DURHAM, N.H. - NH Sea Grant will hold an informal discussion of sector allocation, a fisheries management plan using quotas given to a group of fishermen, on Tuesday, April 22, 2008 from 6:30-8:30 p.m. in the Hilton Garden Meeting Room of the Portsmouth Public Library. The event is part of the ongoing Fisheries Roundtable Discussion series. All talks are free and open to the public.

The discussion will involve the current status of sector applications to the New England Fishery Management Council as well as technical and financial assistance that may be available to current applicants.
