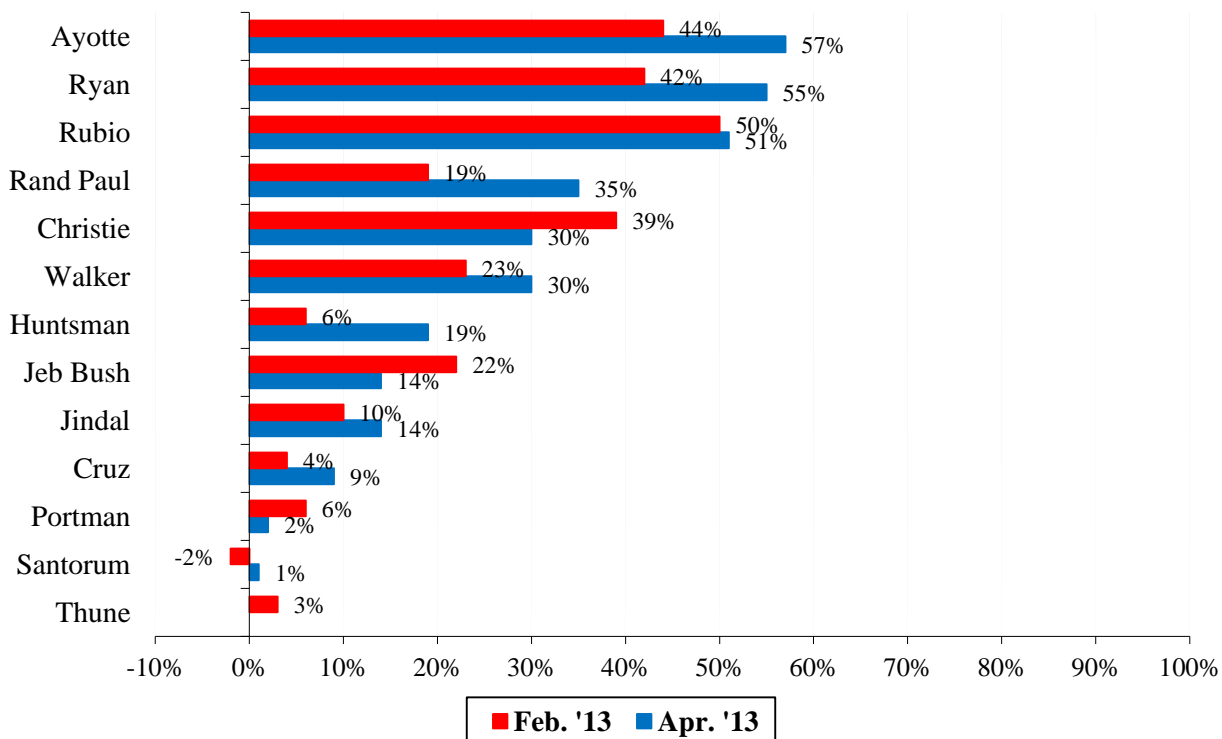
When asked which candidate they would NOT vote for under any circumstance, 13% of likely Republican Primary voters say they would not vote for Santorum, 11% would not vote for Christie, 9% would not vote for Paul, 8% would not vote for Bush, 6% would not vote for Ayotte, 6% would not vote for Huntsman, 1% would not vote for Portman, 24% think all the prospective candidates are acceptable, and 21% are unsure.

GOP Favorability Ratings

New Hampshire's own Kelly Ayotte is currently the most popular potential Republican candidate among likely Republican Primary voters – 71% have a favorable opinion of her, 14% have an unfavorable opinion of her, and 9% are neutral or unsure. She currently receives the highest net favorability rating at +57%. Two other potential Republican candidates receive similar favorability ratings, Paul Ryan and Marco Rubio. Ryan, the GOP Vice Presidential candidate in 2012 is viewed favorably by 68% of likely Republican Primary voters, 13% have an unfavorable opinion of him, and 18% are neutral or don't know. Ryan's net favorability rating is at +55%. Rubio is viewed favorably by 59% of likely Republican Primary voters, 8% have an unfavorable opinion of him, and 33% are neutral or don't know enough to say. Rubio currently receives the highest net favorability rating of the potential GOP candidates at +50%.

Other potential Republican candidates that have moderate favorability ratings, include Rand Paul (+35%), Chris Christie (30%), Scott Walker (30%) and Jon Huntsman (+19%), Jeb Bush (+14%) and Bobby Jindal (14%). Ted Cruz (+9%), Rob Portman (+2%), Rick Santorum (+1%), and Jon Thune (+0%) have low net favorability ratings.

Granite State Poll Methodology

These findings are based on the latest WMUR Granite State Poll, conducted by the University of New Hampshire Survey Center. Five hundred and seven (507) randomly selected New Hampshire adults were interviewed by landline and cellular telephone between April 4 and April 9, 2013. The margin of sampling error for the survey is +/- 4.4 percent. Included in the sample were 171 likely 2016 Republican Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 7.5%) and 188 likely 2016 Democratic Primary voters (margin of sampling error +/- 7.1%).

The data have been weighted to adjust for numbers of adults and telephone lines within households, respondent sex, and region of the state. In addition to potential sampling error, all surveys have other potential sources of non-sampling error including question order effects, question wording effects, and non-response.
